Henry Aaron

Fifty years ago tonight, April 8, 1974, Henry Louis Aaron clubbed the 715th home run of his Hall-of-Fame career, eclipsing Babe Ruth's record for the most home runs in baseball history.

Aaron played 23 major league seasons and hit 755 total home runs, now the second most all-time.

He debuted with the Braves as a 20-year-old in 1954 and spent the next 21 seasons in a Braves uniform. "Hammerin' Hank," who also had a record 20 seasons of 20-or-more homers, homered off 310 different pitchers, including 13 fellow Hall-of-Famers. When he retired, he held major-league career records in extra-base hits (1,477), total bases (6,856) and RBI (2,297) – the latter two he still holds today.

To mark the 50th anniversary, the Atlanta Braves, Major League Baseball, and their partners will host events and celebrations throughout the day.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets tonight open a four-game series with what is the first of 13 total games between the teams this season...The two next meet for a three-game set at Citi Field in New York, May 10-12.

Atlanta went 10-3 in 13 games with New York last season, a .769 winning percentage...Since the Mets were founded in 1962, the best single-season winning percentage the Braves have logged against New York is .778, going 14-4 in 18 games with the Mets in both 1964 and 1966.

The Braves have won 16 of the last 20 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 138-73 (+65) over the stretch.

The Braves have taken the season series from their N.L. East rivals for six consecutive seasons...Prior to last year's 10-3 mark, they went 10-9 in both 2022 & 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 61-38 (.616) against New York overall.

Atlanta went 5-1 against New York here at Truist Park last season...Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 35-23 (.603) against the Mets here.

RH Charlie Morton is set for his 23rd career appearance against New York and his 22nd start...The 6-foot-5, 215-pound right-hander is 6-6 with a 3.58 ERA (47 ER/118.0 IP) in his career versus New York, including a 2-1 mark with a 3.27 ERA (8 ER/22.0 IP) in four such starts last season...In his most recent turn versus New York, August 23 of last year, he tossed 7.0 shutout innings and fanned 11.

RH Julio Teheran is set to make his Mets debut in the start tonight, and pitches against his former club for the third time in his career...The 6-foot-2, 205-pound native of Cartagena, Colombia made 229 appearances, 226 starts, for Atlanta from 2011-2019, compiling a 77-73 record with a 3.67 ERA (554 ER/1360.0 IP) and a pair of All-Star honors...He went 0-1 with an 8.18 ERA (10 ER/11.0 IP) in two turns versus Atlanta with the Brewers last season.

WIN: Atlanta beat Arizona, 5-2, yesterday afternoon to complete a three-game sweep of the Diamondbacks...The Braves have yet to lose at home this season.

This season marks the fourth time in the eight-year history of Truist Park that the Braves have swept their first home series of the year...The club also did so in 2017 vs. San Diego (four games), 2019 vs. Chicago-NL (three games) and 2020 vs. Tampa Bay (two games).

In the Atlanta-era (since 1966), the Braves have won their first three home games of a season on 11 occasions...The club's best home-opening win streak was a 10-game run to begin the 1983 campaign.

Atlanta improved to 4-1 (.800) in day games this season.

BULLPEN: Three Braves relievers - Joe Jiménez, Tyler Matzek and Pierce Johnson - combined to pitch 3.2 scoreless innings in yesterday's win, and the Atlanta bullpen collectively did not allow a run versus Arizona on the weekend.

Atlanta relievers have pitched 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings, dating to their opening frame against Arizona.

The Braves had just one longer such streak last season, compiling 18.1 scoreless innings from May 30 to June 7.

Atlanta's bullpen has pitched to a 1.87 ERA (7 ER/33.2 IP) over eight games this season, best in the National League and fifth lowest in all of baseball...It has allowed opponents to bat just .171/.248/.248 with a .496 OPS.

The Braves are a perfect 3-0 when leading after seven innings this season.

OLSON AT HOME: Atlanta native Matt Olson went 1-for-4 with a solo home run yesterday afternoon, and has hits in each of his three home games this season...He is a career .269/.369/.561 hitter at Truist Park.

Olson has hit safely in each of his last 19 games at Truist Park, dating to August 23, 2023...It's the longest active streak by any player at their home venue.

He has eight extra-base hits through eight games this season, collecting five doubles and three homers...Since his first full major league season in 2018, his 387 extra-base hits are fourth most in baseball.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL: In its eight games this season, Atlanta has scored 56 runs and allowed 30 (+26), good for the best run differential in the National League and tied for the second best in Major League Baseball (also Boston).

Cleveland currently paces the majors with a +32 mark.

Besides Atlanta, the other four members of the N.L. East are each sub-zero in that regard, combining for a -63 run disparity.

Despite playing host to the team with the best mark in N.L., the East cumulatively owns a -37 run differential, the worst of any division in MLB.

HENRY AARON CONT.: The Braves tonight will honor the 50th anniversary of Hank Aaron breaking Babe Ruth's home run record.

Aaron finished his Hall-of-Fame career with numerous accolades, including 25 All-Star selections, three Gold Glove awards, two batting titles and the 1957 National League MVP award.

Elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1982, he received MVP votes in 19 consecutive seasons from 1955-73.

- A* Set to make his first start at Truist Park this season and 15th of his career against Arizona.
- A* Pitched to a 3.23 ERA in 13 starts at home last season...It was the lowest ERA in the Braves rotation last year.
- A* Made his fifth career start against Chicago (AL) in his last turn.
- A* Earned the win scattering three hits over 5.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts.
- A* Morton improved to 5-0 with a 2.08 ERA in five combined starts against the White Sox.
- A* Prior to his last outing, all four starts came as a member of a different organization (Pittsburgh - 2015, Houston - '18, Tampa Bay - '19 & Atlanta - '23).
- A* Morton is the only player in the Modern Era to win four games in four starts against Chicago with four different teams.
- A* Joined Freddy García as the only pitchers since 1900 to go 4-0 in four starts against a single opponent with four different franchises (Seattle, Chicago (AL), New York (AL) & Philadelphia - against Cincinnati).

- A* Morton became the 13th player in franchise history to start a game at age 40 or older.
- A* Prior to Morton, the last Braves pitcher to start a game over the age of 40 was R.A. Dickey in 2017.
- A* Six of the 12 other pitchers have been selected into the Hall of Fame (Tom Glavine, Phil Niekro, Gaylord Perry, John Smoltz, Warren Spahn and Cy Young).
- A* Morton and Chris Sale become the first pair of teammates to have each made an Opening Day start and record the last out of a World Series since Hall-of-Famer Dennis Eckersley and Cy Young award-winner Bret Saberhagen with Boston in 1998.
- A* Morton was the Opening Day starter for Tampa Bay in 2020 and induced a groundout from Corey Seager for the final out in Game 7 of the 2017 World Series with Houston.
- A* Sale was the Opening Day starter for the Red Sox (2018-'19) and the White Sox (2013, '14 & '16)...He struck out Manny Machado in Game 5 as the final out of the 2018 Fall Classic with Boston.

2023 Recap

- A* Started 30 games in his 16th major league season and pitched to a 3.64 ERA (66 ER/163.1 IP) while going 14-12 with 183 strikeouts.
- A* His 14 wins were tied for fifth most in the National League.
- A* Since 2019, Morton's teams have won 79 of his starts; tied for fifth most in the majors during that span...Trailing teammate Max Fried who has 81.
- A* Became the fifth pitcher in franchise history to start at least 30 games at age 39 or older, joining Hall-of-Famers Warren Spahn, Phil Niekro, and John Smoltz as well as R.A. Dickey.
- A* This past season season marked the fifth time in Morton's career in which he made at least 30 starts.
- A* Since 2018, Morton's 166 games started are tied for the seventh most in the majors.
- A* Is one of 20 pitchers in major league history to start at least 30 games in each season between the ages of 37 and 39.
- A* Morton has recorded at least 30 starts in five seasons dating to 2018, the most in the majors among active pitchers over the age of 34.
- A* Justin Verlander ranks second with three such seasons while Yu Darvish, Zack Greinke and Kyle Gibson are tied for third with two each.
- A* His 32% swing and miss rate finished fourth highest among qualifiers in MLB.
- A* Teammate Spencer Strider led the league with a rate of 38.6%
- A* Joined Hall-of-Famers Warren Spahn and Phil Niekro as the only pitchers age 39 or older with at least two separate streaks of four or more consecutive games won in franchise history.
- A* Struck out 10 New York (AL) hitters through 6.0 scoreless frames on August 16.
- A* At age 39 years and 277 days old, Morton joined Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro and John Smoltz as the only pitchers of that age or older in Braves franchise to fan at least 10 hitters while tossing 6.0 shutout innings.
- A* Went 4-1 with a 1.91 ERA in the month of August.
- A* The ERA was the second lowest in the majors and the four wins were tied for the third most in MLB for the month.
- A* His 1.91 ERA was a career low in the month of August for Morton.
- A* Recorded 10 and 11 strikeouts in consecutive outings on August 16 & 23.

- A* Became the 20th player in major league history (live ball era) at age 39 or older to strikeout 10 or more hitters in consecutive games and first since Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz in 2008.
- A* Morton has recorded 604 strikeouts since joining Atlanta's staff in 2021, the fourth most in the National League and seventh most in baseball.
- A* Morton has struck out 397 hitters with his curveball since the beginning of the 2020; the most in the majors.
- A* Morton was placed on the 15-day injured list on September 24 (retro to September 23) with right index finger inflammation.

Career Recap

- A* A 16-year major league veteran, he has compiled a 130-113 record and a 4.00 ERA (871 ER/1960.1 IP) across 353 games, 352 starts...Has fanned 1,880 and pitched three shutouts.
- A* Has pitched for Atlanta (2008, '21-23), Pittsburgh (2009-15), Philadelphia (2016), Houston (2017-18) and Tampa Bay (2019-20).
- A* Is a two-time All-Star (2018 & 2019) and won the 2017 World Series while with Houston and 2021 World Series with Atlanta.

Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 30 yrs • #49

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/2 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 1/1

- 2024 marks his eighth different MLB season...Pitched for the Chicago White Sox from 2017-'23.
- Made his Braves debut on March 29 at Philadelphia, giving up a run while striking out a pair of Phillies.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.
- In 2019, pitched to a 2.13 ERA (16 ER/67.2 IP) with 60 strikeouts and 24 walks.

Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 2/1 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- From 2021-present, owns a 2.21 ERA (31 ER/126.1 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.02 ERA (26 ER/33.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)...Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).
- Needs 18 more strikeouts to reach 1,000.
- Enters his 17th season in the major leagues...Pitched in 36 games for Atlanta last season and posted a 1.56 ERA (6 ER/34.2 IP)...Made one start on May 20 versus Seattle.
- Last season, missed 82 games due to a left shin contusion he sustained on June 14 at Detroit...Was hit by a 99.6 mph grounder off the bat of Miguel Cabrera.
- At the time of his injury, Chavez' 1.69 ERA (5 ER/26.2 IP) in relief ranked fourth in the majors (min. 30 games)... Only Felix Bautista (BAL, 1.16), Carlos Estévez (LAA, 1.50) and Tim Lincecum (TOR, 1.54) had better marks... Season-long, among pitchers with at least 30 outings, Chavez' ERA (1.56) ranked eighth in the majors.
- Last season, his first 10 outings were scoreless for the first time in his 16-season career.
- Posted a 13.2-inning scoreless streak from May 20-September 24...At the time, it was the sixth-longest active streak in the National League and the 12th-longest in Major League Baseball.

Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #26

- Enters his 10th major league season...Appeared in 58 games in 2023 and went 33-for-37 in save opportunities... Pitched to a 2.75 ERA (17 ER/55.2 IP).
- Was named National League Reliever of the month for August 2023 after he pitched 13 scoreless appearances within the month...In 13.0 innings, struck out 17, walked four and allowed only seven hits.
- His 190 career saves rank fifth among active players...Kenley Jansen (421), Craig Kimbrel (417), Aroldis Chapman (321) and Edwin Díaz (205) are the only active pitchers with more.
- Since 2017, his 409 appearances rank fourth in the majors.

Joe Jiménez • RHP • 6-3 • 277 • 29 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 4/4 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 1/0

- Began his eighth season in MLB...In 59 games for the Braves last season, his first with the club, pitched to a 3.04 ERA (19 ER/56.1 IP) – the best mark of his career.
- Pitched to a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2 IP) in seven spring exhibition games.
- On November 2, 2023, agreed to a three-year contract worth \$26 million to remain with Atlanta through 2026.
- From May 20-August 28, held opponents homerless over 33 games and 32.2 innings...At the time, was the sixth-longest active streak in Major League Baseball...Pitched to a 1.65 ERA in that span, with 42 strikeouts against 10 walks.
- From May 27-August 28, logged a 1.20 ERA (4 ER/30.0 IP) in 30 games...Among National League pitchers with as many appearances in that timeframe, his ERA ranked third behind Hoby Milner (MIL, 1.06) and Brusdar Graterol (LAD, 1.09).
- His Whiff Rate (32.2%), Strikeout Rate (30.7%) and Walk Rate (5.9%) each ranked in the top 15 percent of pitchers in 2023.

Pierce Johnson • RHP • 6-2 • 202 • 32 yrs • #38

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 5/4 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Last night logged his first save as a member of the Braves, and his first since June 30, 2023 while with Colorado.
- Has thrown his curveball on 81.8% of pitches this season (63 total).
- Began his seventh season in Major League Baseball...Last season was acquired by Atlanta from Colorado on July 24 in exchange for minor-league pitchers RHP Tanner Gordon and RHP Victor Vodnick...Between the two teams, pitched in 67 games and posted a 4.02 ERA (28 ER/62.2 IP).
- On October 25, 2023, agreed to a two-year contract worth \$14.25 million, with a \$7 million club option for 2026 that includes a \$250,000 buyout.
- Pitched to a 0.76 ERA (2 ER/23.2 IP) after debuting for Atlanta on July 26 last season...Among pitchers with at least 20 outings in that time, his ERA ranked third in the National League sixth in the majors.
- In Johnson's 24 games with the Braves, he posted his lowest ERA in any 24-game span in his entire career...Also walked the fewest batters (5) out of any 24-game span.

Dylan Lee • LHP • 6-3 • 214 • 29 yrs • #52

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/2 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/1

- Has pitched in parts of four major-league seasons...Pitched in 24 games for the Braves last season and logged a 4.18 ERA (11 ER/23.2 IP)...Made one start on May 10 versus the Boston Red Sox.
- Pitched in 20 games for Atlanta last year before he landed on the 60-day injured list with left-shoulder inflammation...Prior to the injury, pitched to a 3.10 ERA (7 ER/20.1 IP).
- Among pitchers with at least 20 games last year, Lee's 70.1% Strike Rate finished as the second-highest in the National League and the seventh-highest in baseball.
- Didn't allow an earned run in any of his first 11 games last season, striking out 12 and walking three...In that time, allowed one unearned run and allowed opponents to hit just .111 off him.

Tyler Matzek • LHP • 6-3 • 230 • 33 yrs • #68

- Last Saturday made his season debut, appearing in his sixth different MLB season...Appeared with Colorado from 2014-'15 before pitching for the Braves from 2020-'22...Missed the entire 2023 season due to UCL reconstruction surgery...Prior to Saturday, last appeared in a major league game on October 5, 2022 at Miami.
