RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude a six-game, six-day Midwest road trip through Chicago (0-3) and Milwaukee (1-1, 1 to play) this afternoon at American Family Field... following tomorrow's off day, Tampa Bay embarks on a nine-game, 10-day homestand featuring matchups with Mets, White Sox and Yankees...the Rays will don their "Grit x Grind" City Connect uniforms for the entire weekend series vs. the Mets.

In last night's 8-2 defeat, eight of nine Tampa Bay starters struck out at least once... the lone exception was **CF Jose Siri** (1-for-3, HR, 2R, HBP)...Siri's 452 ft. HR was the farthest hit by a Ray this season, surpassing **Brandon Lowe's** 444 ft. shot on March 29 vs. Toronto.

Tampa Bay's 13 strikeouts were tied for its most in a nine-inning game this season (also April 5 at COL)...the Rays had 14 SO on April 20 at New York-AL (10 inn.).

The Rays did not draw a walk in last night's defeat, marking the first time since Sept. 15, 2021 at Toronto (15SO, 0BB) that the Rays struck out 13+ times with zero walks in a nine-inning game...Tampa Bay is the only team in the majors this season to have multiple games with 13+ SO and zero walks (also April 20 at NYY).

The Rays five hits were tied for their fewest in a road game this season (also April 21 at New York-AL).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

- Improve to 4-2 in rubber games, including 3-1 on the road.
- Earn their first series victory since taking two of three from San Francisco from April 12-14...they are 0-2-1 since their last series win.
- Win their second series at American Family Field in club history (also June 20-22, 2011) while knotting the all-time series with the Brewers at 11-11.
- Avoid falling four games under .500 for the first time since opening the 2018 campaign 1-5.
- Kevin Cash** (753) can tie **Joe Maddon** (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

IT'S A MARATHON—The Rays finished the month of April with a 13-14 (.481) record... marked their first sub-.500 April since 2021 (also 13-14)...it marked the fourth time in franchise history Tampa Bay played 27+ games in April...the 2023 Rays played a franchise-record 28 April games, while the 2021 and 2011 clubs also played 27 contests.

Tampa Bay hit .240 in April, ranking eighth in the AL and 14th in the majors...the Rays 4.51 ERA in April was fifth worst in the majors, ahead of only Colorado (5.73), Chicago-AL (5.28), Los Angeles-AL (4.79) and Miami (4.51)...it marked the Rays highest ERA in a calendar month since July 2019 (4.75).

The Rays swiped 25 bags in April for the second consecutive season...marks the sixth time in club history they stole 25+ bases in April, joining the 2009/2011 (29SB), 2007 (28SB) and 2008 (25SB) squads.

APRIL FOOLS?—**Randy Arozarena** played 26 games in April and hit .112 (11-for-98) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI and 10 walks against 32 strikeouts...it was the lowest average by any player in the majors during the month, with the next closest being **OAK Ryan Noda** (.125) and **SEA Mitch Garver** (.138).

In 30 games overall this year, Arozarena is batting .143 (16-for-112)...it is tied with **ATL B.J. Upton** (2013) for the third-lowest batting average through March/April (min. 90AB) since 1901...**TB Greg Vaughn** hit .099 (9-for-91) to open the 2002 season, while **CIN Eugenio Suárez** hit .130 (12-for-92) to start the 2021 campaign. Arozarena has gone a career-long 27 games without a multi-hit effort dating to March 31.

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY—Tampa Bay has suffered seven losses by 6+ runs this season, tied with Chicago-AL for the most in the majors...the 2023 Rays had eight such defeats all of last season, the fewest in the majors, with the next closest clubs being the Braves and Mariners (both 9G).

The Rays have a -37 run differential through 31 games, their worst mark since 2007 (-45)...last year's club had a franchise-best +113 run differential through 31 games, posting a 25-6 (.806) record.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—Rays pitching has allowed 40 HR, tied with San Diego for third most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (42HR) and Toronto (41HR).

It marks the most home runs Tampa Bay has allowed through 31 games (in a full season) since the 2007 Devil Rays (also 40HR)...the 2020 Rays conceded 40 HR through 31 games.

Tampa Bay relievers have surrendered an MLB-high 20 long balls, ahead of Toronto (19HR) and Los Angeles-AL (18HR).

PARADES ON THE PROWL—**Isaac Paredes** has three straight multi-hit efforts, one shy of his career-long four-game streak from April 27-30, 2023...it is tied with **CLE Andrés Giménez** and **OAK Tyler Nevin** for the second-longest active streak in the majors behind **MIN Trevor Larnach** (4G).

He has hit safely in seven of his last eight games since April 23, batting .353 (12-for-34) with 2 2B and 2 HR.

WHAT A RELIEF—**Jason Adam** has not allowed an earned run over his last 10 appearances (10.2IP), limiting opponents to an .097/.237/.129 (3-for-31) line.

Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run over his last eight appearances (7.0IP), going 3-0 with two saves during that time...his three wins are tied for the most among AL relievers with **BAL Craig Kimbrel**, **DET Shelby Miller**, **OAK Mitch Spence** and **NY Yankees Luke Weaver**.

Since being recalled from Triple-A Durham on April 22, **Kevin Kelly** has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings across four appearances, allowing no hits or walks while hitting two batters and striking out six.

BRATS AND BREWS—Tampa Bay and Milwaukee conclude a three-game set today at American Family Field...the two clubs are meeting in Milwaukee for only the third time...Tampa Bay took two of three from Milwaukee from June 20-22, 2011 and did not return until Aug. 9-10, 2022, when the Brewers swept a two-game series.

DOWN ON THE FARM—On Monday, Double-A Montgomery **OF Heriberto Hernandez** was named Southern League Player of the Week for the week of April 22-28...in six games, Hernandez hit .300 (6-for-20) with two doubles, four home runs and 6 RBI.

Hernandez has reached base safely in all 19 of his games to open the season...it is the fourth-longest active on-base streak in all of MiLB.

Montgomery has been represented in each of the first three Southern League weekly awards...**SS Carson Williams** (Week 1) and **C Kenny Piper** (Week 2) were awarded Player of the Week honors, while **RHP Cole Wilcox** (Week 1) earned Pitcher of the Week honors.

- Milwaukee Associate Manager **Rickie Weeks Jr.** finished his playing career in Tampa Bay, appearing in 37 games for the Rays in 2017.
- Bally Sports Sun in-game reporter **Tricia Whitaker**, a six-time Emmy Award recipient, had a two-year stint (2014-15) covering professional and collegiate teams, including the Brewers and the Green Bay Packers, for WBAY in Green Bay, WI.
- Rays **C Ben Rortved** was born in Madison, WI and attended Verona Area High School, roughly 90 miles from American Family Field.
- Tampa Bay RHP **Pete Fairbanks**, who is currently on the injured list, was born in Milwaukee, WI.
- Brewers Senior Vice President and General Manager, **Matt Arnold**, spent nine seasons in the Rays front office from 2007-15.
- Milwaukee Hitting Coach **Ozzie Timmons**, who was born in Tampa, FL and played for the University of Tampa, was a coach in the Tampa Bay system for 15 seasons, and served as the Rays First Base Coach/Assistant Hitting Coach from 2017-21.
- Brewers RHP **Tobias Myers**, who made his MLB debut last week, was traded from Baltimore to Tampa Bay on July 31, 2017 in exchange for **Tim Beckham**, the Rays No. 1 overall pick in 2008...Myers, a Central Florida native, was later dealt by Tampa Bay to Cleveland on Nov. 19, 2021 in exchange for **INF Junior Caminero**, who is currently rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 overall prospect in baseball.

TODAY'S START—Eflin makes his seventh start of the season, including his fourth on the road...has posted a 1.96 ERA (18.1IP, 4ER) in his previous three outings...had a 14.1 scoreless inning streak halted in his last start...has averaged 1.16 runs of support per 9.0 IP in his last four starts...is seeking his first road win since Sept. 26, 2023 at Fenway Park.

LAST TIME OUT—Eflin took the loss on April 26 at Chicago to open the current road trip (L, 6.0IP, 9H, 5R, 4ER, 2BB, 4SO)...consecutive 3rd-inning walks preceded **Andrew Vaughn's** sacrifice fly, the first run of the contest...marked Eflin's third multi-walk inning since joining the Rays...permitted back-to-back one-out singles in the 6th followed by a three-run homer off the bat of **Martin Maldonado**.

✦ He issued 2+ walks for the first time since Sept. 10, 2023 vs. SEA (2)...threw 90 pitches, his most since Sept. 21, 2023 vs. LAA (92).

MIDWEST MADNESS—Eflin will be making his seventh career start opposite the Brewers, including his fourth in Milwaukee...has posted a 3.55 ERA (12.2IP, 5ER) in the previous three outings in this venue despite not pitching into the 6th inning in any of his those starts, most recently on June 9, 2022...in his lone start opposite the Brewers last season, he worked around a pair of homers to earn the win on May 20 at Tropicana Field in an 8-4 Rays victory (W, 7.0IP, 4H, 3ER, 8SO, 2HR)...he has yielded 6 HR in his last four starts against Milwaukee (2.75 HR/9.0 IP).

✦ He is 9-7 with a 3.45 ERA (130.1IP, 50ER) in 22 career starts against the NL Central, his lowest ERA against any division in his career...has gone 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (27.0IP, 7ER) and 0.63 WHIP in four starts vs. the division since joining the Rays last season, each of which were quality.

ZACH BOUNCES BACK—Eflin has allowed 5+ runs six times since the beginning of last season...in the outings immediately following the previous five starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.58 ERA (31.2IP, 2ER)...the Rays went 4-1 in those games with a +17 (32-15) run differential.

ON THE ROAD—Eflin has seen mixed results away from Tropicana Field this season...on both April 8 at LAA and April 26 at CWS, he allowed exactly five runs on nine hits...however, on April 20 at NYY, Eflin tossed 6.0 scoreless frames...overall, he is 0-2 with a 4.76 ERA (17.0IP, 9ER) in three road outings...this comes after he went 4-0 with a 1.48 ERA (30.1IP, 5ER) in his final five road starts of 2023.

ONE MONTH DOWN—Eflin's 4.08 ERA in March/April was his second-highest in a single calendar month during his Rays tenure, lower than only his 4.85 ERA (26.0IP, 14ER) in July 2023...he recorded only one win (April 2 vs. TEX), his fewest since going winless in Sept. 2022, when he worked out of the Phillies bullpen.

✦ He recorded a 14.1 scoreless inning streak from April 15-26...went 1-2 with a 6.35 ERA (17.0IP, 12ER) in his first three starts and 0-1 with a 1.96 ERA (18.1IP, 4ER) in his last three.

✦ Eflin received only 2.29 runs of support per 9.0 IP in March/April, third fewest in the AL...only a pair of Athletics pitchers, **Ross Stripling** (1.57) and **JP Sears** (2.18) had lower marks.

NO FREE RIDES—Despite coming off his first multi-walk start of the season, Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (2.7%) and walks per 9.0 IP (1.02) and ranks seventh in SO/BB ratio (7.50)...he walked only two of his first 130 BF (1.5%) in 2024 before walking consecutive batters on April 26 at CWS.

✦ He has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 4.0 pct. (min. 1,500BF), ahead of **Zack Greinke** (4.4%).

IT'S A MARATHON—In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.10 ERA (30.0IP, 7ER) and held opponents to a .207 (23-for-111) average and .541 OPS...from the 6th inning on, he owns a 15.19 ERA (5.1IP, 9ER), .484 (15-for-51) opp. average and 1.386 opp. OPS...23 of Eflin's 30 SO have come in the first five frames...he has allowed half of his 16 total runs (8) in the 6th frame, tied with **NY Yankees' Clarke Schmidt** for the most by any MLB starter in the 6th inning this season.

✦ When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 18-for-899 (.182) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 20-for-43 (.465), the highest such average in the majors (min. 40AB), ahead of **TEX Martin Pérez** (.364).
