THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

AUG. 21

1985 - Astros HOFer **Phil Garner** singles as a pinch-hitter in the Astros 8-3 loss to the Reds in the 'Dome...this single gives Garner six straight hits in six straight at-bats as a pinch-hitter, which is a franchise record...five other Astros have had streaks of five, most recently done by **Morgan Ensberg** in the 2003 season.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros, who own a slim 1.0-game lead in the AL West over the Rangers, will open a huge three-game weekend series against the A's tonight at Daikin Park in Houston, TX...**RHP Hayden Wesneski** (2-1) will make his fifth start of the season tonight and his first against the A's, who are starting **RHP J.T. Ginn** (8-7).

BIG WES: After missing 14 months with injury, **RHP Hayden Wesneski** has returned to the Astros rotation to make four starts, pitching into the 6th inning in three of four and recording two quality starts...this continues a strong run for Wesneski, who was great in his rehab outings, posting a 2.25 ERA (5ER/20IP) in five minor league rehab starts.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 44-33 since May 22, which is the second-best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: Among American League teams, the Astros rank first in slugging (.410), first in total bases (1766), second in home runs (170), third in runs scored (583), and third in OPS (.727)...in the Majors, the Astros rank third in homers, trailing only the Nationals (182) and Yankees (175).

MLB PLAYERS' WEEKEND: Major League Baseball will be celebrating **MLB Players' Weekend** across baseball beginning tonight...Players' Weekend is all about celebrating players and what makes them one-of-one...custom gear, personal stories, and pure self expression will come to life this weekend.

WELCOME BACK JEFF!: **2B Jeff Kent**, who was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in July, will throw out tonight's ceremonial first pitch... Kent spent two (2003-04) of his 17 MLB seasons with the Astros, helping the 2004 Astros advance to the NLCS...Kent authored one of the most-iconic moments in Astros postseason lore, as he hit a walkoff homer in Game 5 of the 2004 NLCS vs. STL.

TONIGHT'S SPECIAL GUESTS: **Gallagher** and the Astros will host athletes from **Special Olympics Texas** tonight...the group will attend batting practice and speak with Astros players and coaches in a special event pregame in the press conference room...one athlete will also throw out a ceremonial first pitch and give the Play Ball Call.

TONIGHT'S RADIO BROADCASTS: The Astros English radio broadcast can be heard on SportsTalk 790 featuring **Robert Ford** and **Kevin Eschenfelder**, who is subbing for **Steve Sparks** tonight... the Spanish radio broadcast will feature **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on TUDN 102.9 FM.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped the rubber game of their three-game series with the visiting Angels last night by a lopsided score of 18-3...**DH Yordan Alvarez** doubled and walked in his two plate appearances while **3B Isaac Paredes** went 2x4 with a double on the night.

ASTROS ROSTER MOVES: The Astros have recalled **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** from Triple A Sugar Land today after optioning **LHP Bryan King** to Triple A last night...also, announced yesterday, the club recalled **IF Raynel Delgado** from Triple A and designated **OF Nelson Velázquez** for assignment.

ON THE MEND: The Astros have four players on the Major League Injured List...updates on three:

- **RHP Mike Burrows** (rt. elbow neuritis) made his second rehab start at Triple A Sugar Land last night, tossing 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and two walks with five strikeouts on 78 pitches.
- **IF Carlos Correa** (lt. ankle tendon injury) is participating in baseball activity, including a hitting and a running progression.
- **OF Brice Matthews** (lt. knee sprain) is participating in on-field baseball activity and a running progression.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** holds the lead in all AL Triple Crown categories, ranking first in average (.319), first in HR (36) and first in RBI (88)... additionally, he leads MLB in OPS (1.045), OBP (.432), SLG (.613), and TB (279)...in the AL, he ranks first in XBH (62), and second in hits (145), walks (87), and runs (84)...AL leaders below:

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has hit 36 home runs this season, which leads the AL...he's just one homer shy of matching his career high in homers, which was 37, hit in 2022.

HIT PAREDES: **3B Isaac Paredes** has hit safely in nine of his last 12 games (since Aug. 7), including six multi-hit games, while batting .378 (17x45) with four doubles, one home run, seven RBI, and a .973 OPS in that span.

THE CLOSER: **LHP Josh Hader** has made 500 career appearances and is the 15th active pitcher to reach that milestone...Hader has been stellar since returning from injury in June, going 4-1 with a 0.87 ERA (3ER/31IP), 41 strikeouts, a .123 opponent average (13x106) and a 0.77 WHIP, while converting all 18 of his save chances in 32 appearances.

VS. THE A'S: The Astros are 3-3 against the A's this season but have not seen them in over two months since they took two of three games in Houston from June 5-7...after this series, the two clubs will match up for a four-game series in Sacramento to end the regular season from Sept. 24-27.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Several of the Astros minor league clubs are having success this season:

- **Triple A Sugar Land:** In the second half, the Space Cowboys (33-15) are in first in the PCL East Division.
- **Class A Fayetteville:** For the second half, the Woodpeckers are in first place in the South Atlantic League North Division with a 29-20 (.583) record.
- **Rookie Level FCL Astros:** The Astros won the Florida Complex League championship, finishing with a 42-11 (.792) record in the regular season.
- **Rookie Level DSL Astros:** The DSL Astros Orange finished with a 33-20 record and clinched a spot in the DSL playoffs, which began yesterday.

LAST START, AUGUST 15 vs. SEA: Allowed 5 runs on 7 hits and 1 walk with 6 strikeouts in 4.0 innings...marked his 1st loss of the season (last, May 6, 2025 at MIL).

RETURN OF THE WEZ: In his return from Tommy John surgery, he's recorded a 5.16 ERA (13ER/22.2IP), a 1.32 WHIP and a .271 opponent batting average through his first 4 starts of the year...the Astros are 3-1 in his starts...tossed consecutive quality starts on Aug. 10 at SF (7 IP, 5 H, 3 ER, 2 BB, 4K) and Aug. 4 vs. TOR (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...he also recorded a winning decision in back-to-back starts to open the year (Aug. 4 vs. TOR and July 29 at LAA).

ON THE CHASE: Has induced a 36.0-percent chase rate, which would mark a career high...his previous high was a 30.2-percent rate through 28 games (7 starts) with the Cubs in 2024...has logged a 40.2-percent chase rate with his sweeper, the highest of any of his pitches...his 40.2-percent chase percentage vs. his sweeper ranks 10th in the AL this season (min. 70 sweepers thrown).

VS. ATH: Has made 1 career appearance against the Athletics...on April 17, 2023 as a member of the Cubs, he allowed 1 run on 5 hits and no walks with 7 strikeouts in 7.0 innings...the Cubs went on to defeat the Athletics, 10-1.

ON THE WAY BACK: Underwent Tommy John surgery on May 23, 2025...returned to the mound to begin his rehab appearances on June 30, 2026, with the FCL Astros (3IP)...advanced to Double A Corpus Christi for 1 start, then made 3 starts for Triple A Sugar Land...combined to post a 2.25 ERA (5ER/20IP) in his 5 rehab appearances...struck out 21 in his 20.0 innings, allowed a .211 opponent average, and posted a 1.00 WHIP...walked just 4 hitters across his 5 rehab starts.

WESNESKI IN 2025: Began last season in the Astros starting rotation and went on to make 6 starts, going 1-3 with a 4.50 ERA (16ER/32IP) prior to his injury...had a couple strong starts, tossing a career-high-tying 7.0 innings on April 7 at SEA, and fanning a career-high 10 hitters on April 13 vs. LAA.

TRADE WINDS: Acquired by the Astros from the Cubs on Dec. 13, 2024 as part of the return for All-Star **OF Kyle Tucker**...the Astros received Wesneski, **3B Isaac Paredes** and **RF Cam Smith** in that trade.

HOUSTON'S OWN: Wesneski was born in Houston, TX, and raised in Cypress, TX, which is about a 25-mile drive northwest of downtown Houston...grew up an Astros fan with **RHP Roy Oswalt** as his favorite player...he graduated from Cy Fair HS, then went on to nearby Sam Houston State, where he pitched for 3 seasons...was selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2019 MLB draft...was traded twice after his selection, first by the Yankees to the Cubs, then by the Cubs to the Astros.

WHAT'S A BEARKAT ANYWAY?: Is one of the most-accomplished pitchers in Sam Houston State history...went 25-9 with a 3.56 ERA and 224 strikeouts (288.0 IP) in 3 years with the Bearkats (2017-19)...his 224 career strikeouts rank 4th all-time in program history...other notable Bearkats include Astros radio broadcaster **Steve Sparks** and Astros 2024 first-round pick **C Walker Janek**.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/19 vs. LAA): Worked a perfect 8th inning and struck out 2 in Wed's night win, picking up his 9th hold...tossed a 98.7-mph fastball in the outing, marking his 4th-hardest pitch of the season.

VS. ATH: In 33 career regular-season appearances vs. the A's, he's posted a 2.39 ERA (10ER/37.2IP), a 0.90 WHIP, 10.51 SO/9IP and a .161 opponent batting average.

SCORELESS STREAK: Recorded a 12-game scoreless streak that spanned 12.0 innings from July 18-Aug. 12...he recorded 17 strikeouts, 4 walks, a 0.58 WHIP and a .077 opponent batting average throughout the streak...it is the second-longest streak by an Astros pitcher this season, behind only LHP Steven Okert's 14-game scoreless streak from May 23-June 24.

A CUT ABOVE: Began throwing a cutter this season in his outing on June 2 vs. PIT and has tossed the pitch at a 8.8-percent rate since that date...has held opponents to a .154 batting average (2x13) vs. his cutter this year...since beginning to throw a cutter on June 2, he's posted a 2.60 ERA (8ER/27.2IP) with 36 strikeouts and a .177 opponent average in 28 appearances.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 4-1-6 with a 2.21 ERA (9ER/36.2IP)...also has 43 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .169 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...his .169 opponent average since May 3 ranks 8th among AL relievers (min. 35 IP).

LAST APPEARANCE (8/20 vs. LAA): Tossed a scoreless 1.0 inning with 2 strikeouts, while working around 1 hit on Wed. night vs. LAA...recorded his 7th hold of the season.

TWO FOR BLU: Ranks 1st in the Majors with 24 relief appearances of 2.0+ innings...are the most by an Astro since RHP Octavio Dotel logged 24 appearances of 2.0+ innings in 2001...also leads MLB with 13 scoreless relief appearances of 2.0+ innings.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Leads MLB relievers with 78.0 IP, with MIL LHP Aaron Ashby (68.2 IP) the next closest...also leads MLB with 30 multi-inning apps. and ranks T-5th among AL relievers with 79 strikeouts.

REVERSE SPLIT: Has held left-handed hitters to a .182 average (27x148) with 42 strikeouts this season...is the 6th-lowest opponent average vs. left-handed hitters by a right-handed pitcher in the AL (min. 100 BF).
