**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 5-1, going 2-1 against Chicago-AL and 3-0 against Los Angeles-AL...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game roadtrip with four against the Guardians tonight through Thursday, followed by three against the Red Sox at Fenway Park over the weekend.

☞ Twins are currently on a season-long three-game winning streak, seeking their first four-game winning streak since July 31-August 5, 2024 (1 at NYM, 3 vs. CWS, 1 at CHC).

☞ Twins are 7-4 in their last 11 games, winning three of their last four series.

☞ After starting the season 0-4, Minnesota has gone 12-12.

**RYAN KING:** The Twins shut out the Angels yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-0, completing their first sweep of the season and second shutout of 2025 (4/9 at KC - Ryan)... Joe Ryan (2-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 innings, with four hits allowed, one walk and 11 strikeouts — 10th career double-digit strikeout total and one short of his career-high (12 - 4/13/24 at DET)...Ryan had career-high 26 whiffs, second-most in MLB this season (Mackenzie Gore - 28)...the offense recorded nine hits, three coming from Carlos Correa, who hit his team-leading seventh double...Ty France drove in two runs, giving him 15 on the season, tying Byron Buxton for team-lead...the sweep for Minnesota marked their first since August 2-4, 2024 (CWS).

**ON GUARD:** The Twins are playing the Guardians today, for the first of 13 games in 2025...the Twins went 3-10 against Cleveland last season, going 2-4 at Target Field and 1-6 at Progressive Field...two of Minnesota's three wins on the season came in a doubleheader sweep on August 9 at Target Field...the other was a 4-1 win on September 17 at Cleveland.

☞ Twins haven't won a series against the Guardians since taking two of three from September 4-6, 2023 at Progressive Field.

☞ Of the 13 games played between these two teams last season, 12 were decided by three runs-or-fewer...Cleveland had nine wins in those instances and Minnesota had three.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .307 (39-for-127) with seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .496 slugging percentage and an .893 OPS in 34 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022 (since he joined the Twins)...in eight games last season, he hit .370 (10-for-27) with eight walks and a .514 on-base percentage against Cleveland pitching.

☞ Harrison Bader is 5-for-15 (.333) with three doubles, two home runs and a 1.308 OPS in five career regular season games at Progressive Field.

☞ Byron Buxton has 14 career home runs against the Guardians, his second most vs. any opponent (Chicago-AL - 23)...six have been hit at Progressive Field.

☞ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 69 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (91)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 55).

**STARTER STRENGTH:** Below are starters numbers in their first 10 games (March 27-April 7), compared to their last 18 games (since April 8), including MLB ranks in parenthesis:

**HOME SICK:** The Twins have gone 3-10 on the road this season, winning back-to-back games at Rate Field on April 1st and 2nd and a win on April 9 at Kansas City...they have a run differential of -19 on the road (38-57)...at home, they have gone 9-6 with a +17 run differential (68-51).

☞ Harrison Bader has 10 RBI on the road this season, tied for fourth-most in the AL.

**FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX:** Over his last 12 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits six times and is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with two doubles, two triples, four home runs, nine RBI, 12 runs scored, a .673 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS in that span.

☞ Buxton ranks in the 94th percentile in baseball in hard hit percentage (57.1%), in the 90th percentile in barrel percentage (17.5%), and the 88th percentile in bat speed (74.8).

☞ He has a 9.0% increase in his hard hit percentage from 2024 to 2025, improving from 48.1% to 57.1%...12th-best increase in the American League.

**C4 WHEEL DRIVE:** Over this last three games, Carlos Correa has six hits in his last 11 at-bats (.545) with one double, one walk and three RBI...below are his first 18 games (March 27-April 16), compared to his last nine games (since April 18):

ALSO: Correa's sixth inning single yesterday was hit at 112.6 mph, the hardest hit ball by a Twin this season...Correa has 25 balls hit at least 100 mph, second-most on the club (Buxton - 26)...of Correa's 25, 18 have resulted in an out, tied with Shohei Ohtani and Yandy Diaz for second-most in baseball, trailing Jarren Duran.

**PLUS-MINUS:** Through the Atlanta series on April 20, the Twins were at a 2025 low-water mark of -20 (75-95) in terms of run differential...over the last six games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +18 (31-13)...they now sit at -2 on the season (106-108).

**TY BREAKERS:** Ty France drove in two more runs yesterday afternoon, giving him 15 on the season, tying with Byron Buxton for team-lead...of those 15 RBI, 13 have come in his last 17 games, since April 9...since that date, the 13 RBI rank tied for third-most in the AL.

☞ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 25 RISP at-bats, his .414 RISP average is tied with Jarren Duran for second-best, trailing Gavin Lux (.423).

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** Trevor Larnach is hitting .293 (12-for-41) with one double, four home runs, 10 RBI, six walks, nine runs scored, a .396 on-base percentage, a .610 slugging percentage and a 1.006 OPS in his last 12 games.

☞ Over those 12 games (since April 14), he has an average exit velocity of 91.5 mph (MLB avg is 89.9 mph).

☞ He is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with a .750 slugging percentage against offspeed pitches this season.

**ROYCE ON REHAB:** Royce Lewis played in his second game on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul yesterday, going 2-for-3 with one RBI, playing seven innings at third base...St. Paul has the day off as they travel to Columbus for a doubleheader tomorrow...Royce has missed all 28 games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

**CONGRATS GARDY!:** Toby Gardenhire earned his 300th career managerial victory as the Triple-A St. Paul manager yesterday with a Saints 5-3 victory over Indianapolis...did you know, that Ron Gardenhire earned his 1,000th career managerial victory in this ballpark on April 5, 2014 — well, now you do.

- ☞ Making sixth start of the season and 94th career start...ninth start against the Guardians.
- ☞ Ober is 2-2 against Cleveland, posting a 2.20 ERA (45.0 IP, 11 ER), with five walks and 46 strikeouts in eight career starts.
- ☞ Allowed one run on eight hits in his last outing against the White Sox, with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings.

**SOMEWHERE OBER THE RAINBOW:** Last pitched on April 22 at Target Field vs. the White Sox, opposite Davis Martin...garnered his second win of the season, first time earning back-to-back wins since August 3-9, 2024...also recorded his third consecutive quality start...first time doing so since April 14-26, 2024...allowed one run (1 ER) on eight hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...escaped two innings without allowing a run with runners in scoring position.

- ☞ Lone run allowed came off a sacrifice fly from Jacob Amaya, scoring Edgar Quero.
- ☞ Recorded his most pitches (87), strikes thrown (62) and strikeouts (6) of the season.
- ☞ Has not had a 1-2-3 first inning yet this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on April 15 at Target Field vs. the Mets, opposite Tyler Megill...snagged his first win of the season in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed three runs (3 ER) on five hits (2 HR) in 6.1 quality innings, with no walks and five strikeouts...allowed no walks for the first time this season...recorded his most innings pitched and most strikes thrown so far this season.

- ☞ Snapped a five-game losing streak (over 10 starts) from August 26, 2024 - March 30, 2025, the longest losing streak of his career.
- ☞ Recorded back-to-back quality starts for the first time since September 1-7, 2024.
- ☞ Fanning Brandon Nimmo in the fourth inning, Ober marked his 500th career strikeout...he is the third pitcher in Twins history to achieve 500 strikeouts in his first 92 games, alongside Bert Blyleven (89 games) and José Berrios (91 games).

**VS. THE GUARDS:** In eight career starts vs. the Guardians, Ober has a 2.20 ERA (45.0 IP, 11 ER), with eight walks and 46 strikeouts...also has a .204 (33-for-162) opponent batting average...2.20 is his lowest ERA among opponents against whom he has at least four starts.

- ☞ Went 1-1 in three starts against Cleveland in 2024, posted a 3.71 ERA (17.0 IP, 7 ER), with three walks and 25 strikeouts...allowed seven runs off 14 hits (3 HR).
- ☞ His last start against Cleveland was September 18, 2024 at Progressive Field, where he allowed two runs on four hits, with no walks and 12 strikeouts (his career high).

**NO MORE NIGHTMARES?:** Went 4-6 in night games during the 2024 season, with a 4.78 ERA (96.0 IP, 51 ER), a .288 (51-for-354) opponent batting average and a .704 opponent OPS in 17 starts; compared to 8-3, with a 3.05 ERA (82.2 IP, 28 ER), a .193 (30-for-301) BAA and a .590 opponent OPS in 14 day game starts...so far this season, Ober is 2-0 in night games, allowing four runs off 13 hits (2 HR), with one walk and 11 strikeouts.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since debuting with the Twins, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.78 ERA (247.2 IP, 104 ER), 9.30 K/9, 2.18 BB/9 and 1.56 HR/9 in 47 starts at home compared to 11-13 with a 3.87 ERA (248.2 IP, 107 ER), 9.08 K/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 46 road starts...his last win on the road was July 27, 2024 at Detroit.

- ☞ Ober is 0-1 in his last five starts on the road, posting a 4.40 ERA (28.2 IP, 14 ER) with four walks and 31 strikeouts, allowing 14 runs off 22 hits (5 HR); compared to 2-1, 2.06 ERA (35.0 IP, 8 ER), with nine walks and 39 strikeouts, allowing eight runs off 18 hits (3 HR) in the previous five home starts.
- ☞ Ober is 3-3 in 10 starts facing division opponents on the road, posting a 3.99 ERA (56.1 IP, 25 ER), with six walks and 57 strikeouts...allowing a .219 (46-for-210) opponent batting average.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through five starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .350/.409/.525 in 40 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .246/.288/.492 in 61 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 92.4 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 38.7 percent compared to righties' 92.2 mph and 56.3 percent.

- ☞ Has a whiff rate of 25.6 percent and put-away percentage of 19.6 against lefties vs. 23.6 percent and 17.7 percent vs. righties.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 38% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He currently ranks ninth in baseball for extension...ranks eighth to last in baseball for exit velocity, with an average of 93.9, and the bottom three percent for max EV, with an average of 115.8.
- ☞ His changeup strikeout percentage is at a career high of 44.4 percent, while his 4-seamer strikeout percentage is tied for a career-low 13.3 percent.

**UNDER PRESSURE:** This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .238 (5-for-21), with two home runs, three walks and seven strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are 0-for-9 with two walks and three strikeouts.

**FIXING THE FASTBALL:** Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through four starts this season, opponents continue to have a higher hard hit percentage, but Ober has substantially lowered opponent batting average and slugging percentage...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS PADDACK (2025: 0-3, 6.45 ERA // CAREER: 27-27, 4.48 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Paddack is set to make his sixth start of the season tomorrow night against the Guardians...last pitched on April 24 vs. the White Sox and took the loss in Minnesota's 0-3 defeat; allowed two runs off five hits, with four walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...is making his second career start against Cleveland...his sole start against the Guardians came May 19, 2024 where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 defeat...allowed two runs on three hits, with no walks and six strikeouts in a career-high 8.0 innings.
