METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets returned to action on Friday and fell to the Dodgers, 7-5 in 13 innings...The Mets have lost four of their last five and six of their last eight games...The Mets continue a nine-game homestand (0-1) against the Dodgers (0-1), White Sox (three games) and Rockies (three games).

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Mets announced the following roster moves: LHP Brandon Waddell and INF/OF Jared Young were recalled from Triple-A Syracuse...LHP Génesis Cabrera and OF José Azocar were designated for assignment.

SOUTHPAW STRIKEOUTS: David Peterson has recorded 511 career strikeouts, which ranks 12th all-time among franchise southpaws...Tom Glavine is next on the list with 516...Peterson became the 13th Mets southpaw to reach 500 strikeouts on May 6 and the first since Steven Matz (recorded his 500th strikeout on 9/11/19)...He reached the milestone in his 108th game (92nd start) which was the seventh-fewest games with the club (Sid Fernandez - 82G/81GS, Al Leiter - 85GS, Johan Santana - 89GS, Jon Matlack - 93G/90GS, Matz - 100G/98GS and Jon Niese - 105G/104GS)...He also became the sixth lefty to be drafted or first signed by the Mets to accomplish the feat, joining Jerry Koosman, Matlack, Matz, Tug McGraw and Niese.

APPLE PICKING: Peterson has recorded 16 career pickoffs (one this season), tied with Bobby Ojeda for the eighth-most by a Mets pitcher...He trails only Ron Darling (41), Jerry Koosman (36), Dwight Gooden (32), Al Leiter (28), Jon Matlack (24), Mike Scott (20), Sid Fernandez (18)...Courtesy of OPTA...Since his Major League debut in 2020, his 27 net bases prevented is the most among major league pitchers according to Baseball Savant (a sum of advances prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher)...Chris Flexen and José Berríos are next on the list with 20.

IN THE CITI: The Mets are 17-6 at home this season...Their .739 winning percentage at home is the best in the majors this season...Mets pitchers have recorded a 2.50 ERA at home this season which is the second-lowest in the majors.

MAKE IT A DOZEN: Over his last 12 games, Jeff McNeil is batting .261 (6-23) with three runs, one double, one triple, one homer, five RBI, 10 walks, a .485 OBP and a .522 SLG...He safely reached base in all but four of his 22 games this season...He has not struck out over his last 11 games, a total of 20 at-bats and 30 plate appearances.

NO HOMERS CLUB: Entering Saturday, Pete Alonso has not hit a home run in 61 at-bats (67 PA)...His 61 at-bats without a home run is the longest stretch in his career...He has gone 15 straight games without a home run...That is tied for the longest streak in his career...He also went 15 games without a homer from April 28-May 14, 2021.

OUCH: The Mets have been plunked 29 times this year, which is the most in the National League...New York was hit 92 times last season, the third-most in the majors and the most in the Senior Circuit...Pete Alonso owns the franchise record, having been hit by 90 pitches in his career...Brandon Nimmo is second with 81, followed by Jeff McNeil at 77 HBP.

PITCHING IN: The Mets lead the majors with a 2.86 ERA and are sixth with 459 strikeouts...They are tied for fifth with five shutouts...New York's starting staff has posted a 2.91 ERA this year, third in the majors and best in the NL...The bullpen ranks second in the majors with a 2.80 ERA.

ED, EDD AND EDDY: Edwin Díaz has not allowed an earned run over his last 10 games, recording four saves and allowing four hits, four walks and 12 strikeouts during that span...He has not allowed a hit over last six appearances.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his last start on May 18 at New York-AL and did not record the decision after allowing just two runs (one unearned) over 6.0 innings (3 H, 4BB/IBB, 4 K, WP)...Reached 500.0 career innings pitched...Is one of 18 left-handed pitchers to reach the milestone with the franchise...Has made three consecutive quality starts, throwing 100+ pitches in each outings...Marks the first time in his career he has thrown triple-digit pitches in three straight outings...Is the first Mets pitcher to do so since Kodai Senga recorded 5 straight starts of 100+ pitches from August 25 - September 20, 2023.

ON A ROLL: Over nine starts this season, has gone 2-2 with a 2.86 ERA (16 ER/50.1 IP), 20 walks and 47 strikeouts...The Mets are 6-3 in his starts this season...Has pitched 5.0 innings or more in eight of his nine starts and in each of his last seven starts...His seven such consecutive games mark the second-longest streak of his career (10 GS with 5.0+ innings from 7/11-9/3/24)...Has allowed three earned runs or less in each of his nine starts this season and in each of his last 10 starts dating back to September 29, 2024 (the second-longest such streak in his career)...His longest such streak came in an 11-start span from 6/20-9/9/22...Among Major League pitchers this season (min. 50.0 IP), his 56.5 groundball percentage is the sixth-best (fourth in NL)...Since the start of last season, Peterson has allowed three runs or fewer in 25 of his 30 starts, going 12-5 with a 2.89 ERA (55 ER/171.1 IP), 66 walks and 148 strikeouts...Since 2024, has allowed just four runs in the first inning, tied with Zack Wheeler or the second fewest in the majors during that span (min. 30 G)...Trails only Reese Olson (2 R)...The Mets are 21-9 over his last 30 starts.

HOME SWEET HOME: In five starts at Citi Field this season, has recorded a 3.08 ERA (9 ER/26.1 IP) with nine walks and 23 strikeouts...Has allowed three runs or fewer in each of those five games and has pitched 5.0+ innings in four...The Mets are 11-3 in his 14 combined home starts since the beginning of 2024...He has gone 5-2 with a 3.25 ERA (27 ER/74.2 IP), 29 walks and 74 strikeouts in those games...In 53 career games (44 starts) at Citi Field, has gone 17-8 with a 3.40 ERA (89 ER/235.1 IP), 105 walks and 242 strikeouts...The Mets have gone 36-17 in Peterson's games at home.

TO THE LEFT TO THE LEFT: This season, Peterson has held lefties to a .195 batting average (8-41)...Among qualified southpaws facing left-handed hitters this season, he is third in groundball percentage (69.0%, second in NL) and is tied for eighth in opponents' SLG (.244, tied for sixth in NL)...In his career, he has posted a .229 opponents' batting average against lefties (102-446).

ELECTRIC SLIDE: David Peterson has used his slider 18.7% of the time this season...Of his 47 strikeouts, 24 have come using this pitch...Has recorded a 33.0% whiff rate with the pitch this season, his highest among pitches in his arsenal.

QUALITY CONTROL: Has recorded five quality starts in nine total outings this season, including each of his last three starts...Peterson has recorded 17 quality starts since the start of last season, with 15 of them coming in his last 25 games (since July 1)...From July 1, 2024 to now, his 15 quality starts are tied for the ninth-most in the majors (tied for fourth in NL).

VS. LOS ANGELES-NL: Including the Postseason, will be making his seventh appearance (fifth start) against the Dodgers...Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in five of those six appearances and has gone 5.0+ innings in just two of his four starts...In the 2024 NLCS, pitched in Game 1 (relief) and Game 5 (start).

CAREER NOTES: Made his third career Opening Day roster (also: 2021 and 2023)...Started the 2024 season on the 60-day Injured List after undergoing left hip surgery in the offseason...Over parts of five major league seasons with the Mets, the southpaw has gone 30-26 with a 3.96 ERA (222 ER/504.1 IP), 217 walks and 511 strikeouts in 110 games (94 starts)...Was drafted by the Mets in the first round (20th overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.

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- Recorded his first loss of the season after allowing two runs (one unearned) in the 13th inning on May 23 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3 H)...Marked his first loss since August 3, 2024 at Los Angeles-AL (career-high 39 G without a loss)...Snapped a 10-game streak of not allowing an earned run (13.2 IP, from 4/27-5/21).
- Earned his third win of the season after tossing 2.1 scoreless innings in relief on May 21 at Boston (H, 4 K)...Entered the game with the bases loaded in the fifth inning and stranded all runners...Marked his most strikeouts in a game since July 6, 2024 (5 K)...Has stranded 14 of 16 inherited runners this season (12.5%), which is the eighth-best percentage among qualified Major League relievers and the best mark in the National League.

- Tossed a scoreless seventh inning in relief on May 18 at the Yankees (H, 2 BB, K)...Loaded the bases and struck out Anthony Volpe to end the inning...Pitched on consecutive days for the fourth time this season (also: 4/8-9, 4/22-23 and 5/4(G1)-5).
- Has gone 3-1 with one save, six holds and a 1.16 ERA (4 ER/31.0 IP) through 23 appearances (two starts as an opener) this season, holding batters to a .175 average (18-103)...18 of his 23 outings this season have been scoreless...With runners on base, has held batters to a .125 average (6-48)...He is one of eight Mets pitchers (ninth time) to record as low of an ERA through their first 23 games of a season and is the first to do so since Francisco Rodríguez's 0.79 ERA in 22 games from 4/2-5/20/11.
- Has recorded a 1.29 ERA (4 ER/28.0 IP) in 21 games as a reliever this season...Among qualified NL relievers this season, is fifth in ERA, is tied for sixth in wins and seventh in WHIP (0.78).
- He has a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) over 10 appearances at home this season and has held batters to a .222 batting average (10-45) at Citi Field.
- Eight of his 21 relief appearances have been for five or more outs and each of those outings have been scoreless...Is also one of five relievers to record at least six scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings.
- Has produced a run value of six with his sinker this season, tied for the sixth-best among qualified Major League pitchers.
