TODAY'S GAME: SF attempts to level its final three-game series of the year this afternoon after falling to the Cardinals 6-3 last night.

- ▶ Last night's loss ensured the Giants can finish no better than .500 in 2024 and will need to win their final two games to do so...SF has finished above .500 only three times since winning the World Series in 2014 (84-78 in 2015, 87-75 in 2016 and 107-55 in 2021).
- ▶ The Giants enter today having lost two straight after winning five in a row earlier this week...SF is still 7-3 in its last 10 games despite last night's defeat.

CHAP HONORED WITH WILLIE MAC: Third baseman **Matt Chapman** was honored with the Giants annual **Willie Mac Award** prior to yesterday's game, an honor bestowed on the Giants player who to the most inspirational player on the team, as voted upon by Giants players, coaches, training staff, clubhouse staff and the fans.

- ▶ Chapman went 1-for-4 with a double in last night's defeat... it was Chapman's 66th extra-base hit of the season, most by a Giant since **Brandon Belt** had 66 in 2016.
- ▶ The 31-year-old has been a mainstay for the Giants all season, appearing in 152 of the Giants 160 games this year...he leads the team in virtually every offensive category including hits (140), doubles (37), homers (27), RBI (78), runs scored (96) and walks (64).
- ▶ It's the 10th time in the SF-era (1958-pres.) a Giant has turned in a season with 35+ doubles, 25+ homers and 15+ steals...see chart below courtesy of *Sport Radar*.

GOIN' REAL DEEP: The 430' homer by **OF Jerar Encarnacion** last night was the third-longest home run hit by a Giants player at Oracle Park this season...the only Giants that went deeper than Encarnacion last night at Oracle this year were the departed Jorge Soler (433' on April 27 vs. Pittsburgh) and **IF David Villar** (433' on June 26 vs. Chicago-NL).

ERR.: SF committed an error in last night's loss to the Cardinals, snapping their season-best nine-game errorless streak they turned in during the road trip...the nine-game error-free streak was the longest by a Giants club since a nine-game streak by the 2021 Giants from April 6-16.

WHO POISONED THE WATER HOLE?: SF has flipped its script in September, going 9-3 on the road while going just 2-9 here at home...in fact, the Giants have lost 10 of their last 12 games here dating to August 31.

- ▶ Prior to this stretch, the last time the Giants lost 10-of-12 games here at home was May 29-June 26, 2017.
- ▶ Dating to August 11, SF is 6-15 (.286) at Oracle Park, the lowest home win % in the NL in that time and 29th of 30 MLB teams ahead of only Chicago-AL (6-16, .273)...entering play on August 11, SF was 35-23 (.603) at home, the sixth-best home win% in MLB...SF is still 41-38 at home this season.

TRISTAN TIME: RHP **Tristan Beck** takes the ball this afternoon for SF in what will be his first start of the season and the fourth of his MLB career.

- ▶ Beck has made six appearances out of the bullpen since missing the Giants' first 137 games on the IL recovering from surgery to remove an aneurysm from his upper right arm on March 4 at Stanford Medical Center.
- ▶ He hasn't allowed a run in his last four relief outings (6.2 innings), allowing five hits while striking out six.

D-D-D, DE-FENSE: Entering play today the Giants have two of *Fangraphs'* DRS leaders at their respective positions in **C Patrick Bailey** (leads all catchers with 19 DRS) and **IF Matt Chapman** (leads all third basemen with 17 DRS)...the duo rank inside the top five for DRS at any position this year.

THREE FOR 30: **IF Matt Chapman** is three homers away from reaching the 30-HR plateau, something no Giants player has accomplished in 21 seasons since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 home runs in 2004.

- ▶ Chapman is slugging .607 with six home runs in his last 16 games...he's looking to become just the fifth Giants third baseman with a 30-homer campaign, joining **Jim Ray Hart**, **Sid Gordon**, **Matt Williams** and **Mel Ott**.
- ▶ **Matt Williams** is the last Giants third baseman to hit 30+ homers in a season (43 in 1994).

DON'T FORGET YOUR 'PEN: SF's bullpen did not allow an earned run in 5.1 innings last night and has a 2.99 ERA (33er, 99.1ip) this month (8th-best in MLB and fourth-best in the National League).

- ▶ Since August 1, the Giants bullpen sports a 2.97 ERA (66er, 200.0ip) that is sixth-best in MLB and second-best in the NL behind only the Brewers (2.86).

This Date in Giants History

SEPTEMBER 28, 1993 - The Giants reclaimed a share of first place in the NL West with the Braves, as SF defeated Colorado 6-4. **Will Clark** hit his 14th homer of the season, **Rod Beck** earned his 45th save and the Giants won their 100th game of the season.

WITH THE GIANTS: Beck is in his second year with the Giants after making his debut last season and appearing in 33 games for SF at the Major League level (three as a starter).

TOUGH START: The 28-year-old was expected to compete for a spot in the rotation or at the very least a role in SF's bullpen at the outset of Spring Training in 2024...a few weeks into camp, however, Beck's hand would go cold after throwing some bullpen sessions... he went to see a vascular specialist at Stanford who helped determine that Beck had an aneurysm in his upper right arm that was causing the numbness...Beck underwent surgery to remove it on March 4 at Stanford Medical Center with the procedure performed by Dr. Jason Lee.

THE ROAD BECK: Two months after surgery Beck was cleared to throw in early May and built up to a rehab assignment at Triple-A Sacramento in early August...in five starts for the River Cats Beck allowed 14 runs (12 earned) in 13.2 innings (7.90)...however, he struck out 17 and walked just three...he returned to the MLB roster on September 1 after missing the Giants' first 137 games.

FAMILIAR, BUT UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY: Today marks Beck's fourth career MLB start, and 40th career MLB game overall...although starting is relatively new at the Major League level, 60 of Beck's 68 MiLB games came as a starting pitcher...he starred collegiately at nearby Stanford University as a starter for three seasons before signing with the Braves after being selected in the fourth round of the 2018 draft following his junior season.

VS. ST. LOUIS: Has faced the Cardinals twice in his career with both appearances coming as a reliever last year here at Oracle Park...allowed two runs on three hits in 2.1 innings across the two outings.

SMALL SAMPLE SIZE: Beck's most used pitch this season has been his four-seam fastball with him using it 48.8% of the time and hitters batting .105 off it...dating back to last season, opponents are batting .160 while slugging just .192 off his four-seamer.

- ▶ Made his MLB debut on June 16.
- ▶ Went 5-1 with a 2.92 ERA in 27 relief outings for Triple-A Sacramento...struck out 42 in 49.1ip with opponents hitting .231 off him.
