TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 7 -game homestand (5-1) with the last of 3 games against the Texas Rangers $(2-0)$... Seattle opened the homestand with a 4-game series win against the Chicago White Sox (3-1)...following today's series finale vs. Texas, Seattle will embark on a 10-day, 9-game odyssey to Cleveland (3 G, June 18-20), Miami (3 G, June 21-23) and Tampa Bay (3 G, June 24-26)...today's game will be televised live on ROOT SPORTS with Aaron Goldsmith and Mike Blowers on the call...the game will also be broadcast live on Seattle Sports (710 AM) with Dave Sims and Rick Rizzs.
ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners defeated the Rangers by a $7-5$ score in yesterday's game...the Mariners are $11-4$ over their last 15 games ( $5 / 31-c$ ) and $15-5$ over their last 20 games ( $5 / 26-c$ )...the Mariners are $32-5(.865)$ when scoring $4+$ runs in a game (2nd-best record in MLB)...Seattle is $32-3$ when out-hitting its opponent.

- Climbing The Ladder - Seattle (42-31) is a season-high 11 games above .500.
- Series-ly Sensational - Seattle has a 13-4-1 series record over its last 18 series (4/15-c).
- Running Through the 6 - The Mariners are 36-14 (.720) when their starting pitcher goes 6.0+ innings.
- Polo Update - INF Jorge Polanco began a rehab assignment yesterday with High-A Everett, going 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts as the designated hitter.
- Day of the Dads - The Mariners are 28-17 all-time on Father's Day.

BEST IN THE WEST...the Mariners (42-31) hold 1st place in the American League West Division by a season-high 7.5 games over the 2nd place Rangers (33-37) and 9.0 games over the 3rd place Astros (3238)...the Mariners have held 1st place for 35 consecutive days (5/12-c).

TERRIFIC AT T-MOBILE...Seattle has won 9 consecutive home series dating back to April $15 .$. Seattle's current streak of winning home series marks its longest within a single season since winning 10 consecutive home series from July 27-Oct. 7, 2001...during their current stretch, the Mariners are 22-6 (.786) at T-Mobile Park, 2nd-best home record in the Majors during that span and trailing only Philadelphia (.852/23-4)...overall this season, Seattle's 26-12 home record (.684) is 4th-best in MLB, trailing the Phillies (.730/27-10), Guardians (.724/21-8) and Yankees (.688/22-10).

THE J-ROD SHOW IS ROLLING...Julio Rodríguez went 2 -for- 5 with 1 home run, 2 RBI and 1 run in yesterday's game...over his last 21 games (5/25-c), Julio is batting . 305 ( $25 \times 82$ ) with 17 runs, 1 double, 5 home runs, $15 \mathrm{RBI}, 7$ walks and 7 stolen bases, getting on base at a .360 clip and slugging . 500 (. 860 OPS)...during that span, he has reached safely in 20-of-21 games and hit safely in 16-of-21, including 7 multi-hit games.
HOME PITCHING...Seattle pitchers hold a 2.60 ERA (100 ER, 346.0 IP) with 78 walks, 363 strikeouts and an 0.94 WHIP this season...Mariners pitchers lead the Majors at home in ERA, WHIP, SO/BB (4.65), BB/9 (2.03), Opp. OBP (.248), Opp. SLG (.316) and Opp. OPS (.564), ranking 3rd in SO/9 (9.44) and 2nd in Opp. AVG (.198)...Mariners starters this season are 17-10 with a 2.52 ERA ( 64 ER, 228.2 IP), 47 walks and 233 strikeouts at T-Mobile Park.
THE TALL MAN...Logan Gilbert is $3-4$ with a 3.19 ERA ( 32 ER, 90.1 IP), 20 walks, 84 strikeouts and a 0.97 WHIP, limiting opponents to a .209/.256/.363 slashline...among qualified AL starters this season, Gilbert ranks T-2nd in quality starts (11) 3rd in innings pitched, 6th in WHIP, 8th in Opp. AVG, T-10th in SO and 13th in ERA...Gilbert is 32-0 in his career when the Mariners score 3 or more runs while he is in the game.
NEVER DONE WITH ONE-RUN...Seattle is 17-7 (.708) in 1-run games, most 1-run wins in the big leagues.. Seattle's 1-run record is 2nd-best in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay (13-5/.722)...since Scott Servais took over as Mariners manager (2016-c), Seattle owns the most 1-run wins (231) and best 1-run winning percentage (.570/231-174) in the Majors during that span.
GARV SAUCE...Mitch Garver has reached base safely in 9 of his last 12 games (6/2-c), getting on base at a .413 clip, slugging .571 with a . 984 OPS, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 11 RBI and 11 walks during that span...his 11 walks in June are 3rd-most in the Majors, trailing only Juan Soto-NYY (14 BB) and Aaron Judge-NYY (12).
"CLUTCH" CAL RALEIGH...Cal Raleigh has 24 RBI in the 7th inning and later this season, most in MLB.. Raleigh is the only player in the Majors with 3 go-ahead or game-tying home runs in the 9th inning or later this season, and is also the only player with 2 go-ahead grand slams...Cal is toting a . 956 OPS in "Late \& Close" situations on Baseball-Reference, batting . $250(11 \times 44)$ with 3 doubles, 4 HR, 18 RBI and 8 walks.
STOP IT!...Seattle's infield defense has impressed with its . 986 fielding percentage ( 18 errors in 1,311 total chances) between 1B/2B/3B/SS ranking 2nd-best in the American League behind Minnesota (.987)...Josh Rojas' 6 Outs Above Average are the most among third basemen via Baseball Savant...J.P. Crawford leads MLB shortstops in fielding percentage (.994), committing just 1 error across 160 total chances.
ANDRÉS MUÑOZ: AL ALL-STAR?...right-hander Andrés Muñoz has 12 saves and a 1.55 ERA (5 ER, 29.0 IP) with 41 strikeouts and 10 walks in 28 appearances this season...Muñoz has posted a 0.966 WHIP and limited opposing hitters to a . 176 batting average...the 25-year-old is 1 of 3 American League pitchers with 12+ saves and a sub-2.00 ERA this season, along with Emmanuel Clase-CLE and Clay Holmes-NYY. THE NEXT HOMESTAND...following the upcoming road trip, the Mariners will return home for 9-game homestand from June 28-July 7, hosting the Minnesota Twins (3 G, June 28-30), Baltimore Orioles (July 2-4) and Toronto Blue Jays (July 5-7)...upcoming promotions the homestand are J.P. Crawford "City Connect" Bobblehead Night on June 28, Aloha Shirt Night on June 29, Bark at the Park on July 2, Patriotic Fireworks on July 3, Patriotic Cap on July 4 and Kids Run Around the Bases on June 30 and July 7.

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners are 16-5 (.762) against the AL West this season, going 3-0 against the Angels, 4-2 against the Athletics, 5-2 against the Astros and 4-1 against the Rangers so far in 2024, owning the best divisional record in the Majors, ranking ahead of Baltimore (17-6, .739), and... YOU MAY ALSO KNOW...the Mariners are on pace to set a franchise-best mark against the AL West, ranking ahead of their marks in 1994 (19-7, .731), 2001 (40-18, .690) and 2023 (33-19, .635), but...DID YOU KNOW? ...that the Mariners own a 136-88 (.607) record against the AL West since 2021, the 4th-best divisional record in the Majors during that span?...Seattle trails only the Dodgers (151-76, .665), Astros (147-84, .636) and Braves (140-87, .617) during that span.

## ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT.

- The 27 -year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make his 15 th start of the season and 2 nd against Texas....he will also make the 103 rd start of his MLB career and 12th career start against the Rangers.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB FirstYear Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Was named the 2022 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
LAST TIME OUT...ND on $6 / 10$ vs. Chicago-AL....he pitched 6.2 innings and allowed 3 runs on 6 hits ( 1 HR ) with 0 walks and 8 strikeouts...earned his 11th quality start of the season.
OUT ON THE RANGE...since the start of 2023, the right-hander has made 4 starts against Texas...in those outings he has a 2.16 ERA (6 ER, 25.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 9 walks ( 1 intentional)...Rangers batters have hit . 149 $(13 \times 87)$ in those contests with 4 doubles, 2 home runs and a 227 OBP...this is the lowest average against vs. Texas in the Majors over that span.
AMONG THE AL's BEST....among qualified AL pitchers this season, Gilbert ranks T-2nd in quality starts (11), 3rd in innings pitched (90.1), 6th in WHIP (0.97), 8th in Opp. AVG (.209) and T-10th in strikeouts (84).

EATING INNINGS...in each of his last 6 outings ( $5 / 14-\mathrm{c}$ ), he has gone $6.0+$ innings...this the 5 th-longest active streak in the Majors...during that span he has 5 quality starts.
GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD....he is posting a $67.8 \%$ 1st pitch strike rate, the highest of his career....among pitchers with $80.0+\mathrm{IP}$, this is the 4 th-highest in the Majors behind Tarik Skubal-DET (72.3\%), Joe Ryan (70.4\%) and George Kirby (69.7\%).
FEELING SUPPORTED...Gilbert is $32-0$ in his career when the Mariners score 3 or more runs while he is in the game...in those games the Mariners are 40-9.
100 AND COUNTING...made his 100th career start on $5 / 30$ vs. HOU....he had the 4th-most strikeouts (562) in a players' first 100 games with the franchise... behind only James Paxton (603), Randy Johnson (593) and Félix Hernández (575)...only 14 pitchers in franchise history have had each of their first 100 appearances be starts.
MARINERS MILESTONES...currently is tied for 13th in franchise history with 575 strikeouts with Gil Meche....Matt Young is 12th in the ranking with 597 strikeouts... he moved into the top-15 after striking out 5 batters on $6 / 5$ at OAK.
STRONG BEGINNINGS...Gilbert is 1 of 4 players in Major League history to have recorded 500.0 innings, $550+$ strikeouts and 140 -or-less walks in their first 100 career games...the list includes Noah Syndergaard-NYM, Masahiro Tanaka-NYY and Michael Pineda-NYY/SEA.
FAR FROM HOME.... has gone $6.0+$ innings in 6 of his 8 away starts this season...in those 8 starts, he has a 3.18 ERA (18 ER, 51.0 IP ) with 6 quality starts and 41 strikeouts.
ALL I DO IS WIN...over his career has made 54 starts away from T-Mobile Park...in those starts he is 24-7 for a .774 win percentage, the best in MLB history ( min .50 GS )...the next closest is Shane Bieber-CLE (37-14, .725).
QUALITY MIDSET... 11 of his 14 starts have been quality starts...he has gone 6.0+ innings in 12 of his 14 starts...the Mariners are 7-5 when he pitches in 6.0+ innings.
SITTING THEM DOWN...recorded $6+$ strikeouts in each of his first 7 starts this season (3/30-5/4), tied for a career-best streak (also: 4/1/23-5/8/23)...has $4+$ strikeouts in 13 of 14 starts this season, the only other Mariners pitcher to do so this season is Luis Castillo who has 13 in 15 starts.
LEFTY-RIGHTY...this season left-handed batters are hitting .205 ( $30 \times 146$ ) with 7 doubles, 3 home runs and

## 45 strikeouts.

GOOD STRETCH....went $3-0$ with a 1.02 ERA (4 ER, 35.1 IP), 11 walks and 35 strikeouts over 5 starts (4/10-5/4)...recorded a quality start in each outing during the span and limited opponents to a .137 ( $16 \times 117$ ) average and a .442 OPS.
INNINGS EATER...2nd among American League pitchers with 466.2 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season (Framber Valdez-HOU, 467.0 IP)...during that span he also ranks among qualified AL leaders in BB/9 (5th, 2.03), WHIP (6th, 1.10), Opp. AVG (12th, .230), ERA (T-11th, 3.41), SO/BB (7th, 4.26), fWAR (T-6th, 7.7) and LOB\% (8th, 76.4\%).
