**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles beat the Yankees, 5-3, clinching a Postseason following Minnesota's loss to Miami...Marks the fourth time in team history that the club has made the playoffs in at least two straight seasons, joining 1996-97, 1973-74, and 1969-71 (3)...**Dean Kremer** allowed one run in 5.0 innings to improve to 4-1 in his last eight starts...The O's hit three home runs, including the 44<sup>th</sup> of the year by **Anthony Santander** and the 23<sup>rd</sup> by **Colton Cowser**.

**BE THE NOISE:** Fans can now purchase Postseason tickets for potential games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards by visiting [Orioles.com/postseason](http://Orioles.com/postseason)...It's time for Birdland to set the tone, pack the Yard, and Be The Noise.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's trail the Yankees by 5.0 games in the AL East, needing to win out with New York losing out to earn their second straight division title...The club holds the top Wild Card spot ahead of the Tigers and Royals (+4.0 games)...Baltimore can clinch home field advantage in the Wild Card with a win and a Detroit loss vs. Tampa Bay tonight...The Birds hold the head-to-head tiebreaker with the Royals (4-2) and lose a tiebreaker with the Tigers (2-4)...The O's have lost seven of their last 11 and 10 of 15...The team is 34-39 (.466) since July 1, 29-32 (.475) since the All-Star break, and 22-26 (.458) since August 1... Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 188-131 (.589), the best record in the AL and the third-best winning percentage in MLB during that time, behind the Dodgers (.605, 193-126) and Braves (.596, 190-129).  
 O's New York leads the division at 92-65 (.586); an AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since Boston won the division in 2017 and 2016 with a .574 record.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles rank second in MLB with 228 home runs, ahead of the Dodgers (225) while trailing the Yankees (230)...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 89 home runs since, 13<sup>th</sup> in MLB...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13<sup>th</sup> time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2017 (232).

O's Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Dodgers and Red Sox for the most in MLB this season: **Anthony Santander** (44), **Gunnar Henderson** (37), **Colton Cowser** (23), **Adley Rutschman** (19), **Cedric Mullins** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (11); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

O's Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (56) and Juan Soto (40); the O's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

O's The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (15); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)...He passed **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004), who held the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...He would also be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with **Brady Anderson** (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

O's He was voted the 2024 Most Valuable Oriole by members of the local media; he's the eighth player to earn MVO in back-to-back seasons and the first since **Adam Jones** in 2011-12.

O's Henderson earned AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; Henderson slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

O's His 116 runs scored are fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Roberto Alomar** set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), **Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), **Anderson** (2, 1995-96), and **Ripken, Jr.** (3, 1983-85).

O's He's on pace to score 120 times; Alomar, **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and **Ripken, Jr.** (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

O's Oriole ranks third in the AL and fourth in MLB with 8.2 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since **Ripken, Jr.** set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; four O's (six occurrences) have finished a season with an 8.0 fWAR, along with **Ripken, Jr.** (3x; 10.6, 1991; 9.8, 1984; & 8.5, 1983), **Brooks Robinson** (8.1, 1964), **F. Robinson** (8.2, 1966), and **Jim Gentile** (8.0, 1961).

O's He has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996.

**MASHED TATERS:** **Anthony Santander** ranks third in MLB with 44 home runs, trailing New York-AL's Aaron Judge (56) and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (53)...He's the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season and one of four (five occurrences) with at least 44 (see chart at right).

O's His solo home run last night gave him 100 RBI for the season, the first Oriole to reach that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; he's the fourth Oriole switch-hitter to do so, joining **Eddie Murray** (5x, 1980, 82-85), **Ken Singleton** (2x, 1979-80), and **Bobby Bonilla** (1996).

O's Santander has hit 35 home runs since the start of June, behind Ohtani (39) and Judge (36) for the most in MLB; no other player has more than 27 during that time.

O's His 105 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and are second in the AL, behind only Judge (155).

O's He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

**HOLY COWSER:** **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 23 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023... Among rookies, Cowser leads the AL and ranks third in MLB with 3.9 fWAR, behind San Diego's Jackson Merrill (5.1) and Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (4.2)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1<sup>st</sup>, 75), total bases (1<sup>st</sup>, 216), extra-base hits (2<sup>nd</sup>, 49), walks (2<sup>nd</sup>, 51), slugging percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .447), RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>, 65), OPS (3<sup>rd</sup>, .771), doubles (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 23), and on-base percentage (4<sup>th</sup>, .324).

O's His 10 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

O's He's two home runs shy of becoming the fifth Oriole rookie to hit at least 25 homers in a season, along with Henderson, **Ryan Mountcastle** (33, 2011), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (28, 1982), and **Eddie Murray** (27, 1977); Mountcastle is the only one of that group who did not win Rookie of the Year.

**AGAINST THE YANKEES:** The Orioles and Yankees wrap up their season series with three games at Yankee Stadium through Thursday...The O's are 7-4 against the Yanks this year and have clinched a winning record against New York-AL in back-to-back seasons for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2015-2017.

O's Prior to the series between the teams from July 12-14 at Oriole Park, the O's had gone 22 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, going 16-0-6 in series and 49-23 (.681) overall during that time; that was the longest streak by a team against its own division without a series loss since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*; the Birds have gone 2-4-1 in series and 12-12 (.500) overall since.

**DOCUMENT IT:** A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.  
 O's The project is being filmed and produced by Mike Tollin Productions; creator of projects such as "The Last Dance", "The Captain", and "Justice USA", Mike Tollin Productions is the nation's premier production house for sports documentaries and storytelling.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his ninth start with the Orioles and 28<sup>th</sup> this season tonight against the Yankees...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to his start on September 1; placed on the IL (right shoulder inflammation) on August 20, retroactive to August 17; marked his second stint on the IL this season after being reinstated on June 5 (lower back inflammation)...Won his first five starts to begin his Orioles career, joining Jack Harshman (1958) as the only Orioles to win each of their first five appearances with the club in team history; Eflin is the first to win each of his first five with all of them being starts and the first Oriole to win each of his first five starts with the team since Ben McDonald (7/21-8/13/90)...Was acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26...Became the first MLB pitcher since Andrew Cashner in 2019 to make back-to-back starts against the same opponent with different franchises in the same season (BAL and BOS against TOR), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*; no pitcher had been acquired by the Orioles in the same season and faced the same opponent he did in his previous start in franchise history (since 1954)...Ranks in the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile with a 2.9 walk percentage this season, per Statcast...His 16 wins in 2023 were tied with Toronto's Chris Bassitt for the most in the American League, becoming the third Rays pitcher to lead the AL in wins and helping him finish sixth in the AL Cy Young award voting...Signed a three-year contract with the Rays on December 13, 2022...Spent seven seasons with the Phillies, going 36-45 with a 4.49 ERA (329 ER/659.1 IP) in 127 outings (115 GS) from 2016-2022...Acquired by Philadelphia from Los Angeles-NL on December 19, 2014 in exchange for Jimmy Rollins and cash considerations...Traded to the Dodgers a day prior as part of a package for Matt Kemp...Originally selected by the Padres in the C-A round (33<sup>rd</sup> overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Paul J. Hagerly (FL) High School.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision on September 19 vs. San Francisco after exiting with a 3-2 lead...Allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts in 6.0 innings...11 of his 13 runs surrendered as an Oriole have scored via home runs...Notched his 13<sup>th</sup> quality start...Has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer runs in all eight of his starts to begin his career with Baltimore; the only Orioles starters to have longer streaks to begin their career with the team this century are Jeremy Guthrie in 2007 (11) and current teammate Corbin Burnes this season (15)...Threw 93 pitches, 63 strikes.

**AGAINST THE YANKEES:** Making his ninth career start against the Yankees...Owns a lifetime 3-3 record with a 2.11 ERA (11 ER/47.0 IP) in eight prior outings...Suffered the loss after allowing five runs (4 ER) on seven hits and a career-high-tying four walks with five strikeouts across 5.0 innings in his last start against the Yankees on July 19 (w/TB) at Yankee Stadium...Is 0-2 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) in three games against them this season.

**AGAINST THE AL EAST:** Appearing in his 33<sup>rd</sup> career game (31<sup>st</sup> GS) against the AL East...Has gone 13-10 with a 3.84 ERA (75 ER/175.2 IP) in those games...His last appearance against the division came on September 7 vs. Tampa Bay; suffered the loss after allowing three runs on eight hits (2 HR) and one walk with four strikeouts in 5.2 innings...Four of his eight starts since joining the Orioles have come against AL East foes.

**WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:** Eflin has issued 19 walks in 160.2 innings this season; his 1.06 BB/9 is the best in MLB among qualified pitchers...His 2.9 walk percentage ranks in the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile in MLB this season, the second-best mark among qualified pitchers, per Statcast, trailing only Seattle's Bryan Woo (2.6); the 2.9% walk rate would be his career low; the lowest walk rate by an Oriole in the Statcast era is Tommy Hunter (3.3, 2011)...12 of his 27 starts this season have been walkless, the fourth most in MLB, trailing Chicago-AL's Garrett Crochet (13), Seattle's George Kirby (14), and St. Louis' Miles Mikolas (15); had 13 such starts last year, tied for second most in MLB with Mikolas, while trailing Kirby (16)...Has not walked more than one batter since July 19 at New York-AL (4), a streak of nine straight starts.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Eflin is 0-1 with a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/15.2 IP) in 11 career Postseason outings (1GS)...Made his first career Postseason start last season, taking the loss in Game 1 of the American League Wild Card series against the Texas Rangers on October 4 at Tropicana Field (w/TB)...Allowed five runs on nine hits (2 HR) and two walks (1 IBB) in 5.0 innings...Appeared in 10 playoff games in relief for the Phillies in 2022, posting a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) en route to an NL pennant.
