

RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and New York Mets wrap up their four-game weekend series tonight at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis is 2-5 on its seven-game homestand against the Oakland Athletics (2-1) and New York Mets (0-3), teams with lowest (\$56.8 million) and highest (\$330.6 million) Opening Day payrolls in MLB this season ... After today's game, the Cardinals embark on a seven-day, six-game Pennsylvania road trip through Pittsburgh (Mon.-Wed) and Philadelphia (Fri.-Sun).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals have lost four straight, dropping to a season-low 16 games below .500 for the 5th time this season ... St. Louis enters the day in 5th place in the NL Central, a season-low 13.0 games out of first and 10.0 games back in the NL Wild Card chase ... St. Louis has spent 104 of 139 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... This season is the Cardinals slowest start since 1995 when they were 52-72 (.419) after 124 games ... St. Louis needs to finish 27-11 (.710) over the remaining 38 games to end with .500 record.

POND SCUM: With a win today, the Cardinals would avoid their first fourgame series sweep to the Mets since April 24-27, 1986 at Busch Stadium II

. The last time the Cardinals were swept by the Mets in any series was the 2007 season-opening three-game set (April 1-4) at Busch Stadium III ... St. Louis has been swept in a series five times this season (four at home) ... The last time they were swept in a four-game series at home was June 3-6, 2021 by the division-rival Cincinnati Reds.

HALL of FAME

DAK ATTACK: Dakota Hudson is 20-5 (.800 win pct.) in 53 career games (36 starts) at home, trailing only Chris Carpenter (2.61) in Busch Stadium ERA (2.71) among pitchers with a minimum 225.0 IP ... Of pitchers with 25 or more home decisions, Hudson's .800 winning pct. ranks 3rd all-time among pitchers in MLB history behind **José Fernández** (29-2, .935), and **Emil Yde** (27-6, .818).

EASY LIKE SUNDAY MORNING: The Cardinals are 12-7 on Sundays this season, their only day of the week with a winning record ... St. Louis is 8-2 as the home team on Sunday, including a 7-2 mark at Busch Stadium while wearing their Sunday hats. IN THE END: The Cardinals are just 12-28 in series openers, but 24-15 in series finales.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 20, 1998): First baseman Mark McGwire becomes the first player in Major League history to hit 50 home runs in three consecutive seasons (1996-98) ... Brian Jordan and Big Mac go back-to-back in the 7th inning off Willie Blair to power the Cardinals to a 2-0 win over the Mets in the first game of a doubleheader at Shea Stadium.

### **NEW YORK CONNECTIONS**

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Tommy Edman doubled off Steven Matz for his first career MLB hit (June 14, 2019 at Citi Field).

Adam Wainwright (Sept. 11, 2005 at Busch II), Brendan Donovan (April 25, 2022 at Busch III), and **Masyn Winn** (Aug. 18, 2023 at Busch III) made MLB debuts against the Mets.

Richie Palacios was born in Brooklyn...2015 graduate of Berkely Carroll School in Brooklyn ...favorite professional NY teams are Giants and Brooklyn Nets...favorite athlete growing up was Derek Jeter, and attended his last Yankees home game.

Cardinals Bench Coach **Joe McEwing** played five seasons with the Mets (2000-04)... appeared in 11 games with the Mets during the 2000 postseason as the club reached the World Series...originally traded by St. Louis to New York in exchange for **Jesse Orosco** (March 18, 2000)...played college baseball at the County College of Morris in Ran-dolph Township, NJ, where his uniform is retired.

Cardinals Hall of Famer José Oquendo played the first two seasons MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis for John Young and Angel Salazar (April 2, 1985).

Adam Ottavino was selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft. pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals last season... acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with Chris Stattron from Pittsburgh in exchange for Johan Oviedo and Malcom Nuñez.

Rafael Ortega was claimed off waivers by St. Louis in 2014 and played two seasons (2014-15) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

**Sam Coonrod** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby Carrollton (III.) High School...pitched three seasons at Southern Illinois University-Carbondale (2012-14).

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Mets First Base Coach Wayne Kirby played in 98 games for Memphis (AAA) in 1998, where he was teammates with **Ron "Pop" Warner** and **Joe McE**wing...traded by St. Louis to the Mets for **Shawn Gilbert** (June 10, 1998).

Hall of Fame Manager Joe Torre played for and managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Mets (1975-77 & 1977-81).

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator Scott **Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Tylor Megill's older brother, Trevor Megill, was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign, returning to Loyola Marymount (Calif.) University.

Cardinals broadcaster Ricky Horton was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter Jim Hayes was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...gradu-ated from SUNY-Geneseo.

Cardinals Hall of Famer Jason Isringhausen was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

Cardinals AGM/Player Dev. **Gary LaRocque** previously served as Scouting Dir., AGM & VP/ Player Dev. and Scouting with the Mets from (1998-2005)...appointed VP of Pro Scouting in 2006.

#### TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 5th start of the season and 11th appearance since his promotion from Memphis (AAA) at the beginning of July.
- Is facing the New York Mets for the 4th times, but the 1st time at Busch Stadium since 4/21/19 when he as credited with a 6-4 win despite allowing three solo HR's.
- He's 20-5 (.800 win pct.) in 53 career games (36 starts) at Busch Stadium, and ranks 3rd in ERA (2.71) all-time at Busch III among pitchers with a minimum 200.0 IP.
- Of pitchers with 25 or more home decisions, his .800 winning pct., ranks 5th among starting pitchers in MLB history trailing Jose Fernandez (29-2, .935), Howie Krist (20-4, .833), Emil Yde (27-6, .818) and Tony Gonsolin (20-5, .800).
- Is 3-0 in August and has won a career-best 5-straight decisions dating to 9/17/22.
- The Cardinals are 44-27 (.620 win pct.) in his 71 career games started and 27-9 (.750) in his 36 career games started at Busch Stadium.
- Spent bulk of 2023 season at Memphis (AAA) where he was 5-4, 6.00 ERA in 11 starts.
- Has appeared in 106 career MLB games, going 36-17, 3.64 ERA, including team-leading 16 wins in 2019 when he finished 5th in NL ROY voting.
- Was 8-7, 4.45 ERA in 27 games (26 starts) for Cardinals last season. Tied for MLB lead with 25 GIDPs induced.
- Was brought up as the 27th player for the DH vs. NYY (7/1) in Game 2 and pitched 2.2 innings.
- Was recalled on 7/5 from Memphis (AAA) and was thrust into action that night allowing two runs in 2.2 relief innings at MIA.
- Earned his 1st win of season with 3.1 scoreless IP on 7/15 vs. WSH, matching STL season high for IP by a reliever. It came in his 100th career appearance.
- Made first start of the season on 7/19 vs. MIA (3.0 IP), throwing 66 pitches
- Made his longest relief app. (4.1 IP) this season on 7/27 vs. CHI after Mikolas was ejected in the 1st inning. Threw a then season-high 93 pitches.
- Dating to last season, has allowed just 10 HR's in his last 29 games (147.1 IP). Had a career-best 46.1 homerless IP streak from 5/8-6/23/22. It was longest for the Cardinals since Trevor Rosenthal's 54.0 IP in 2015.

### LAST TIME OUT

Ran his win streak to 4 games, one shy of his career-best, in a 6-2 win vs. OAK this past
Tue. (8/15). It was his 20th career win at Busch Stadium III. He threw a season-high
101 pitches, 70 for strikes, and held the Athletics scoreless over his first 6.0 IP.

### CAREER

- Among active pitchers with 50 or more decisions, ranks 5th in career winning percentage (.679, 36-17) with three Dodgers leading the list: Walker Buehler (.742, 46-16), Julio Urias (.720, 59-23) & Clayton Kershaw (.696, 208-91).
- Has not lost three straight decisions dating back through his freshman season at Mississippi State including minor league baseball.
- Won a team-leading 16 games in 2019, becoming the first Cardinals rookie to lead the team in victories since Matt Morris (12 in 1997). His 16 wins were the most by a Cardinals rookie since Dick Hughes (16 in 1964). His .696 win pct. (16-7) was the best by Cardinals rookie since Hughes (.727, 16-6) in 1964.
- Hudson's .818 (9-2) home winning pct. in 2019 ranked 5th among all Cardinals rookie starters and highest since Harvey Haddix (.867, 13-2) in 1953.
- Led NL in walks (87) in 2019, the first Cardinal to do so since Ken Hill (99) in 1989.
