RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals wrap up their home slate at Busch Stadium today with the finale of a three-game series with the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers ... The Cardinals have gone 2-3 on their rivalry homestand against the Red Legs (1-2) and Brew Crew (1-1) ... Today's home finale marks the earliest St. Louis has wrapped up a home schedule since Sept. 21, 2014 at Busch III and Sept. 21, 2003 at Busch Memorial Stadium.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the NL Central and 5.0 games back of the Mets (80-75) for the third and final Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals postseason elimination number stands at three (two vs. the Mets due to tiebreakers) ... St. Louis needs to win all seven remaining games this season to finish with a winning record (82+ wins) ... The last time the Cardinals posted two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

GAMES THAT MATTER: Since 2011 Opening Day, the Cardinals have played 2,297 out of a possible 2,319 regular season games (99.1%) during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated.

MO-MENTOUS: The Cardinals will honor & celebrate the career of President of Baseball Operations **John "Mo" Mozeliak** during a pregame ceremony today. - *Mo's accomplishments & career timeline are listed right.*

PLAYERS USED: Forty-four different players have played for the Cardinals this season, tying Cleveland for fewest in Major League Baseball (Baltimore leads with 69) ... The 44 Cardinals matches last season's total, while the 52 different Redbirds in 2023 set a franchise record.

- Seven Cardinals have avoided the Injured List and been active for every game this season (excluding suspension): catcher **Pedro Pagés**, starting pitchers **Miles Mikolas**, **Andre Pallante**, **Sonny Gray**, & **Matthew Liberatore**, and relievers **Kyle Leahy**, and **JoJo Romero**.
- St. Louis is the only MLB team in 2025 with 4+ pitchers with 28+ starts.

20 SEASONS AT BUSCH III: The Cardinals have clinched a winning record at Busch Stadium III (43-37, .536) for the 18th time in 20 seasons since the stadium was opened (2006-25), 3rd-most winning seasons at home behind only the Dodgers (20) and Yankees (20).

- Since 2006, their all-time .575 win pct (898-663) at Busch III ranks 3rd at home to the Dodgers (.622, 974-593) & Yankees (.614, 960-604).
- Among teams in MLB history over their initial 20 seasons at primary home venues, the Cardinals .575 win pct. at Busch III ranks 11th-best and is 2nd in franchise history to the Gashouse Gang's first 20 years at Sportsman Park (.596, 901-611) from 1920-39. - *Elias*.
- The New York Yankees hold the MLB record by starting 1,027-501 (.672) at Original Yankee Stadium from 1923-42. - *Elias*

KINGS OF THE NORTH: The Springfield Cardinals look to capture its 2nd overall Texas League (AA) championship (also 2012) when it hosts Game 1 of the best-of-three series against the Midland Rockhounds (Athletics) today at Hammons Field ... LHP **Pete Hansen** starts for Springfield at 1:05 p.m. today ... Springfield set a franchise record in regular season victories (88-50, .638), while winning both halves in the same season for the 2nd time in franchise history (2007).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Erick Fedde made 30 starts for St. Louis over parts of two seasons (2024-25)...acquired at the 2024 MLB Trade Deadline from the White Sox as part of three-team trade with the Dodgers.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Stratton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Brewers Media Relations Intern **Owen Buescher** previously worked as a 2024 Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate...graduated from Belleville (Ill.) West High School and Univ. of Missouri.

Jacob Misorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Late Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** & **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Southpaw will be making his 29th start of the season and 53rd career (120th career appearance).
- A win today will give him eight wins, matching his total from his first three seasons (2022-24).
- Pitched 6.0 innings and earned a quality start vs. CIN (9/15) for the first time since June 29 at CLE. Also the last time he has consecutive quality starts (6/24-29).
- His last win in a road game came on 6/29 in a 7-0 win over Cleveland at Progressive Field.
- Leads STL starters in ERA (4.35) and ranks 3rd in wins (7), 2nd in strikeouts (110), and 4th in IP (140.2) - all career single-season highs.
- Has worked 146.2 IP this season, 3.0 innings shy of his season high innings of 149.2 combined in 2022 between St. Louis (34.2 IP) and AAA-Memphis (115.0 IP).
- Tonight marks his 10th start since the All-Star Break (1-5, 4.66 ERA). Was given a 14-day extended pause/rest combined with benefit of the All-Star break between his starts on July 11 & July 26.
- Over his initial 13 starts of 2025, limited left-handed batters to a .190 BA (11-58) with one extra base hit (Sal Frelick double on 4/25).
- Held the opposition to two runs or fewer in eight straight starts (April 13-May 24), longest streak by a Cardinal since **Jack Flaherty** ran off nine straight in 2019 (7/7-8/23).
- Is 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA (70.2 IP) in 13 home starts this season & 2-7 with a 4.50 ERA (76.0 IP) in 15 road starts.
- Has worked 6.0 innings or more in 12 of his 28 starts this season. His May 1 start at CIN was cut short (3.0 IP) by a lengthy rain delay.

ST. LOUIS SOUTHPAWS

- His 29th start tonight is the most by a Cardinals left-hander since **Jaime García** (30 in 2016). At age 25, Libby’s 29 starts are the most by a St. Louis southpaw at age 25 or younger since the 24-year-old García made 32 starts in 2011.
- Among MLB lefties age 25 or younger this season, only Washington’s 25-year-old **Mitchell Parker** (30 starts) has made more than Liberatore.
- His 7 wins this season are the most by a Cardinals lefty starter since **Jaime Garcia** (10 in 2016).
- Boasts the 3rd most wins (7) in MLB among lefty starters age 25 or younger this season, trailing **Mitchell Parker** (WSH) and Noah Cameron (KC) with 8.
- Is the youngest Cardinals lefty starter to win 7 games since 23-year-old **Jaime Garcia** (13 wins in 2010).

LAST TIME OUT (Monday, Sept. 15 vs. Cincinnati): Pltched 6.0 innings allowing three runs (2 ER) on four hits with six strikeouts in a no decision the Cardinals lost 11-6 to Cincinnati. His first start of 6.0 innings since June 29.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Has established single season-highs in wins (7), losses (12), starts (28), strikeouts (116), and innings pitched (146.2) this season.
- Struck out four batters at CIN (8/28) giving him his first career 100 strikeout season.
- He had 9-straight starts pitching 5.0 IP or less, the longest in-season streak by a Cardinals starting pitcher and set the franchise record for those uninterrupted by a relief appearance passing Mark Mulder (2006-07)
- Allowed a home run in five straight games from 8/6 to 8/29, his career-long streak; T-4th longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher this season.
- Cards won each of his 4 starts (6/17-7/5) scoring 35 runs over those games. Held opposition to 2 runs or fewer in each start (3-0, 2.25 ERA).
- Ran a career-high win streak to three games after recording three-straight winning decisions to close out the month of June.
- Held the opposition to two runs or fewer in a career-best eight straight starts from April 13-May 24.
- Was dazzling in a 2-1 win over the Pirates and Paul Skenes on May 6 at Busch Stadium as matched his career high in strikeouts with 8 and limited the Buccos to just 3 hits while he logged a season-high 7.0 IP (99 pitches); It was his 4th consecutive winning decision in a Home start dating to last season (3-0 in 2025).
- Pitched 6.0 innings allowing three runs for a quality start in his first start of the 2025 season vs. LAA (4/1); surrendered all his runs in the 3rd inning vs. LAA after retiring the first eight batters of the game.

CAREER:

- Is a career 12-21 with a 4.94 ERA in his 52 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 67 career relief appearances.
- Lifetime 9-9 with a 3.94 ERA (118.2 IP/50 ER) in 23 career starts at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals are 10-13 in his starts there.

LIBERATORE vs. MILWAUKEE:

- Is facing the Brewers for the 11th time in his career, but for just his 4th start.
- Of pitchers with 20 or more career innings vs. MIL, his 1.14 ERA ranks 8th-lowest all-time.
- **Had identical starts vs. MIL on 5/17/23 at Busch Stadium and his 1st career start (5/28/22) against the Brewers; owns a 2-0 mark with 0.00 ERA (10.0 IP) in his two starts against MIL with 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 BB, 6 SO at Busch Stadium.**
- In 23.2 career innings and 99 total batters faced, has not allowed a home run to Milwaukee.
- Has only allowed one earned run in seven career appearances (3 starts) vs. the Brewers at Busch Stadium (3-0, 0.45 ERA, 20.0 IP, 21 K).
- His 1st career MLB win came in the 5/28/23 start against Milwaukee.
