The Brewers have won each of the 6 starts made by **Brandon Woodruff** 

TODAY'S GAME: Is game 6 (5-0) of a 6-game homestand against New York-NL (3-0) and Pittsburgh (2-0)....following this homestand and an off day tomorrow, the team takes an 8-game trip to Cincinnati (3g) and Chicago-NL (5g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

AT HOME: The team is a Major League-best 41-20 at home, going 15-5-0 in series play, including this series.....are 29-11 in the last 40 games, 18-4 in the last 22 and 8-1 in the last 9 contests with a 5-game winning streak.....had a season-high 6-game winning streak from 7/7-7/13

ON THE ROAD: The team is a Major League-best 34-24 on the road, going 10-7-2 in series play.....are 24-6 in the last season-high 7-game winning streak. are 24-6 in the last 30 games and 12-1 in the last 13 contests with a

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

<u>COACHES</u>: Associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (2nd season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 20 replay challenges this season, going 13-7.....their last challenge (won) came on 8/4 at Atlanta as an out call at first base involving Andrew Vaughn was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseasor eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

**BREWING CONSISTENCY**: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 741 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

WOODRUFF AT A GLANCE: Brandon Woodruff, 32, makes his seventh start of the season and first against the Pirates.....he last started last Friday vs. New York-NL in a 3-2 win (7ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 8k, 2hr, 79 pitches).....the team is 6-0 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .139 [17-for-122, 7hr).....he missed the 2024 season as he recovered from right shoulder surgery.....he is 19-3 with a 2.34 ERA in his last 38 starts dating back to May 2022 [227ip, 150h, 62r, 59er, 53bb, 272k].....Woodruff was selected in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.

SORRY I'M LATE: Woodruff's return to a Major League mound was delayed twice while on rehab assignment.....the team returned Woodruff from rehab assignment at Triple-A Nashville on May 12 due to right ankle tendinitis and again on June 5 due to a right elbow contusion suffered in a start on 6/3 vs. Gwinnett (struck by line drive).

SIMPLY THE BEST: Woodruff is the all-time franchise leader with a 3.06 ERA (min. 500ip).....his 833 strikeouts rank seventh in franchise history.....Corbin Burnes ranks sixth (870).....at 50-26, his .658 career winning percentage ranks first franchise history (min. 50 decisions).

CAREER: Has gone 50-26 with a 3.06 ERA in 136 games/121 starts (715.2ip, 243er).....is in his ninth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-25).....was a 2019 and 2021 All-Star.....underwent surgery on 10/13/23 to repair the anterior capsule in his right shoulder, performed by Dr. Keith Meister.....missed the entire 2024 season.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 27-9 with a 2.82 ERA in 68 games/61 starts (366.2ip, 115er)....is 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA in 3 starts this season (17.1ip, 6er).
