## NATIONALS NEWS

### MOVING ON

The Washington Nationals open a three-game series against the St. Louis Cardinals to Nationals Park on Monday night.

- Washington dropped Sunday's series finale to the Los Angeles Dodgers despite a strong outing by **Foster Grif-fin** (5.0 IP, 5 H, ER, HR, 3 BB, 6 SO) and homers from **Luis García Jr.** and **James Wood**.

### PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank third in Major League Baseball with 55 runs scored and rank among Major League clubs in batting average (.4th, .270), slugging percentage (5th, .429) and on-base percentage (6th, .340).

- The 55 runs are the most by any Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) ahead of the 2019, 2017 and 2014 Nationals who each scored 49 runs through the first nine contests...Looking ahead, the 2019 Nationals scored 59 runs through their first 10 games.

### OUT OF THIS WORLD

**CJ Abrams** has recorded 12 RBI this season, tied for the most in Major League Baseball and are the most in a player's first eight games to begin a season in team history (2005-pres.).

- Abrams has reached base safely in all eight games to start the season and has hit safely in six straight...He is 8-for-24 (.333) with three homers, 10 RBI, four walks, two stolen bases and seven runs scored during the streak.

### GO GO GARCÍA!

**Luis García Jr.** is 7-for-16 (.438) with two doubles, a triple, a homer, three RBI and two runs scored over his last four games...He's recorded at least one extra-base hit in three straight games.

### DAYLEN'S DAYS

**Daylen Lile's** 12 hits are tied for third-most in the National League...He has hit safely in seven of the first nine games to start the 2026 season, going 12-for-40 (.300) with three doubles, three RBI, two walks and seven runs scored.

- Since June 21, 2025, he ranks fourth among all hitters with a .321 batting average.
- The reigning National League Player and Rookie of the Month, Lile paced National League in OPS (1.212), slugging percentage (.772), batting average (.391) and triples (7) during September 2025.

### HITTERISH

**Joey Wiemer**, who was acquired off waivers in the offseason after he was designated for assignment twice, is 10-for-21 (.476) with a triple, two homers, four RBI, five walks and seven runs through the first six games of the season...He's reached base safely in five of the six games.

- Wiemer reached base in each of his first 10 plate appearances to start the season to match **Carlos Delgado** in 2002 for reaching in the most consecutive plate appearances to start a season since 1920, per *Elias Sports Bureau*...He fell just two plate appearances shy of the Nationals record for most consecutive plate appearances reaching base safely overall: 12 by **Juan Soto** from Sept. 21-24, 2021.

### PAUL TOBONI

**Paul Toboni** was named President of Baseball Operations on Oct. 1, 2025...Widely regarded as one of the best young executives in baseball, Toboni brings a fresh voice to the organization, providing valuable experience in scouting and player development to build around the Nationals' talented core of young star players.

- Toboni comes to the Nationals from the Boston Red Sox, where he most recently held the title of senior vice president, assistant general manager...In his time with Boston, Toboni oversaw player development at the Major and Minor League levels, as well as the MLB First-Year Player Draft and was one of the key voices in the organization's larger baseball operations strategy.

### BLAKE BUTERA

**Blake Butera** was named Washington's eighth field manager on October 31, 2025 after spending the previous two seasons as the senior director of player development for the Tampa Bay Rays...He served as the Rays' Minor League field coordinator in 2023 following four seasons (2018-19, 2021-22) as a manager in their Minor League system.

- At Single-A Charleston, Butera was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2021 and 2022, won the Carolina League championship both seasons and the 2022 club was named Minor League Team of the Year by *Baseball America*.
- He began his coaching career with the Rays organization in 2017 as the bench coach for Single-A Hudson Valley and was promoted to manager in 2018, becoming the youngest manager in all of Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.

### PITCHER OF THE WEEK!

Rochester left-handed pitcher **Andrew Alvarez** was named International League Pitcher of the Week on Monday after striking out 10 batters in 5.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball last Thursday night...It was his third career 10+ strikeout game and first since Sept. 22, 2024 vs. Iowa (CHC).

### MIGHTY MIGUEL

Fredericksburg right-handed pitcher **Miguel Sime Jr.** made his professional debut on Sunday...He struck out six batters in 2.1 innings of one-hit, one-run ball...Two of the strikeouts topped out at 101.3 and 101.1 MPH...Sime Jr. was selected in the fourth round of the 2025 First-Year Player Draft out of Poly Prep in Brooklyn, New York.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

**APRIL 6 (3-8)**  
2005 – The Washington Nationals earned the organization's first victory, a 7-3 decision over the Philadelphia Phillies at Citizens Bank Park. The Nationals trailed, 3-2, heading to the top of the eighth inning before scoring four runs in the eighth inning and one in the ninth. **Brad Wilkerson** hit for the cycle for the second time in his career. **Joey Eischen** (1.0 IP) earned the first win in Nationals history, while **Vinny Castilla** (4-for-5, 2 2B, RBI, R) and **Jose Guillen** (2-for-5, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R) also provided offensive support.

# CAREER

*Veteran starter is one of just 12 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 60 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.75 since the beginning of 2024.*

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-23 with a 3.67 ERA in 75 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
- His 4.2% walk rate since the start of 2023 is the fifth-best mark in MLB.

## LAST START

Littell took the loss last Tuesday at Philadelphia...He came out of the bullpen in the second inning to throw 5.0 innings and allow three earned runs (two homers) on six hits with one strikeout.

- It was his first relief appearance since Sept. 29, 2023 at Toronto.

## vs. ST LOUIS

Littell has faced the Cardinals 11 times (three starts) in his career...He has 17 strikeouts and only three walks in 28.0 innings of work.

## 2026 SPRING TRAINING

Littell made two starts for Washington in 2026 Spring Training after signing on March 10.

- He struck out five in 5.2 innings of work and allowed four hits.

## 2025

*He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.*

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
- Made his Reds debut on Aug. 5 at Chicago (NL)...Became the fifth pitcher in Reds history with at least 7.0 innings, one run or fewer allowed and at least eight strikeouts in his team debut (also: Brady Singer, 3/31/25 vs TEX; Johnny Cueto, 4/3/08 vs AZ; Mo Sanford, 8/9/91 at SD; Tom Seaver, 6/18/77 at MON).
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** Slider (27.5%) Split Finger (27.3%) Four Seamer (23.8%) Sinker (16.0%) Sweeper (5.4%)

## 2024

*In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.*

- Led the Rays in wins (T1st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (T1st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
- Went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (10 ER/49.1 ER) over his final nine starts from July 27 on and ranked second in the AL (4th in MLB) in ERA.
- Received two or fewer runs of support in 22 of 29 starts, including 17 of his final 20...His 3.22 run support average was the lowest in MLB and lowest in Rays history (prev. Tony Saunders, 3.51 in 1998).
- 2024 Pitch Mix:** Slider (34.8%) Split Finger (23.2%) Four Seamer (22.3%) Sinker (14.6%) Sweeper (5.1%)

## 2023

*Appeared in 28 games (4 starts) between the Red Sox and the Rays...Converted to the starting rotation with the Rays on July 19.*

- Ranked among MLB leaders after the All-Star break in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 0.89), walk rate (2nd, 2.4%) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 7.86).
- In 14 starts, went 3-5 with a 3.41 ERA (27 ER/71.1 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.
- Pitched in Game 2 of the AL Wild Card vs. Texas...Tossed 2.0 hitless innings and struck out three while hitting one batter

## 2021-22

*Spent two seasons working out of San Francisco's bullpen...Went 7-3 with three saves, 3.82 ERA in 102 relief appearances for the Giants.*

- Struck out 102 batters in 106.0 innings across the two seasons.
