### Wins vs. Yankees

Atlanta beat New York, 8-1, last night, and has won each of its last four games versus the Yankees. The Braves swept a three-game series last season.

Since the advent of interleague play in 1997, just one National League team has a longer winning streak versus New York. The Crosstown Mets won six straight over the Yankees from 2013-2014.

Atlanta is one of just five other teams to ever beat New York in four consecutive interleague games, joining St. Louis (2022-23), Philadelphia (2010-15), Miami (2009-15) and Colorado (2007-11).

The Braves have outscored the Yankees, 26-4 (+22), in their four wins.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Yankees tonight continue a three-game weekend series in what are the only scheduled meetings between the teams this season...The two are playing for the second consecutive season after meeting at Truist Park last year.

- A* Atlanta beat New York, 8-1, last night to open the series...The Braves swept the Yankees in three games last season, and the club's four-game winning streak against New York is their longest in history...They had won back-to-back games five times previously.
- A* Atlanta is just 20-26 (.435) all-time against New York since the advent of interleague play in 1997, its worst record against any AL team in that span... The Braves and Yankees have met four times in the World Series, with Atlanta going 1-3 in these sets...The Milwaukee Braves won the title in 1957, before the Yankees won in 1958, 1996 and 1999.
- A* Despite the losing record overall, Atlanta is 13-12 all-time here in New York...The Braves last played here in 2021 and split a pair of games, and Atlanta last won a series here in 2012 (2-1)...The club is 4-3-2 in nine total series here all-time...Atlanta is one of just two National League clubs with a winning record in New York (Los Angeles, 5-3).
- A* RH Charlie Morton is set to make the 14th start of his career against New York, and is 5-3 with a 3.54 ERA (27 ER/68.2 IP) and 95 strikeouts over his first 13 turns...The 6-foot-5, 215-pound right-hander pitched against them once last season, August 16 at Truist Park, and threw 6.0 scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts...A native of Flemington, NJ, Morton attended Joel Barlow High School in Redding, CT, located just over an hour from Yankee Stadium.
- A* RH Marcus Stroman is 4-3 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER/38.0 IP) in eight career starts versus Atlanta, but has lost each of his last three starts against the Braves dating to 2021...The 5-foot-7, 180-pound right-hander started against Atlanta on September 28 of last season while with the Cubs, and took the loss after allowing four hits and four runs, two earned, over just 2.0 innings...In his first season with the Yankees, the native of Medford, NY, is 6-3 with a 3.08 ERA (29 ER/84.2 IP) over 15 starts.

**INTERLEAGUE WIN:** Atlanta beat New York in the opener last night to win its fourth straight game, all of which have come against American League opponents...The Braves swept the Tigers at Truist Park earlier this week.

- A* Atlanta enters play tonight with the best interleague record in baseball, going 21-10 (.677)... New York ranks fourth with a 12-7 (.632) mark... The Braves' 21 wins are tied with the Brewers for the most against the opposing league this season.
- A* The Braves' seven-run win over the Yankees last night was their fourth-largest margin of victory over New York all-time, regular and postseason... Atlanta beat New York by 11 in the 1996 World Series and eight in the 1958 World Series, along with another eight-run win last year.

**PITCHING:** Atlanta allowed just three hits and one run last night versus New York, and has surrendered just three total runs over its last four games...The Braves beat the Tigers, 2-1, on Monday & Tuesday, shut out Detroit on Wednesday and allowed just a single run last night.

- A* The Yankees entered play last night tied for second in the majors in runs scored, and were held to no more than one run for just the ninth time...New York's three hits matched its season low.
- A* The Braves' three runs allowed over a four-game span are their fewest since August 14 to August 18 of last season, which also included a series with the Yankees...Atlanta beat New York, 11-3, on August 14 before pitching three straight shutouts.
- A* The Braves' 3.56 ERA (256 ER/648.0 IP) on the season ranks eighth in baseball and third in the NL... Atlanta's 3.67 FIP for the season though trails just Philadelphia (3.50) and Baltimore (3.66).
- A* Four Atlanta relievers combined to throw 4.0 scoreless innings last night, and the Braves' have tossed 14.2 consecutive scoreless innings in relief... It is the longest active scoreless run by a bullpen in baseball...Atlanta's 3.21 ERA in relief this season is third-best in the majors, behind just Cleveland (2.33) and Los Angeles-NL (3.16).

**HOMERS:** Atlanta hit three more home runs last night, and has clubbed 16 homers over its last seven games...No team in baseball has more homers in that span, which dates to June 14.

- A* The Braves' 16 homers over their last seven games are more than their total from the previous 20 contests, May 23 to June 14 (15 homers)...Atlanta ranks tied for 12th in the majors with 82 homers on the season, one year after leading baseball and tying the single-season major league record with 307 homers in 2023.
- A* Matt Olson's fourth-inning home run last night would have been out in just eight total ballparks, and would not have been a homer at Truist Park in Atlanta...Per Baseball Savant, Yankee Stadium is ranked as the seventh most homer-friendly park in the majors with a home run mark of 112, meaning that of batters and pitchers who played at both Yankee Stadium and elsewhere, 12% more home runs occurred in New York...Conversely, Atlanta's Truist Park ranked 23rd with a home run mark of just 88.

**BARRELS:** Atlanta barreled six balls last night, going 3-for-6 with two homers and a double on such hits... Jarred Kelenic and Austin Riley each had two barrels, while Ramón Laureano and Ozzie Albies had one.

- A* Atlanta has 181 barrels on the season, fourth most in the majors...However, dating to June 13 and the start of the Braves' 7-1 run, no team in baseball has more (27).
- A* Riley and Kelenic each have five barrels since that date, two of just 15 players across baseball with as many...Riley has hit .444/.531/1.037 in those eight games, while Kelenic has batted .314/.351/.514.

#### Today's Game

- A* Set to make his 14th start of the season and 14th of his career against New York (AL).
- A* Earned his fourth win of the season after Holding Tampa Bay to three hits and one run over 6.0 innings pitched while fanning eight hitters...the eight strikeouts were tied for a season most.
- A* With his first start this season, Morton became the seventh player in Braves franchise history to pitch for the club in his 20's, 30's and 40's...Joins Hall-of-Famers Warren Spahn, Phil Niekro, Tom Glavine and John Smoltz along with teammate Jesse Chavez and Dick Rudolph.
- A* Morton is averaging 9.04 strikeouts per nine innings this season...Only Hall-of-Famers John Smoltz, Nolan Ryan and Randy Johnson had higher K/9 rates through a season at age 40 or older.
- A* Went 2-0 with a 3.16 ERA in his first five starts this season.
  - A* Has gone 1-3 with a 4.54 ERA in seven starts since.
- A* At 40 years, 167 days-old in his start against Cleveland on April 17, became the fifth Braves pitcher over the age of 40, in the Atlanta-era (since 1966), to toss at least 7.0 scoreless frames, joining Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro (11x) and John Smoltz (3x), along with Dennis Martínez and R.A. Dickey.
- A* His 168 quality starts are the seventh most among active pitchers...trails teammate Chris Sale who ranks fifth with 177.
- A* His 2034.0 innings pitched are the fourth most among active pitchers.
  - A* Trails only Justin Verlander, Max Scherzer and Clayton Kershaw.
- A* Struckout Wyatt Langford to reach 1,900 on his career.
  - A* Morton's 1,1956 strikeout are the eighth most among active players.
  - A* Teammate Chris Sale ranks fourth with 2,296.
- A* Throwing his curveball on 40.0% of pitches; the highest rate in the majors among qualified starters.
  - A* Morton has struck out 445 hitters with his curveball since the beginning of the 2020; the most in the majors.
- A* Morton has recorded 680 strikeouts since joining Atlanta's staff in 2021, the seventh most in baseball.
  - A* His rate of 10.29 strikeouts per nine innings is also the sixth highest in the majors during that span among qualified pitchers.
- A* Morton's 3.14 ERA to open the season was the lowest in Atlanta franchise history for pitcher's above the age of 40 through their first seven starts since Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro and Gyalord Perry in 1981.

#### 2024 Recap

- A* Morton became the 13th player in franchise history to start a game at age 40 or older.
  - A* Prior to Morton, the last Braves pitcher to start a game over the age of 40 was R.A. Dickey in 2017.
  - A* Six of the 12 other pitchers have been selected into the Hall of Fame (Tom Glavine, Phil Niekro, Gaylord Perry, John Smoltz, Warren Spahn and Cy Young).
- A* Morton and Chris Sale become the first pair of teammates to have each made an Opening Day start and record the last out of a World Series since Hall-of-Famer Dennis Eckersley and Cy Young award-winner Bret Saberhagen with Boston in 1998. (Research courtesy of Elias Sports Bureau)
- A* Morton was the Opening Day starter for Tampa Bay in 2020 and induced a groundout from Corey Seager for the final out in Game 7 of the 2017 World Series with Houston.
- A* Sale was the Opening Day starter for the Red Sox (2018-'19) and the White Sox (2013,'14 & '16)...He struck out Manny Machado in Game 5 as the final out of the 2018 Fall Classic with Boston.

#### Career Recap

- A* A 16-year major league veteran, entered the 2024 season with a 130-113 record and a 4.00 ERA across 353 games, 352 starts...Fanned 1,880 and pitched three shutouts.
  - A* Has pitched for Atlanta (2008, '21-23), Pittsburgh (2009-15), Philadelphia (2016), Houston (2017-18) and Tampa Bay (2019-20).
  - A* Is a two-time All-Star (2018 & 2019) and won the 2017 World Series while with Houston and 2021 World Series with Atlanta.

**Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 30 yrs • #49**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/2    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/19    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/5

- **Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...Is one of two pitchers in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed...Also Justin Martinez (ARI).**
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 59.2% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 94th percentile.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

**Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 24/11    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 11/1

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .059 (2-for-34) off him, which leads Major League Baseball (min. 30 BF with RISP).**
- **Is carrying an active scoreless streak of 14.1 innings...Among relievers, it's the second-longest active in the majors (2024 only)...Pedro Avila (CLE, 14.0 IP) leads him.**
- Just one of Chavez's 13 inherited runners has scored, posting the second-best percentage (7.7%) in the National League (min. 10 IR) behind Hunter Harvey (WSH, 7.7%).
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.77) ranks sixth behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63) and Mike Remlinger (2.74).
- By Run Value, Chavez owns the fourth most valuable cutter (8 RV, tied) in baseball among both starters and relievers...Corbin Burnes (BAL, 12), Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 11) and Garrett Crochet (CWS, 10) are the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 54% of his offerings.
- Among the 27 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older, Chavez owns the best ERA in the National League and second-best in MLB (1.17)...Texas' Kirby Yates is the only player to lead him in that regard (0.99).
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,006 strikeouts rank sixth behind Craig Kimbrel (1,231), Aroldis Chapman (1,192), Kenley Jansen (1,190), David Robertson (1,105) and Matt Moore (1,036).
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.01 ERA (34 ER/152.0 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)...Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).

**Daysbel Hernández • RHP • 5-10 • 220 • 27 yrs • #62**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 6/6    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- All six of his major league outings have been scoreless this season, pitching 1.0 inning in each of them.
- This season, has pitched to a 2.35 ERA (6 ER/23.0 IP) across 17 relief outings with Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Has posted a 11.35 K/9 at Triple-A this season.
- Earned the win in his MLB debut on July 23 2023 in Milwaukee...Prior to that, the last Atlanta reliever to earn a win in his MLB debut was Jesse Biddle, who beat the New York Mets on April 21, 2018.
- Missed the entire 2022 season due to UCL reconstruction surgery.

**Grant Holmes • RHP • 6-0 • 226 • 28 yrs • #66**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/2    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- On June 16, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two strikeouts and no walks in his major league debut...Holmes is just the second Brave to pitch to those parameters in his major league debut in the Atlanta era (since 1966)...He joined Manny Bañuelos, who did it in a starting nod on July 2, 2015...Just three other pitchers have done it in franchise history.
- Across 18 appearances (3 starts) for Triple-A Gwinnett this season, pitched to a 2.63 ERA (12 ER/41.0 IP) with 51 strikeouts and only 14 walks.
- Among International League pitchers, his 2.63 ERA ranked fourth at the time of his call-up (min. 40 IP).
- Through his first 11 appearances of the season, logged a 0.63 ERA (1 ER/14.1 IP).
- From Conway, SC, just outside of Myrtle Beach and roughly 5 hours, 16 minutes from Truist Park.
- Signed with the Braves organization as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
- Was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 MLB draft...Was traded to the Oakland Athletics on August 1, 2016, along with Frankie Montas and Jharel Cotton in exchange for Rich Hill and Josh Reddick...Holmes was released by Oakland on July 28, 2022.

**Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #26**

**Saves/Opp:** 19/21    **Holds:** 0    **1st Batter/Retired:** 29/21    **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/0

- Has converted 11 consecutive save opportunities, tied for the fourth-longest streak in MLB.
- Ranks third in the National League and tied for fourth in the majors with 19 saves.
