THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Miami last week...

OFF WISCONSIN: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2... Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision...

THE BIG CHEESE: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the second of six games this season... Minnesota will travel to Wisconsin for three games...

Since 2020, the Twins have hit 41 home runs in 31 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent... they have homered 24 times over their last 17 games vs. the Crew.

"SERIES-LY SPEAKING" BY MIKE VASSALLO: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their sixth series win of the season... they have gone 5-8-1 in series play, 3-3-1 at home and 2-5-0 on the road...

FAST TIMES: Twins were held without a stolen base last night for the first time since last Saturday at Cleveland (May 9)... since that next game, on May 10, they have stolen 11 bases in five games.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Over his last 16 games, since April 23, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .309 (17-for-55) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 12 runs scored, 11 walks, a .418 on-base percentage...

STEADI-LEE ON THE RISE: Brooks Lee has 39 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (44)... below are Lee's first 22 games (March 26-April 22) compared to his numbers over his last 20 games (since April 23):

CASH IN CASH OUTMAN: James Outman went 1-for-3 last night and is now hitting .333 (7-for-21) with an .840 OPS over his last eight games with an at-bat... he began the season 0-for-his-first-18 through April 18.

THIS AND THAT: Brooks Lee has not committed an error in his last 32 games (120 total chances). Twins bullpen has gone 2-2, 3.23 ERA (30.2 IP, 11 ER) with a .244 opponent batting average over their last seven games.

LAWYER UP: Right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson is beginning his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul tonight... Laweryson has been on the 15-day Injured List since April 11 with a right forearm strain.

SENTIMENTAL SATURDAY: On May 16, 2025, the Twins went into Milwaukee, carrying an 11-game winning streak and in the middle of a club-record 34-scoreless inning streak... they won that night, recording their 12th-straight (eventually ending at 13) and extended the scoreless inning streak for their pitching staff to 24.1... also on this day in 2010, Jason Kubel hit an eighth-inning grand slam off Mariano Rivera for a 6-3 win at new Yankee Stadium... Rivera had converted a record-tying 51-consecutive save opportunities at home and had not given up a grand slam since 2002; the runs were also the first he allowed that season.

HBD, BLACK JACK: Hall of Famer Jack Morris is celebrating his 71st birthday today... during his 18-year major league career, he pitched one game on his birthday, that coming in 1987, pitching a complete game over Cleveland at Tiger Stadium, allowing three runs on five hits with 11 strikeouts... he shares a birthday with former University of Minnesota baseball coach John Anderson (71).

 ☞ Tonight, Prielipp will match up against his home state team, as he was born and raised in Tomah, WI, which sits about two hours northeast of downtown Milwaukee.

LAST TIME OUT: In his most recent outing, on May 8 at Cleveland, Prielipp took his first career loss after going 5.0 innings for the third straight time and allowing four runs (one earned) on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts...gave up all four runs in the first inning, the most runs he has given up in a single inning in his MLB career; of those four runs, only one was charged to Prielipp due to a Luke Keaschall fielding error with runners on first and second.

- ☞ **BOUNCING BACK:** After allowing the four runs in the first inning, Prielipp would strike out six of the next eight Guardians batters that he faced from the second inning-fourth inning...here is his line from innings two through five: 4.0 IP, 0 ER, 2 H, 2 BB and 6 K.
- ☞ **ONE OF TWO, EVER:** Through four career MLB outings, Prielipp has given up only 12 hits, while striking out 21; the only other Twins starter (1901-) to give up less than 12 hits and strikeout more than 21 in their first four career games is Joe Ryan (10 hits, 25 strikeouts).

TWO STARTS AGO: On May 2 vs. Toronto, Prielipp went 5.0 innings, giving up two runs on three hits (2 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts...left the game with the Twins leading 4-2, but did not factor into the final decision as the Twins lost 11-4 to the Jays.

- ☞ **HITS DON'T COME EASY - 111 YEARS:** In Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-), only one other starting pitcher other than Prielipp and Ryan began his career by allowing eight-or-fewer hits in his first three starts: George Dumont (23.0 IP, 7 H) in 1915.

ROOKIE RANKINGS: Prielipp has been a steady force in the Twins' rotation through his first four MLB starts...here is where he ranks in a few categories among MLB rookie starting pitchers (min. 19.0 IP).

MEET THE BREWERS: Tonight will be Prielipp's second career start against a National League opponent and first start against his home state's Brewers; a native of Tomah, WI, Prielipp went 6-2 with a 0.85 ERA and 118 strikeouts (21.7 SO/9) against just five walks (23.60 SO/BB) in 49.0 innings as a senior at Tomah High School en route to being named Wisconsin Gatorade Player of the Year in 2019.

BUILDING UP THE ENDURANCE: Prielipp has been slowly building his pitch count this season; after throwing 61 pitches in his first Triple-A start on March 27, his pitch count has steadily increased, throwing 80-or-more pitches in each of his four MLB starts, including a career-high 93 on May 8 at Cleveland...that is the most pitches he has thrown in a start as a professional and as a collegiate pitcher at Alabama (most - 78 pitches); in an effort to build him up wisely, the Twins have given him seven days of rest between starts heading into tonight.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through four games, Prielipp has started two at home and two on the road...at Target Field this season Prielipp is 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER), five walks, nine strikeouts and a 0.90 WHIP, while on the road he is 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER), two walks, 12 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP.

- ☞ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** In his minor league career, Prielipp went 2-2 with a 4.20 ERA (64.1 IP, 30 ER), 30 walks, 80 strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP in 18 home appearances (17 starts), and 1-8 with a 3.35 ERA (78.0 IP, 29 ER), 25 walks, 103 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 24 road appearances (23 starts).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through his first four MLB starts, lefties are slashing .200/.278/.467 (3-for-15) with one double, one home run, two walks and two strikeouts, while righties are slashing .170/.262/.321 (9-for-53) with two doubles, two home runs, five walks and 19 strikeouts against Prielipp.

- ☞ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In his four starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ **THE HEATER:** Among MLB starters, Prielipp's .118 (2-for-17) BAA on his 4-seam fastball is the third lowest in all of baseball (min. 20 PA and min. 300 total pitches on season); he trails Zack Wheeler (.083) and Paul Skenes (.092).

- ☞ **OVERALL BAA:** Prielipp's .176 (12-for-68) BAA currently ranks sixth in MLB among starters (min. 75 PA and min. 300 pitches); the five guys he trails are Paul Skenes (.145), Tyler Glasnow (.149), Shohei Ohtani (.161), Jacob Misiorowski (.162) and Shane Bieber (.168).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2026: 4-2, 3.46 ERA // CAREER: 35-32, 4.03 ERA)

Bailey Ober will take the mound tomorrow afternoon for the 10th time this season in the three-game series finale against the Brewers...Ober is coming off a complete-game shutout in his last start on May 12 vs. Miami; he became the 28th Twin to record a "Maddux" and finished with a final line of 9.0 innings pitched, two hits allowed, zero walks and seven strikeouts while throwing only 89 pitches (64 for strikes)...with the win in that May 12 start, Bailey now has quality starts in four of his last five outings and has lowered his ERA from 4.15 to 3.46 in that five-start span...tomorrow afternoon will be his third career start against Milwaukee; is 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks and 10 strikeouts in his first two career outings.

CAREER NOTES

- Upon call-up, currently ranked fifth in the Twins system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per MLB.com and ranked as the no. 81 prospect in baseball and fourth-best in Twins system by *Baseball America* (highest ranked pitcher)...ranked 94th-best prospect in baseball by *Baseball America* entering 2026.
- In 2025, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combined to go 1-9 with a 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks and 98 strikeouts in 24 appearances (23 starts).
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year...is the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).
- Ranked as having best slider and best changeup among Minnesota minor leaguers.
- Entering 2025, ranked seventh-best prospect in Twins organization by *Baseball America* entering 2025, and 21st by MLB.com.
- Began season at Double-A Wichita and pitched in short spurts, not going beyond the fourth inning and topping out at 76 pitches in a single outing for Wind Surge...despite innings restrictions, struck out at least five batters in nine of 19 starts.
- Among Texas Leaguers with at least 50.0 inning pitched, ranked ninth in the league in strikeout rate (27%) while holding the 13th-lowest walk-rate (7%).
- Named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after recording a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks (9.0 BB%) and 17 strikeouts (29.0 K%) across four starts.
- Promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 16, where he finished season.
- In 2024, ranked 16th-best prospect in the Twins farm system by *Baseball America* entering 2024 and was 21st by season's end...began season on 60-day Injured List with High-A Cedar Rapids...had rehab assignments with the FCL Twins and Low-A Fort Myers...was reinstated from the Injured List on July 22 and went 0-1, 3.26 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts in seven starts for the Kernels.
- In 2023, ranked as fifth-best prospect in Twins system entering 2023, per MLB.com...split the season between Rookie FCL Twins and High-A Cedar Rapids, posting a 6.75 ERA (6.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and seven strikeouts in two starts, was placed in the Injured List on April 10 with a left forearm strain, missing the remainder of the season...had Tommy John surgery on left elbow, a procedure performed by Dr. James Andrews.
- In 2022, did not begin his professional career immediately after being drafted by Twins in July...ranked as the fourth-best prospect in Twins system by MLB.com.
- Originally selected by Boston in 37th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Tomah High School, but elected to attend University of Alabama...selected by Twins in second round (48th overall) in 2022 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Matt Williams.
- Spent two seasons pitching at the University of Alabama from 2020-21, going 4-1, 0.96 ERA (28.0 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks and 47 strikeouts in seven starts.
- Did not allow a run in his first 26.2 innings of college baseball spanning the 2020 and 2021 campaigns.
- Finished his first season at UA with a perfect 0.00 ERA (21.0 IP) and a 3-0 record in four starts...struck out 35 compared to six walks and held opposing hitters to an SEC-low .077 average in 2020.
- Earned National Freshman Player of the Year accolades from Collegiate Baseball News following the pandemic-shortened campaign...also garnered first team All-America and Freshman All-America recognition from CBN.
- Became Alabama's 16th first team All-American in program history...selected as the "Impact Freshman of the Year" by Perfect Game USA and named D1Baseball.com's "Top Freshman Pitcher" following his rookie stint.
- Pitched at Tomah High School and was named the Gatorade Wisconsin Player of the Year as well as a Collegiate Baseball News First Team All-American as a senior in 2019 after going 6-2 with a 0.85 ERA and 118 strikeouts against just five walks in 49.0 innings as a senior.
