**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 13-10 at home, going 4-2-1 in series play....the team has gone 8-3 in their last 11 home games after a 5-7 start.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 18-13 on the road, going 5-4-1 in series play....the team took 2 of 3 games at Boston on its last trip to snap a streak of four straight road series losses....the Brewers went 4-0-1 in their first five road series this season.

**MANAGER:** **Pat Murphy** was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

**COACHES:** First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....**Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 12 replay challenges this season, going 7-5....their last challenge came on 5/28 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at second base involving Willy Adames stood.

**TONIGHT'S STARTER: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON (13g, 6gs, 3-1, 2.86)**

**WILSON AT A GLANCE:** Bryse Wilson, 26, will be making his 14th appearance and seventh start of the season....Wilson last pitched last Friday at Boston in relief and earned a 7-2 win (5.1ip, 6h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 7k, 1hr, 80 pitches)....he has gone 0-1 with a 2.20 ERA as a starter (28.2ip, 7er) and 3-0 with a 4.11 ERA in relief (15.1ip, 7er)....opponents are batting .219 (34-for-160, 7hr)....the team is 3-3 in his starts....he has 2 quality starts....his last start prior to this season came on 9/28/22 vs. Cincinnati....he made 59 straight relief appearances between starts....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

**LAST SEASON:** Wilson went 6-0 with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career....he held opponents to a .211 batting average, marking a career best.

**CAREER:** Is 18-18 with a 4.56 ERA and 4 saves in 122 games/49 starts (353ip, 179er)....is in his seventh Major League season with Atlanta (2018-21), Pittsburgh (2021-22) and Milwaukee (2023-24)....is 9-17 with a 5.08 ERA as a starter (226.2ip, 128er) and 9-1 with a 3.63 ERA in relief (126.1ip, 51er)....Wilson was selected by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Orange (NC) High School....he committed to the University of North Carolina prior to being drafted....Wilson was traded by the Braves to the Pirates, along with RHP Ricky DeVito, in exchange for RHP Richard Rodríguez on 7/30/21.

**CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD:** Is 4-3 with a 3.22 ERA in 36 games/6 starts (72.2ip, 26er)....is 0-1 with a 2.50 ERA in 5 games/3 starts this season (18ip, 5er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 10-11 with a 4.48 ERA in 59 games/25 starts (170.2ip, 85er)....is 3-0 with a 3.12 ERA in 8 games/3 starts this season (26ip, 9er).

**CAREER vs. CUBS:** Is 1-2 with a 5.55 ERA in 10 games/6 starts (35.2ip, 44h, 26r, 22er, 14bb, 24k, 5hr)....made 3 appearances against the Cubs last season, all coming in relief (4ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 5k, 0hr).
