PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (22-23) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (24-21) May 16, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - Game #46/Home #25 LHP Christopher Sánchez (4-2, 2.11 ERA) vs. RHP Bubba Chandler (1-4, 4.62 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have split the first four games of this six-game homestand vs. Colorado (2-1, Tuesday-Thursday) and Philadelphia (0-1, Friday-Sunday) after losing to the Phillies, 11-9, in 10 innings on Friday...Will host Philadelphia for two more games (Saturday-Sunday) during MLB Rivalry Weekend before embarking on a six-game road trip to St. Louis (May 19-21) and Toronto (May 22-24)...Are in the 21st game of a stretch of 25 straight games vs. the National League (last interleague game was on April 23 at Texas)...Have the second-best stolen base percentage in MLB (88.0, 44-for-50).

HOME-R HAPPY: Pittsburgh has hit 26 home runs at PNC Park this season after Brandon Lowe (two) and Marcell Ozuna went deep on Friday vs. Philadelphia...The Pirates are on pace to hit 87 home runs at home this year, which would be their most in a season at PNC Park (since 2001), surpassing the current high of 81 (2003)...It would also be their most home runs at home since hitting 91 home runs at Three Rivers Stadium in 1999...Pittsburgh's 49 home runs at home last year were the fewest in Major League Baseball (Washington, 68, ranked 29th) and were tied with 2011 for their fewest in any full season in PNC Park's history.

THE TIME IS LOWE: Brandon Lowe connected for his third multi-homer game of the season on Friday vs. Philadelphia (also March 26 at New York-NL and April 12 at Chicago-NL)...He is the first Pirate with three multi-homer games in a season since Jack Suwinski (four) in 2023...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Lowe is the first Pirate since at least 1900 with three multi-homer games through his first 39 games of a season, as well as through his first 39 games with the team...His three multi-homer games are tied with Los Angeles (NL)'s Max Muncy and Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the second-most in Major League Baseball, behind Colorado's Mickey Moniak (four)...His seven games with multiple extra-base hits are tied with Moniak for the most in all of MLB.

SIX PACK: The Pirates scored six runs in the third inning on Friday vs. Philadelphia, marking their third inning with at least six runs this season (they scored 10 runs in the sixth inning on April 13 vs. Washington and six runs in the seventh inning on May 9 at San Francisco)...Pittsburgh had just four innings with at least six runs scored in the 2025 season...The Pirates' 229 runs scored so far this year rank fourth in all of Major League Baseball, trailing Atlanta (240), Washington (239) and Chicago-NL (230)...Their six-run third inning on Friday was their highest-scoring inning vs. the Phillies at home since July 4, 2010 (seventh inning, six runs).

POKED THE BEAR: Marcell Ozuna hit his fifth home run of the season with his two-run blast (off Aaron Nola) in the third inning on Friday vs. Philadelphia...His 28 career home runs against the Phillies are the third-most among all active Major League players, behind only Los Angeles (NL)'s Freddie Freeman (34) and New York (AL)'s Giancarlo Stanton (30)...Ozuna has gone 18-for-63 (.286) with three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI and nine runs scored in his last 16 home games (since April 13 vs. Washington).

INDISPENCEABLE: Spencer Horwitz went 2-for-4 with a run scored on Friday vs. Philadelphia (he also stole the first base of his Major League career and first since April 7, 2024 with Triple-A Buffalo at Worcester in the sixth inning)...He is 13-for-37 (.351) with five doubles, a triple, nine RBI, six walks, a steal, four runs and a .983 OPS in his last 11 games (since May 2 vs. Cincinnati)...He ranks eighth in MLB in OBP (.442) and 10th in batting during that stretch.

THE OUTFIELD: Pirates outfielders have recorded 78 RBI so far this season (Oneil Cruz has 32 RBI, Ryan O'Hearn has 24 RBI, Bryan Reynolds has 21 RBI and Jake Mangum has one RBI)...Their 78 RBI from outfielders rank third in Major League Baseball, behind only Los Angeles-NL (80) and New York-AL (80)...Pittsburgh's 202 RBI from outfielders in 2025 ranked 22nd in all of MLB.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz went 2-for-4 with two RBI, a walk, a stolen base and a run scored on Friday vs. Philadelphia...He is batting .286 (16-for-56) with four doubles, a home run, six RBI, five walks, six stolen bases, a hit by pitch and 12 runs scored in his last 13 games (since May 1 vs. Cincinnati)...Cruz has become one of just three Major League players since 1920 (when RBI became an official statistic) to have at least 10 home runs, 32 RBI and 16 stolen bases through their first 43 games of a season...He joined St. Louis' Lou Brock (1967) and Cincinnati's Eric Davis (1987) as the only players to do that.

 May 16, 2024: Jared Jones improved to 3-4 after allowing three runs and striking out seven batters over 6.0 innings of work in the Pirates' 5-4 win over the Cubs at Wrigley Field. Nick Gonzales connected for his second home run with a solo shot off Justin Steele in the fourth inning, while Edward Olivares also hit a two-run blast off Steele in the first inning. Bryan Reynolds also had an RBI double in the victory.

LAST TIME OUT: Chandler had a no-decision after allowing two runs and striking out three batters in 5.0 innings in Pittsburgh's 12-inning loss on May 10 at San Francisco.

GET BACK ON TRACK: Chandler is looking to snap a three-game losing streak (began on April 23 at Texas) today vs. Philadelphia...Pittsburgh has scored a total of six runs while he has been in the game during his last four outings...The Pirates have scored one or zero runs while he has been in the game in four of his eight starts so far in 2026.

FINISHING STRONG: Chandler went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA (16.2ip/2er), 19 strikeouts (zero walks issued), a .123 batting average against (7-for-57) and a 0.42 WHIP over his final three starts of the 2025 season, including 5.2 innings of one-run ball in his final start on September 27 at Atlanta (he is a native of Lawrenceville, GA, located approximately 30 miles from Truist Park)...He became the first Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) to make three consecutive starts with one or zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts...Chandler also joined Milwaukee's Corbin Burnes (four starts) in 2021, Arizona's Zac Gallen (three starts) in 2023 and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (three starts) last season as the only Major League pitchers during the Modern Era to make at least three consecutive starts with four or fewer hits allowed, one/zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts.

A BIT OF BOTH: Chandler went 2-1 with a 5.12 ERA (19.1ip/11er) in four starts and 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0ip/3er) in three relief appearances in 2025...Nine of the 11 runs he allowed as a starting pitcher came during his first career start (Sept. 7 vs. Milwaukee).

RELIABLE ROOKIES: Chandler (starter) and Braxton Ashcraft (reliever) each struck out six batters while issuing zero walks in Pittsburgh's 2-0 win last season on September 20 vs. the Athletics...They were the first pair of Pirates teammates during the Modern Era (since 1901) to each strike out six batters without issuing a walk in the same game... They were the ninth pair of Pirates since 1901 to both have six strikeouts in a game, the first since Chad Kuhl (eight)/Richard Rodríguez (six) on May 6, 2018 at Milwaukee.

DYNAMITE DEBUT: Chandler secured a 4.0-inning save in his Major League debut on August 22 vs. Colorado...He was the first Pirates pitcher to earn a save in his MLB debut (stat became official in 1969), and he was one of four Major Leaguers to earn a 4.0-inning save in his MLB debut, joining Boston's Bob Stanley (April 16, 1977 at Cleveland), St. Louis' Zack Thompson (June 3, 2022 at Chicago-NL) and San Francisco's Keaton Winn (June 13, 2023 at St. Louis)...He was the only one to not surrender a run.

FOUR YOUR INFORMATION: Chandler became one of two Pirates relievers since at least 1900 to pitch at least 4.0 innings in each of his first three outings (last year on August 22 vs. Colorado, August 27 at St. Louis and Sept. 2 vs. Los Angeles-NL), along with Carmen Hill in 1915 (the last Major League pitcher to do that prior to Chandler was Kansas City's Atlee Hammaker in 1981)...He also became one of three Major League pitchers since 1969 (when saves became official) to earn two wins and a save in his first three games (Minnesota's Tom Johnson in 1974/Cincinnati's Hector Carrasco in 1994).

SAVE (AND WIN) THE DAY: Chandler earned his first Major League win with 4.0 scoreless innings of relief last year on August 27 at St. Louis (second game)...He also earned his first Major League save with 4.0 scoreless innings of relief on August 22 vs. Colorado, making him one of five Major Leaguers (saves became official in 1969) to earn a win and a save in his first two games, joining Rick Waits (1973/1975), Bob Stanley (1977), Mardie Comejo (1978) & Mickey Weston (1989)...He was one of four MLB relievers in the Modern Era (since 1901) to begin a career with two outings of 4.0-plus scoreless innings (Hugh Bedient in 1912, Von McDaniel in 1957, Eric King in 1986).
