PERMISSION GRANTED TO CALL IT A COMEBACK: Unphased by a 4-2 deficit after seven innings, the Detroit Tigers last night erupted for five runs in the eighth inning and three more in the ninth to put away the Los Angeles Angels, 10-4, in the series opener of this four-game set in Anaheim ... Dillon Dingler's three-run homer in the eighth snapped a 4-4 tie while Spencer Torkelson put the game out of reach with a three-run homer of his own in the ninth ... Casey Mize (7.0 IP/4 ER) notched his fifth win of the season, tied for the major league lead.

- The Tigers are the first American League team to win 20 games this season and they reached the mark on May 1, the earliest calendar date to win their 20th game in franchise history.
- At 20-12, the Tigers have their best record through 32 games to start a season in 11 years when they began 21-11 in 2014.
- The Tigers have gone 20-9, a .690 winning percentage, in their last 29 games starting March 31 since enduring a three-game sweep to start the season at Dodger Stadium ... their 20-9 record starting March 31 is tied with the Mets for best in all of baseball in that span.
- The Tigers last night improved to 9-2 in series openers this season, the best in all of baseball.
- This stay in Anaheim is the middle stop of a season-long 11-day, 10-game, three-city trip through Houston (1-2), the Angels (1-0) and Colorado (three games starting Tuesday).
- The Tigers today continue their stretch of 23 games in 24 days through this Sunday, May 4.

HE WAS ACTUALLY BETTER THIS TIME AROUND: Tarik Skubal starts tonight for the seventh time this year ... he is coming off an outstanding April in which he went 3-1 with a 1.52 ERA (5 ER/29.2 IP) with 38 strikeouts and only four walks in five starts, which is actually a tick better (we're splitting hairs here) than his April of 2024 when he went 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER/30.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts and six walks in five starts en route to winning the A.L. Cy Young Award in unanimous fashion.

- Tarik Skubal (1.52 ERA in April) and Casey Mize (2.12 ERA in April) were one of only two pairs of qualifying teammates in all of baseball to have sub-2.20 ERAs last month, joining Texas' Tyler Mahle (0.90 ERA) and Nathan Eovaldi (1.96 ERA).

HE'S DONE THIS ONCE BEFORE: Zach McKinstry enters tonight riding an active 11-game hitting streak, matching his career best 11-game streak from August 17-31, 2024 ... his current run is tied for the second-longest active streak in the majors and is already McKinstry's second hitting streak of eight or more games on the young season ... he became the first Tigers player with multiple hitting streaks of eight or more games in April since Miguel Cabrera in April of 2013.

HOLY SMOKES THIS IS WILDLY OFFENSIVE: Spencer Torkelson last night slugged his team-leading ninth home run of the season, as his three-run shot upped his season total to 26 RBI ... he is one homer shy of the major league lead and is tied for second in the A.L. in RBI ... his 17 extra-base hits rank third in the A.L.

- Javier Báez last night homered for the second game in a row, his first time homering in back-to-back contests since August 13-15, 2024 ... Báez now has a .430 slugging percentage and .760 OPS this season, easily his best early-season numbers in any of his four years with Detroit.

THIS DIFFERENCE ISN'T NEGLIGIBLE: The Tigers begin the day with the best record in the A.L. on the strength of a +46 run differential this year, the second-best mark in the A.L. behind the Yankees (+52) ... the Tigers are one of seven A.L. teams in positive run-differential territory, but they and the Yankees are well ahead of the third-best Mariners (+23) ... overall, the Tigers are fourth in the majors with their +46 run differential.

IN THE BIG INNING: The Tigers are averaging seeing 20.7 pitches in the first inning this season, the best mark in the A.L. and second-best in the majors behind only the Phillies ... Detroit has scored 20 first-inning runs, sixth most in the A.L. ... the Tigers rank second in the A.L. and third in the majors with a .386 on-base percentage and a .322 (37-for-115) batting average in the first inning this year.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ: The Tigers bullpen has combined to post a 2.69 ERA (32 ER/107.0 IP) this season, just behind Houston (2.64 ERA) for lowest relief ERS in the American League and the fourth-lowest mark in all of baseball, also behind San Diego (1.77) and San Francisco (2.35) ... Tigers relievers have also combined to limit opponents to a .610 OPS, the third lowest mark in the A.L. ... Detroit's 107.0 relief innings pitched are the fifth fewest in the A.L.

AND FINALLY: Dillon Dingler now has four homers, 15 RBI and a .799 OPS in 87 plate appearances this season ... in total last year with the Tigers, Dingler hit one home run with 11 RBI and a .505 OPS in the exact same 87 plate appearances.

- Went 3-1 with a 1.52 ERA (5 ER/29.2 IP) with 38 strikeouts and only four walks in five starts in April, a tick better than his April of 2024 when he went 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER/30.2 IP) with 35 strikeouts and six walks in five starts en route to winning the A.L. Cy Young Award in unanimous fashion.
- Named the Tigers Opening Day starter for the second consecutive season...went 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (5ER/19.1IP) in five starts in Spring Training, striking out 24 batters compared to just one walk
- Was the unanimous AL Cy Young winner in 2024, becoming the fifth Tiger to win the award, the first since Max Scherzer in 2013, and the second LHP in franchise history to ever do so (other, Willie Hernandez in 1984).
- Started 31 games last year, posting an 18-4 record with a 2.39 ERA (51ER/192.0IP) and 228 strikeouts...his 18 victories were the most by a Tigers pitcher since Max Scherzer also won 18 in 2014.
- Won the American League Pitching Triple Crown, finishing first in wins (18), ERA (2.39) and strikeouts (228)...became the third pitcher in franchise history and the 22nd pitcher in Major League history to win the Triple Crown, joining Justin Verlander (2011) and Hal Newhouser (1945).
- From Sept. 3, 2023-May 17, 2024, Skubal had a 10-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (14ER/85.0IP), 12 walks, 109 strikeouts and four home runs allowed...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, Skubal is the third starting pitcher since 1913 to have a 14-start span with an ERA below 1.50, 100-or-more strikeouts, 12-or-fewer walks and four-or-fewer home runs, joining Clayton Kershaw (twice, 9/29/15-6/4/16 and 5/1/16-9/19/16) and Jacob deGrom (4/5/21-7/1/21) while being the only starter with such a stretch while also earning 10 wins.
- Started three games during the postseason, compiling a 1-1 record with a 2.37 ERA (5ER/19.0IP) and 20 strikeouts...started his playoff career by not allowing a run in 17.0 consecutive innings, tied for the fifth-longest streak in MLB history and longest since Ian Anderson started his postseason career with 17.2 straight scoreless innings in 2020.
- Became the fourth pitcher in franchise history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his first career playoff game (Oct. 1), joining Max Scherzer (2011) and Joe Coleman (1972)

- Earned a spot on his first career Opening Day roster after a standout spring camp, during which he didn't allow a single earned run over 10.2 innings (nine games) of relief...went 1-0, surrendering seven hits and three walks while striking out nine
- Appeared in 21 games (three starts) for the Tigers in 2024, posting a 1-1 record with a 1.84 ERA (6ER/29.1IP), six walks and 23 strikeouts...also made 34 appearances with Triple-A Toledo last year, going 1-2 with one save, a 5.17 ERA (27ER/47.0IP) and 53 strikeouts.
