BATTLE-BACK BIRDS: The Orioles overcame a 4-0 deficit after two and a half innings to defeat the Red Sox last night, 5-4, in the opener of the three-game set...Marked their eighth comeback win of the season...Have won all eight series openers to start the year, four at home and four on the road...Improved to 7-2 in one-run games.

99 PLATE VISION: O's batters did not strike out last night, the first time since August 8, 2010 vs. Chicago-AL that they did not strike out in a game...According to Statcast, O's batters swung and missed on just four pitches, tied for Baltimore's fewest in the Statcast era (since 2015) with four whiffs on September 22, 2019 vs. Seattle; Statcast's definition of a "swing-and-miss" includes swinging strikes, blocked swinging strikes, and foul tips...All nine starters recorded a hit in a game for the first time since August 6, 2022 vs. Pittsburgh.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's have won seven consecutive games, nine of their last 10, and 11 of their last 13...Marks the team's longest winning streak since a 10-game stretch from July 3-13, 2022...The 15-7 start to the season is tied for the third-best in team history (since 1954), done in 2005, 1997, and 1969, and trailing only 1966 and 1968 (16-6).

⚾ Entering today's games, Baltimore owns the second-best record in the AL, trailing only Tampa Bay (20-3); the O's .682 winning percentage is the third-best in MLB behind Tampa Bay (.870) and Pittsburgh (.696).

⚾ The Birds have won five straight games at Oriole Park for the first time since winning eight in a row from June 22-July 10, 2022.

⚾ The seven-game winning streak is the longest active stretch in the AL and tied with the Pirates for the longest active stretch in MLB.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The Orioles have pitched to a 1.55 ERA (11 ER/64.0 IP) during the current seven-game winning streak...Starters have thrown to a 1.94 ERA (9 ER/41.2 IP), the best in the AL and second-best in MLB during the streak, while the bullpen has a 0.81 ERA (2 ER/22.1 IP), best in the AL and second-best in MLB, over that period...This comes after the team had a 5.36 ERA (79 ER/132.2 IP) in the first 15 games through April 15, sixth-worst in MLB in that time.

⚾ O's hurlers did not allow a run in 34 consecutive innings from the second inning on April 16 at Chicago-AL through the eighth inning on April 21; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it marked the sixth-longest streak in club history (since 1954) and the longest since the O's tossed 45 straight scoreless frames to end the 1995 campaign...According to STATS, it was the longest streak by an AL team in a single season since Baltimore's 45-inning streak in 1995.

⚾ Baltimore starting pitchers had a scoreless innings streak of 29.2 from the second inning on April 16 through the sixth inning on April 22...Marks the longest such stretch by Orioles starters in a single season since a 42.0-straight scoreless stretch to end 1995.

THE CANO SHOW: **Yennier Cano** earned his first career save last night after tossing a perfect ninth inning with two strikeouts...Has set down the first 20 hitters he has faced to begin the season, including five on Saturday night...He is the first O's pitcher to do so since Fred Holdsworth set the team record (since 1954) by retiring the first 24 batters he faced in the 1976 campaign from July 17-24.

HOME SWEET HOME: The O's continue their six-game homestand tonight with the second of three games against the Red Sox...The Orioles swept the series against the Tigers over the weekend...The O's have gone 8-3 so far at home and their .727 home winning percentage ranks second in MLB (see chart at right)...Baltimore went 4-3 (.571) in their season-opening homestand against the Yankees (1-2) and Athletics (3-1) from April 7-13.

AGAINST THE RED SOX: Baltimore and Boston meet for three games this week, their second matchup this season after the teams squared off at Fenway Park for the opening series of the year from March 30 to April 2...After Wednesday, the O's and Red Sox do not meet again until a three-game series September 8-10 in Boston before the teams wrap up the regular season with four games at Oriole Park from September 28 to October 1.

LOOKING AHEAD: Following the current homestand, the Birds embark on the longest road trip of the season with four games at Detroit from April 27-30, an off day on May 1, three games at Kansas City from May 2-4, and three games at Atlanta from May 5-7.

ON THE ATTACK: Baltimore is batting .247/.336/.415 (178-for-721) with 42 doubles, two triples, 25 home runs, 113 runs scored, 109 RBI, and 93 walks to start the season...The O's rank sixth in the AL and 10th in MLB in runs scored after finishing 10th in the AL and 20th in MLB with 674 runs scored in 2022...The Birds rank among AL teams in walks (T-1st, 93), on-base percentage (3rd, .336), slugging percentage (4th, .415), OPS (4th, .750), and batting average (6th, .247).

⚾ The Orioles lead MLB with 4.10 pitches per plate appearance this season; the O's have three players in the top seven in the AL in pitches per plate appearance: **Adley Rutschman** (3rd, 4.36), **Anthony Santander** (6th, 4.294), and **Adam Frazier** (7th, 4.292); **Gunnar Henderson** (12th, 4.22) and **Cedric Mullins** (21st, 4.13) also rank in the top 21 in the AL.

NEED FOR SPEED: The O's have 25 stolen bases, tied for second in MLB with the Pirates and trailing only the Guardians (28 SB) for the most in MLB this season...The 25 steals through the first 22 games of the year are the most in O's history (since 1954) to open a campaign, though the team has not stolen base in the last five games since April 19 (1 CS)...The O's have only been caught stealing four times for an 86.2 percent success rate...**Cedric Mullins** is tied with Chicago-NL's Nico Hoerner for second in MLB with nine stolen bases, behind only Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. with 12, while **Jorge Mateo** is tied for second in the AL and fourth in MLB with eight steals...The duo's 17 combined stolen bases are more than 17 MLB teams while four teams have eight-or-fewer steals to start 2023.

⚾ Mullins' nine successful stolen bases are the most to begin a season by an Oriole since Adam Jones also swiped his first nine attempts in 2013; the last Orioles to steal 10-or-more bases successfully without being caught to begin a season are **Brian Roberts** and **Corey Patterson**, who each swiped their first 13 attempts, an O's record, to begin 2006.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** returns for his fifth season...In 2022, he led the O's to an 83-79 record, his first winning season as manager and the club's first winning campaign since 2016...He was named the *Baseball America* MLB Manager of the Year and was voted the *Sporting News American League* Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers...He finished second in voting for the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) American League Manager of the Year award...Hyde was named the 20th manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his third start of the season, first at home, and sixth career start against the Red Sox tonight...Made 23 starts in his inaugural season with the Orioles in 2022...Went 4-7 with a 4.90 ERA (64 ER/117.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts to 46 walks...Was one of 13 O's players (7 pitchers) to make their debut in 2022...Threw to Adley Rutschman in Rutschman's debut on May 21 vs. Tampa Bay...Tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings across four starts from August 26 to September 6...Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Kyle Brnovich**, **RHP Zach Peek**, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season on April 19 at Washington...Worked 6.0 scoreless innings on five hits with one walk and six strikeouts...Marked his first start since being placed on the 15-day Injured List (right foot contusion) on April 5 (retroactive to 4/4)...Threw 92 pitches, 59 strikes.

CAREER AGAINST BOSTON: Making his sixth career start against the Red Sox...Made his MLB debut against Boston on April 29, 2022 at Oriole Park; dealt the loss after allowing three runs (2 ER) on five hits (1 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Sports an 0-3 record with a 7.54 ERA (19 ER/22.2 IP) in his five career starts against Boston...Did not factor into the decision in his last outing against the Red Sox on September 27, 2022 at Fenway Park, surrendering seven runs on four hits (1 HR) with four walks, three strikeouts, and a hit batter.

CAREER AGAINST AL EAST: Making his 15th career start against the AL East...Went 0-7 with a 7.21 ERA (51 ER/63.2 IP) in 14 starts against division foes in 2022...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in seven of his final eight starts against the division...Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the AL East on October 2, 2022 at New York-AL after allowing an unearned run on three hits with five walks and five punchouts.

HOME COOKING: Making his first home start of the 2023 season tonight...Owned a 1-5 record with a 5.00 ERA (35 ER/63.0 IP) in 12 starts at Oriole Park in 2022...Earned his first career win at OPACY on September 22 vs. Houston, working a career-high 8.2 scoreless innings on two hits and 10 strikeouts...Has pitched to a 3.03 ERA (10 ER/29.2 IP) with 26 strikeouts in his last five home starts since August 9, 2022.

SAVING HIS BEST FOR THE BEST: Made 14 starts against teams that qualified for the 2022 playoffs in his debut season, going 4-4 with a 4.24 (36 ER/76.1 IP) ERA...The Orioles owned a 9-5 record in those games...He went 2-0 against Houston, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings on August 26 at Minute Maid Park and throwing another 8.2 shutout frames on September 22 at Oriole Park.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Started the season with Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in three starts with the team...Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 11-17 after going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in two starts...Recalled from Norfolk on April 29 and made his MLB debut later that day against the Boston Red Sox...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) on June 24...Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in his final 13 starts after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on July 29...Notched his first win at Oriole Park on September 22 vs. Houston after surrendering two hits and recording ten punchouts in 8.2 scoreless innings...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 16 of his 23 starts.
