- Transferred to the 60-day injured list RHP Graham Ashcraft, who tomorrow is scheduled for surgery to relieve a stress reaction in his right big toe.

- Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs Kyle Farmer's first-place Twins and Game 1 of a 7-day, 6-game homestand that includes Thu's off day followed by a weekend series vs the Pirates.
- Prior to tonight's game, Farmer will receive his 2022 Ernie Lombardi Award as the Reds' Most Valuable Player and the Joe Nuxhall Good Guy Award.
- Enjoying the game with their families are 2023 draft picks RHP Rhett Lowder (1st round), RHP Ty Floyd (CBA) and IF Sammy Stafura (2nd round).
- The Reds are coming off a 4-2 road trip (2-1 at Det, 2-1 at NYM).
- Following this homestand, the Reds will finish the season with a 5-game road trip to Cle's Progressive Field (2g) and StL's Busch Stadium (off day, 3g).

### **SERIES NOTES**

- The Reds are 16-15 all-time vs the Twins, including 4-4 at Great American **Ball Park**
- A 2-1 series win in April 2018 snapped a streak in which the Reds had lost 9 consecutive interleague road series of at least 3 games, dating back to September 2013.
- With a 7-2 win at Target Field on 9/25/20, the Reds clinched their most recent Postseason berth, their first since 2013.
- During that 2020 COVID-19 season, the Reds were the only road team to win a series at Target Field, where the Twins finished with the best home record in the Major Leagues at 24-7.

- bases each (Elly De La Cruz, Matt McLain, Spencer Steer).
  - For the first time since 1890, when Cincinnati joined the NL, 3 Reds rookies have produced at least 10 HR. IF Matt McLain (5/22-5/28) and IF Elly De La Cruz (6/19-6/25) each earned National League Player of the Week awards,
- McLain in the second week of his career and De La Cruz in his third week.

### 100 LOSSES

The Reds are trying to become the first team ever to win a division after losing at least 100 games the season before (62-100) and only the third team ever to make the playoffs following a 100-loss season (2017 Twins. 2020 Marlins)...last year, the Reds were 59-92 after 151 games and 59-93 after 152 games.

### ROLLER COASTER

From 4/24-7/31 the Reds went 52-34 (.605). the second-best record in the **Major Leagues** behind the **Braves** (53-29, .646)...through games of July 31, the Reds led the NL Central by 1.5 games over the Brewers and by 5.0 games over the third-place Cubs...followed that 3-month hot stretch with a 10-17 August and began September in third place, 6.0 games behind the Brewers and 3.0 games behind the Cubs ... are 9-7 so far in September and won 5 of their last 7 games.

# KOMEBACK KIDS

The Orioles lead the Major Leagues with 47 come-from-behind wins, followed by the Reds with 46...the Reds won 24 games in their final plate appearance, including 10 walkoff wins...the single-season club record for comeback wins in a season is 54, held by the 1976 Big Red Machine.

Following Wed's start at Det was returned to Louisville as a substitute player to make room on the roster for RHP Ben Lively, who was reinstated from the COVID-19 injured list.
- Didn't pitch for the Bats before he rejoined the Reds today.
- Was a non-roster invitee to 2023 Major League spring training camp.
- Prior to his 9/2 promotion went 4-5, 3.86 with 1 save in 24 starts and 1 relief appearance for Class AA Chattanooga and Class AAA Louisville.
