TODAY'S GAME: SF looks to secure the series with a win tonight after a thrilling walk-off win last night.

- ▶ The Giants are 9-5 in their last 14 games dating to June 24, taking series from the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1) while dropping their last series at Cleveland (1-2).
- ▶ SF has won three of its last four home series, and seven of its last nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ The Giants are 15-12 all-time against Toronto, and 9-5 at Oracle Park.

A FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC: Last night's walk-off win was the Giants eighth of the season, second-most in the Majors this year to Miami's nine walk-off victories.

- ▶ SF has now won 23 games this season when trailing at any point in the game, tied for fifth-most in the Majors.
- ▶ Only the Brewers (26 comeback wins), Guardians (24), Mets (24) and Twins (24) have more such wins than the Giants.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER?: The Giants have scored 112 runs this year from the 8th inning on, second-most in the Majors only to the Mets 114 runs from the eighth inning onward.

- ▶ SF's .756 OPS from the 8th inning on is third-best in the Majors behind the Orioles (.789) and Mets (.773).

WE'RE RIGHT THERE...LITERALLY: Each of the Giants last seven games have been decided by two runs or fewer with SF going 4-3 in those games.

- ▶ Since the start of the June, the Giants have had 23 games decided by two runs or fewer, most in the Majors ahead of Milwaukee (22)...SF is 11-12 in those games...the 12 losses are tied for second-most in MLB in that span behind the White Sox 13 (*Stats, LLC*).

LA ESTRELLA DE MAUNABO: **OF Heliot Ramos**, who was born in Humacao, PR but raised in Maunabo, PR, is the first Giants homegrown outfielder to be selected to an All-Star Game since **OF Chili Davis** in 1986.

- ▶ He's also the youngest Giants All-Star (pitcher or position player) since **IF Joe Panik** in 2015, who was 24 years, 257 days old...Ramos will be 24 years, 313 days old.
- ▶ Ramos enters today slashing .302/.372/.535 for a .907 OPS with 11 doubles, 13 homers, 42 RBI and 27 runs scored in 55 games...according to *Sarah Langs*, Ramos' 13 homers are the most by a Giants player under the age of 25 in his first 55 games of a season since **IF Matt Williams** had 13 in 1989.
- ▶ His 13 homers and 2.4 fWAR lead the team while his 42 RBI are tied for most on the team with **IF Matt Chapman**.
- ▶ Ramos' 15 multi-hit games at home since his recall on May 8 are most in MLB over that span (*Stats, LLC*).
- ▶ Since May 8, the 24-year-old ranks among the NL leaders in RBI (42, 2nd), home runs (13, T-3rd), OPS (.907, 5th) and SLG% (.535, 7th).

PEN TO PAPER: The SF bullpen has pitched 29.0 innings over its first seven games this month...overall, the Giants' 383.2 bullpen innings this year are most in MLB.

- ▶ **RHP Tyler Rogers** and **RHP Ryan Walker** are tied for the most appearances in MLB (46).
- ▶ **LHP Erik Miller** has made 43 appearances in his rookie campaign, second-most among rookies behind CLE's Hunter Gaddis (45).

WEBB SLINGER: Newly minted first-time All Star **RHP Logan Webb** takes the bump tonight for the Giants for his 20th start of the season.

- ▶ He'll be pitching with an extra day of rest with Monday's off day and **LHP Blake Snell** being slotted into the rotation yesterday...he last pitched on the Fourth of July in Atlanta where he spun 7.0 innings of two-run ball against the Braves in SF's 4-2 series-clinching win.
- ▶ He enters today's start having thrown 119.1 innings, most in the National League and third-most in the Majors behind SEA's Logan Gilbert (125.1) and KC's Seth Lugo (122.0)...Webb's 3.09 ERA is seventh-best in the NL.
- ▶ He's been terrific here at home, posting a 2.13 ERA (13er, 55.0ip) in eight starts at Oracle this year...the Giants as a team are 6-2 in his eight home starts.
- ▶ Lastly, Webb has worked at least 6.0 innings in each of his last 11 overall starts dating to May 10...the last Giant with a longer such streak was **LHP Madison Bumgarner** with a 19-game run in 2016 (April 20-July 27).

SO...WE'RE VETERANS NOW?: The Giants have had 12 different rookies pitch in a game this season, most of any team in MLB, and those rookies have combined to throw 303.0 innings...there's only been one other season in franchise history prior to this one where Giants rookies combined to throw 300+ innings before the All-Star break (1975, 313.2 innings) (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ For reference, the next closest team in terms of innings pitched by rookies this season are the A's (244.1).

RAY OF LIGHT: **LHP Robbie Ray** made his eighth rehab appearance (seventh start) yesterday, this time starting at Single-A San Jose...Ray threw 3.0 innings and allowed four runs on four hits (two homers) with one walk and five strikeouts...Ray was stretched out to 59 pitches (40 strikes).

- ▶ Ray is recovering from Tommy John surgery last year.

COBB SALAD, TO GO PLZ: **RHP Alex Cobb** takes his turn in the rehab cycle tonight for Single-A San Jose...it'll be Cobb's third rehab start for San Jose.

- ▶ Cobb is on the road back from some right shoulder trouble that flared up as he was returning from offseason surgery on his left hip.

ABOUT TIME!: It was announced Sunday night that Webb had been selected to his first All-Star Game...Webb is the first homegrown (drafted and developed) Giants pitcher to be named to an All-Star Game since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** was selected to the team in 2016...Webb, who had a case to make it each of the last two seasons, will head to the game with teammate **OF Heliot Ramos**, also a first-time All-Star.

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched the Giants to a win nearly a week ago, spinning 7.0 innings last Thursday in Atlanta in the Giants 4-2, series-clinching win at Truist Park...Webb allowed two early runs and then buckled down to get through seven innings with six strikeouts and one walk in the 104-pitch effort.

DADDY LONG LEGS: Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 11 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only two other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Jordan Hicks** did so on April 5 vs. San Diego and **Kyle Harrison** has done so twice)...SF's ace enters this outing having thrown 119.1 innings so far this year, most in the NL and third-most in the Majors behind SEA's Logan Gilbert (125.1) and KC's Seth Lugo (122.0).

GOIN' DEEP (IN THE GAME): Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 527.2 innings, most in the Majors in that time ahead of Aaron Nola (512.1), Miles Mikolas (510.1), Corbin Burnes (508.1) and Logan Gilbert (501.2).

VS. TORONTO: Is looking to put together a better outing against the Blue Jays tonight after somewhat of a clunker last year up in Toronto on June 28...in that outing Webb allowed five runs on eight hits, struck out five and walked none in a 6-1 Giants loss...all five runs came in the 1st inning as he was blitzed for five runs on six hits.

THE SPLITS: Below is a look at Webb's numbers within the confines of Oracle Park this year versus what he's done on the road.

KILLA WHALE: Is making his ninth start at home this season and is 4-2 with a 2.13 ERA (13er, 55.0ip) in his previous eight starts at Oracle in 2024...the Giants have gone 6-2 in Webb's seven starts here this year and are 37-16 in his 53 regular season starts in this ballpark since the beginning of 2021...Webb in that span is 26-14 with a 2.37 ERA (89er, 338.0ip) and two complete games.

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: Webb's changeup has a +4 run value in 2024 after having +28 run value last season (the second-most valuable pitch in the league behind AL Cy Young Award winner Gerrit Cole's fastball)...his most valuable pitch this year thus far (in terms of run value) has turned out to be his sinker, which has a +7 run value...over his last three outings, opponents have gone 5-for-25 (.200) with one XBH in ABs that end with his sinker...hitters have gone 12-for-25 (.480) with three XBH in ABs that have ended with the changeup in that span...off his sweeper (slider), they've gone 4-for-20 (.200) with one XBH and nine strikeouts.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants are 63-47 (.573) in Webb's 110 regular season starts since 2021...SF is 9-10 in his 19 starts in 2024...he's received three or fewer runs of support in 13 of the 19 starts.

PRETEND ITS THE SECOND INNING?: The first inning has given Webb fits all year as he's allowed exactly a quarter of all the runs he's allowed this season (11 of 44) in the first inning...from the second inning on, Webb boasts a 2.69 ERA (30er, 100.1ip)...in the first inning he has a 5.21 ERA (11er, 19.0ip).

STAY IN THE PARK: Webb allowed three homers in June (40.0 innings) after allowing two homers in his first two months of the season (72.1ip)...still, his 0.38 HR/9ip would be a career-best...among starters with at least 15 starts this year Webb's 0.38 HR/9ip is second-lowest in MLB behind PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.18).

CHECK 'EM: Opposing teams had early season success running on Webb in 2024, stealing 10 bases in his first nine starts this year...after a stretch of allowing just one steal in seven starts from May 15-June 18, the Cardinals swiped four bags off Webb on June 23...since that outing, basestealers are 0-for-1 off Webb...still, the 15 steals against him this year are tied for third-most in MLB behind BAL's Corbin Burnes (22) and COL's Ryan Feltner (20).

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Through 19 starts this year Webb owns a 57.9% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (62.2%), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (60.2%) and ATL's Max Fried (58.9%).
