SUNDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles failed to sweep the Rangers with a 3-2 defeat...Anthony Santander hit a two-run home run in the eighth inning, his fourth homer in four games since July 14...Baltimore tallied five hits in the loss, including two from Colton Cowser.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won three of the last four games since July 14 after dropping a season-high-tying five consecutive games from July 9-13...At 60-39 (.606), the Birds own the second-best record in MLB behind the Phillies (.630, 63-37)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 161-100 (.617), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The 0's are 244-179 (.577) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.585, 248-176), Braves (.612, 259-164), and Dodgers (.638, 271-154).

This year marks the ninth time in Orioles history, including the second straight, with the team winning at least 60 of the first 99 games to begin a season, tied with 1964 and trailing 2023, 1997, and 1971 (61), 1970 (62), 1979 and 1966 (66), and 1969 (68).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 157 home runs, 11 more than the second-place Yankees (146) and 18 more than the Dodgers (139), who rank third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

Baltimore has an MLB-best eight players with at least 10 home runs, the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (28), **Anthony Santander** (27), **Adley Rutschman** (17), **Jordan Westburg** (16), **Colton Cowser** (13), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (12), and **Cedric Mullins** (10); the Birds have eight players to 10+ homers before the 100-game mark for the third time in team history, joining the 2000 and 1987 seasons.

Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 25 home runs, joining New York Al Agree, leader (25), this market the third time on 0's team has

York-AL's Aaron Judge (35) and Juan Soto (25); this marks the third time an O's team has had multiple players with 25+ homers through the first 100 games of a season, joining **Brady Anderson** (31) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (25) in 1996, and **Boog Powell** (27) and **Frank** Robinson (25) in 1969

The Orioles lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

The 0's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks third in MLB with 81 runs scored behind Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. and New York-AL's Juan Soto (82)...It's the most runs scored through the first 99 team games to begin a season in Orioles history...He scored three runs on Friday at Texas for the eighth time this year, two more than the next closest player (Witt Jr.)...Henderson's 15 such games since the start of 2023 are five more than any other player in that time...He's on pace to score 133 times, breaking the 0's record for runs in a season, set by Roberto Alomar in 1996 (132).

MASHED TATERS: Since the start of June, Anthony Santander is slashing .278/.326/.639 (47-for-169) with five doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 25 runs, 37 RBI, and 12 walks in 43 games... His 18 homers lead the majors while his 108 total bases are the second most behind Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. (199) during that span.

He drove in eight runs in the weekend series in Texas, tied for the second-most in a

series of any length in his career; he also drove in eight in a five-game series at Fenway Park from May 27-30, 2022 and tallied nine RBI in a home series against the White Sox from August 28-30, 2023.

Santander is the first Oriole with 18 home runs in a 43-game span since Chris Davis had

Santander is the first Uriole with 18 nome runs in a 40-game span since Units Davis had multiple overlapping stretches from late July to September 2015, most recently from July 30 to September 14; Davis' run included multiple 43-game stretches with 21 homers. With his first home run on Friday, Santander reached 25 home runs; he's the ninth player in 0's history to do so in at least three straight seasons, matching Frank Robinson (1969-71), Lee May (1976-78), and Manny Machado (2015-17), and trailing Eddie Murray (1982-85) and Rafael Palmeiro (1995-98), who did so in four consecutive years, Chris Davis (2012-17) and Cal Ripken, Jr. (1982-87), who had six, and Adam Jones (2011-17), who hit at least

25 homers in seven straight years.
He now has 15 multi-homer games, eighth-most in franchise history behind Frank Robinson (16), Brady Anderson (17), Chris Davis and Manny Machado (19), Eddie Murray and Boog Powell (20), and Cal Ripken, Jr. (21).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip tonight with the first of three games in Miami...The Orioles went 2-1 in Texas to open the trip...The O's are a league-best 30-17 (.638) on the road this year and 82-46 (.641) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .585 during that time.

O>> The Birds have won 10 of 15 road series to start this year; the .667 series winning percentage would be the best in club history ahead of the 2023 and 2012 teams, which

both won 17 of 26 (.654) series away from home.

AGAINST THE MARLINS: The Orioles and Marlins begin their first series in Miami since 2021 tonight...Baltimore swept a three-game series at Camden Yards last year and have now won four consecutive games between the teams for the first time in series history...The 0's are 13-28(.317) against the Fish since the teams first met in 1997, the lowest winning percentage against an

Santander scored the game-winning run in the fifth inning after recording a single and later scoring on a two-run homer by Boston's Jarren Duran, who earned MVP.
