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THE TWINS: Through three games on their current six-game homestand, the Twins have gone 1-2, dropping a series to Chicago-AL over the weekend, salvaging the series finale on Sunday afternoon...Minnesota will continue the homestand tonight with the first of three against the Tigers through Wednesday night.

ZEBBY CALLS SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-1, avoiding the sweep...Zebby Matthews (9-8) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 8.1 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Matthews carried a perfect game into the sixth inning until a Drew Romo two-out single; he was relieved by Jeff Hoffman with one out in the ninth after throwing 103 pitches...the offense recorded nine hits and struck out just three times...Luke Keaschall hit his ninth home run of the season and reached three times on the day, totaling five bases on the afternoon.

TIGER KINGS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the eighth of 13 games today...Twins are 5-2 vs. the Tigers this season, going 4-0 at Target Field and 1-2 at Comerica Park.

☞ The Twins have gone 44-24 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season, second-most home wins against any opponent in that span (Kansas City - 48-21).

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 158, 31 ahead of Cleveland (127).

☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .898 OPS in 27 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 27 career games vs. the Tigers (.415 OBP, 26 H, 18 BB).

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with two doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, six walks, a .440 on-base percentage and a .975 OPS in 12 career games vs. Detroit.

☞ Notables this season vs. Detroit: Josh Bell is 11-for-27 (.407) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and two walks...Royce Lewis is 9-for-24 (.375) with one double, one home run, four RBI and five walks...Luke Keaschall is 6-for-20 (.300) with one home run, four RBI and three walks.

DIVISION SIGNS: The Twins have 25 games remaining, 12 against AL Central opponents — three vs. the White Sox, six vs. the Tigers and three vs. the Guardians...they also play the Angels (.387 win%), Giants (.409 win%) and Rangers (.489 win%)...their remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .472, the fifth-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.

OH MY JOSH: Josh Bell drove in two more runs yesterday, giving him a team-leading 83 on the season...it marks the fourth-most of his career (116 in 2019; 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021).

☞ 83 RBI rank tied for fifth-best in the AL and tied for 11th-most in baseball.

☞ Bell is on pace for 98 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

☞ Since August 17, he has 11 RBI in 11 games.

JOGGING OR YOGGING, IT MIGHT BE A SOFT J: Twins went 1-for-2 in stolen base attempts yesterday and are now 22-for-27 over their last 34 games since July 23...since that date, their 81.5 stolen base percentage ranks fourth-best in the AL.

☞ Josh Bell stole his second base of the season yesterday and now has 1/3 of his career total of six.

E-LUKE-TRIC FEEL: Luke Keaschall is hitting .337 (33-for-98) with a .987 OPS in his last 26 games...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

SO FRESH, SO C-LEE-N: Over his last 19 games, Brooks Lee is hitting .307 (23-for-75) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, one walk, a .325 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a .925 OPS...additionally, he has just 12 strikeouts in 77 plate appearances (15.6%) in that span.

☞ This season, he has already set single-season career-highs in hits (121), runs (61), doubles (21), triples (3), home runs (22), RBI (73), walks (33) and stolen bases (7).

☞ He is the only switch hitter in baseball with 20-plus doubles, 20-plus home runs and 70-plus RBI...removing the RBI, he is one of five switch hitters in baseball with 20-doubles/20-homers (Ozzie Albies, Ian Happ, Ketel Marte, Eily De La Cruz).

DILL PICKLE FLAVORED TWINS: The Twins are currently at the 2026 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...The Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (now through Monday, September 7)...former Twins pitcher and current bullpen coach LaTroy Hawkins will visit the Experience tomorrow from 11-45 am to 12:45 pm.
