## NATIONALS NEWS

**MEET THE METS**  
The Washington Nationals continue this four-game series against the New York Mets on Tuesday night...Washington has won three consecutive series over New York since Aug. 19-21, 2025, including a victory earlier this season at Citi Field, April 28-30...The Nationals have won or split their last three home series against the Mets since July 1-4, 2024.

- The Nationals are in a stretch of 16 straight games without a day off that started on May 12 at Cincinnati... Washington's next day off is scheduled for May 28 at home...The Nationals are 4-3 during this stretch so far.

**ROSTER MOVES**  
The Nationals recalled outfielder **Dylan Crews** and first baseman/designated hitter **Andrés Chaparro** from Triple-A Rochester and optioned outfielder **Joey Wiemer** to Triple-A Rochester on Tuesday...The Nationals also optioned third baseman **Brady House** to Triple-A Rochester on Monday.

- Crews, 24, joins the Nationals after hitting .308 (20-for-68) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, 11 RBI, six walks, two stolen bases and 15 runs scored in his last 17 games with Triple-A Rochester...He hit safely in 15 of the 17 games and posted a .366 on-base percentage and a .585 slugging percentage...He went 2-for-4 with two doubles and two runs scored in his final game with Rochester, May 17 vs. Lehigh Valley.
- Chaparro, 27, returns to the Nationals for his third Major League stint of the season. He hit .260 with eight doubles, six home runs, 24 RBI, 14 walks and 22 runs scored in 35 games with Triple-A Rochester...In his last two games with the Red Wings, Chaparro went 6-for-10 (.600) with three doubles, one homer, six RBI and three runs scored on May 16 and 17 vs. Lehigh Valley.

**WINNING WAYS**  
Despite Monday night's loss, the Nationals have won four of seven, seven of 12, eight of 14 and 12 of 21 games since April 25...They have won five of their last seven series and have won five of their last eight home games after starting the season 3-12 through their first 15 home games.

- In the 12 wins, the pitching staff has recorded a 2.51 ERA and a .207 opponents' average.
- Per Baseball-Reference.com, the Nationals have the hardest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball with their opponents averaging 0.3 runs per game more than the league average team.

**PRETTY OFFENSIVE**  
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 5.46 runs per game and with 262 runs scored this season.

- Washington has scored 39 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 101 runs in the seventh inning or later.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 28 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

**OUT OF THIS WORLD**  
**CJ Abrams** ranks among National League hitters in RBI (3rd, 39), on-base percentage (8th, .384), OPS (8th, .913), wRC+ (8th, 153) and wOBA (9th, .395) and extra base hits (10th, 21).

- He is hitting .338 (26-for-77) with eight doubles, a triple, two homers, 18 RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 14 runs in his last 19 games...He's reached safely in 16 of the 19 and is slugging .545 during the stretch.

**ACE OF BASES**  
The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams in baseball according to the advanced metrics:

- According to FanGraphs, Washington leads Major League Baseball in their baserunning metric, baserunning runs above average, at 5.1...Baserunning runs above average is *all encompassing baserunning statistic that turns stolen bases, caught stealings, and other base running plays (taking extra bases, being thrown out on the bases, etc) into runs above and below average.*
- Per Baseball Savant, the Nationals are tied with the Miami Marlins for the Major League Lead with five baserunning runs (A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths.).
- Nasim Nuñez** leads Major League Baseball with four baserunning runs and is second with 3.4 baserunning runs above average...His 20 stolen bases lead the NL and are tied for the most in MLB with **Jose Ramirez** (20).

**GOOD WOOD**  
**James Wood** leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.5 MPH ahead of **O'Neil Cruz** (96.0).

- Wood is one of four players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (2), **Junior Caminero** (2) and **O'Neil Cruz** (2).
- Wood's 29 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch angle) are the most in MLB ahead of **Kyle Schwarber** (26) and his 58 batted balls over 100 MPH are tied for the most in MLB with **O'Neil Cruz** (58) and **Drake Baldwin** (58).

**HOMER HAPPY**  
Washington's 20 home runs since May 6 are tied for second in Major League baseball with the Philadelphia Phillies (20) and behind the Chicago White Sox (22)...The Nationals have homered at least once in nine of the 12 games since May 6...Washington leads Major League Baseball with a .512 slugging percentage over this stretch.

## FARM REPORT

**STREA-KING TO ROCHESTER**  
Shortstop **Seaver King** has reached base safely in all 34 games this season, the second-longest active streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest streak in MiLB overall this season...He was promoted to Triple-A Rochester on Monday...King ranks in Washington's system in triples (1st, 3rd), average (2nd, .336), hits (2nd, 46), doubles (T3rd, 10), runs (T3rd, 33) and extra-base hits (4th, 18).

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

## LAST START

Allowed a career high nine earned runs through 4.1 innings of work on seven hits (2 HR) and three walks against the Cincinnati Reds on May 14 at Great American Ball Park.

## NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Griffin has a 2.12 ERA in three games at home (4 ER/17.0 IP) this season...His home ERA ranks 13th-best in the National League.

- Griffin did not give up a run in his last home start against the Milwaukee Brewers on May 2.

## WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

## LUCKY 7

Griffin has the ability to throw seven pitches, including: cutter (31.3%), four seamer (15.8%), sweeper (13.4%), changeup (12.1%), curveball (8.9%), split finger (7.0%) and sinker (11.4%).

## 2026 SPRING TRAINING

Made two starts allowing four earned runs on eight hits striking out nine batters across 8.0 innings.

## 2023-25

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.
