### THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

APRIL 16, 1946

On Opening Day at the Polo Grounds, **Mel Ott** of the New York Giants hit his 511th and final home run in the Giants' 8-4 victory against the Philadelphia Phillies. Ott hit his homer off Phillies left-hander Oscar Judd. Ott would injure his knee diving for a ball in the next day, and play only occasionally thereafter.

**BE A GOLDFISH:** Losers of four straight for a second-time this season (also April 3-6), the Giants aim to stave off a sweep today here in Cincinnati after dropping last night's game 8-3 following Monday night's 2-1 defeat.

- ▶ SF enters today a season-worst six games under .500 at 6-12 (.333) through 18 games and are tied for the lowest win % in the Majors with the White Sox (also 6-12, .333).
- ▶ The 6-12 start is tied for the second-worst start in the SF-era through 18 games behind only a 5-13 (.278) start by the 1983 Giants...the other years in the SF-era the Giants started 6-12 are: 2023, 2017, 1990, 1980 and 1972...only one of those teams (1990) finished above .500 (85-77).
- ▶ The Giants are trying to avoid being swept here in Cincinnati in a three-game series for the first time since August 17-19, 2018.
- ▶ Overall, SF is 1-4 through its first five games of this nine-game road trip after going 1-2 in Baltimore and 0-2 thus far here on the banks of the Ohio River.

**IF YOU NEED A BEER, GRAB A BEER:** Four-time World Series-winning manager and current Special Advisor to Baseball Operations **Bruce Bochy** celebrates his 71st birthday today.

**ROUPPER:** RHP Landen Roupp will try his hand at being the stopper in the series finale this afternoon...SF's last win came on the first game of this road trip last Friday in Baltimore behind a solid outing from the 27-year-old Roupp.

- ▶ In that outing, Roupp picked up his second win of the season with 6.0 innings of one-run ball, five hits allowed, two walks and four strikeouts in SF's 6-3 win...in two road starts this year, Roupp is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip), 11 strikeouts, four walks and seven hits allowed.
- ▶ Roupp has faced the Reds once in his career, taking the loss on April 8 of last year despite allowing one run on seven hits with no walks and four punchouts over 6.0 innings in the Giants 1-0 loss at Oracle Park.
- ▶ In terms of being a stopper, Roupp is 1-1 this year when pitching after a Giants loss the previous game...since the start of last year, Roupp is 6-5 with a 3.24 ERA (27er, 75.0ip) in 15 starts that followed a Giants defeat...the team overall is 7-8 in those 15 games.

**WHERE CAN WE FIND A LIVE CHICKEN?:** The Giants were held to three runs or fewer for a fourth consecutive game and for the 12th time in 18 games this season last night.

- ▶ The Giants enter today with the lowest runs per game in the Majors (3.06)...they also rank inside MLB's bottom five in on-base percentage (.287, 28th), OPS (.640, 27th), walks (36, 30th) and home runs (nine, 30th)...the 36 walks are 10 fewer than the closest team (Arizona, 46).
- ▶ The last time a Giants team walked 36 or fewer times in any 18-game span within a single-season was the end of the 2018 season when they also walked 36 times in an 18-game span from September 10-30.

**EVENING OUT:** SF's bullpen threw 4.0 scoreless innings yesterday on top of tossing 3.0 scoreless on Tuesday night.

- ▶ Giants relievers were 15-for-15 in throwing first-pitch strikes over their 4.0 innings yesterday and 8-for-10 in throwing them in the series opener on Tuesday (SIS).
- ▶ Over the last seven games dating to April 7 the 'pen has a 2.57 ERA (6er, 21.0ip) with 23 strikeouts, 10 walks allowed and two home runs permitted.
- ▶ The unit's 59.1 innings pitched are second-fewest in the National League behind only the Dodgers (58.1 innings) and fifth-lowest in the Majors.

**THIS IS THE LAST STOP ON THIS TRAIN...:** Following today's game the Giants will reach the last stop on this three-city east coast swing as they'll open a three-game series back in the DMV Friday night against the Nationals at Nationals Park.

- ▶ While the Giants have struggled against the Nationals in San Francisco the last four years, it's been a different story in DC as SF has won three of the last four series its played in the District...since 2022 the Giants are 8-5 against the Nats at Nationals Park.
- ▶ Following the weekend series in Washington the Giants will fly back to San Francisco for an off day on Monday before opening up a six-game homestand against the Dodgers and Marlins next Tuesday.

# LANDEN ROUPP RHP #65

2026 RECORD: 2-1, 3.24 ERA

**WITH SAN FRANCISCO:** Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco and made his third career Opening Day roster...he is slated to make his fourth start of the season tonight after going 2-1 through his first three starts.

**LAST START:** Made his second start on the road of the season, and was stellar once again...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on five hits while striking out four in his first career matchup against Baltimore last Friday...marked the first time he's had consecutive road starts of 6.0+ innings and one-or-less runs allowed in his career (first: 6.0ip, 2h, 2bb, 7k at San Diego on 3/31/26).

**VS. REDS:** Will be making his second career appearance versus Cincinnati, and first at Great American Ball Park...was a tough-luck loser at Oracle Park the first time he faced the Reds on April 8, 2025 (L, 6.0ip, 7h, er, r, 4k) in the Giants' 1-0 loss.

**DICING IN THE DAYLIGHT:** Over 17 day games in his career (10 starts), Roupp carries an ERA of 3.29 (23er, 63.0ip) and has only allowed two home runs, boasting a .231 BAA...the Giants as a team are 5-5 in Roupp's 10 day game starts.

**(SURPRISE) ROAD WARRIOR:** Through the early going this season, has an 0.75 ERA (1er, 12.0ip) on the road compared to a 9.64 ERA at home after a tough start vs. the Mets... this is the opposite of 2025, as he had a 2.63 ERA (14er, 48.0ip) in nine starts at Oracle Park compared to a 4.76 ERA (31er, 58.2ip) in 13 starts on the road...his 2.63 home ERA ranked as the 14th-lowest among NL pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched at home.

**MIXING IT UP:** In 2025, Roupp's curveball (thrown 35.7% of the time) was very effective, as opponents were just 29x147 (.197) with 49 strikeouts and a 35.8% whiff rate against it...this season, he's mixing his pitches more, throwing the curveball just 23.9% of the time... its been just as effective, as opponents are 4x22 (.182) off the curve with a 31.3% whiff rate... the big change is his cutter usages has increased from 6.7% in 2025 to 15.2% through three starts...while opponents have hit it hard (5-for-6, three singles and two doubles) it's helped the rest of his pitches and hitters stay off his sinker and curveball.

**2025 SEASON:** Was the Giants' fourth starter for most of the season...had his year cut short after suffering a left knee bone bruise in his start on August 20 at San Diego...the injury shut his season down and he went 7-7 with a 3.80 ERA (45er, 106.2ip), 102 strikeouts and 45 walks allowed in 22 starts (eight quality outings)...the Giants went 12-10 in his outings.

**AIN'T NOBODY GOT TIME FOR THAT:** With the bases empty, Roupp averaged 11.9 seconds between pitches in 2025, which was tied for the second-quickest in the Majors...Cincinnati's Brent Suter was quickest with only 11.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty...Roupp's been a tad slower this year, averaging 12.6 seconds between pitches with the bases empty but it's still good for fifth-fastest in MLB...league average thus far in 2026 is 16.1 seconds.

- ▶ Faces the Nationals for a seventh time in his career with SF going 5-1 in his prior six outings against them...in DC, Webb is 2-1 with a 6.59 ERA (10er, 13.2ip) in three starts... his last one here came in August 2024 (W, 5.2ip, 4h, 1r)

### #47 RYAN BORUCKI ▶ LHP

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 4/15 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Lefties are 2-for-13 (.154) with two walks and four strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .181 clip (69-for-382) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 7-for-14 with three XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).

### #34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/15 at CIN; 2.0ip, 2h, bb, 2k (28 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's first 18 games and tossed 2.0 innings three times.
- ▶ Has allowed runs in one of his eight games and has issued at least one walk in six of eight contests (eight walks in 10.1ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 9-for-25 (.360) with three XBHs off him while lefties are 1-for-12 (.083).
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13, 2025 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 0.2ip, h, r, er, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ With his win on April 8, at age 33 years and 56 days old, he became the oldest pitcher in the San Francisco era (since 1958) to earn their first career MLB win as a member of the Giants.
- ▶ Has appeared in eight of SF's 18 games, tossing 7.1-innings.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 41.0innings dating to June 11, 2023, which is the 10th longest active streak in MLB.
- ▶ Signed an MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the first half of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed one run on two hits in 7.0innings with 10 strikeouts and four walks in eight games.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.

### #60 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 4/12 at BAL; 1.0ip, h, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in six of SF's 18 games, allowing four runs in 5.0ip.
- ▶ Has not allowed a homer in his last 50.1innings dating to August 14, 2024, the fifth-longest active homerless streak in MLB.
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.

### #46 BLADE TIDWELL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Sweeper, Slider, Splitter

**Last Game:** 4/15 at CIN; 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in four of his five outings (2er, 7.0ip) and posted a 0.86 WHIP.
- ▶ Recalled on April 2 with RHP José Buttó being placed on the IL...logged his first career save in his Giants debut that night pitching against the Mets, the team that drafted him.
- ▶ Pitched one game for Triple-A Sacramento on March 29, drawing the start vs. El Paso while spinning 2.2 hitless/shutoutinnings.
- ▶ Played for Giants MGR Tony Vitello while at the Tennessee...is from Loretto, TN, which has a population of about 1,700 people.
- ▶ Was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft and joined SF at last year's deadline alongside RHP José Buttó and OF Drew Gilbert in exchange for RHP Tyler Rogers.

### #74 RYAN WALKER ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Sinker, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven of SF's first 18 games.
- ▶ Batters are 2-for-13 in ABs that end with his slider and 4-for-11 in ones that end with his sinker...last season, batters hit .277 (41x148) off his slider and .207 (18x87) off his slider last season.
- ▶ In 24 save opportunities last season, he owned a 7.06 ERA (17er, 21.2ip)...in his 44 non-save situations games he had a 2.50 ERA (11er, 39.2ip)...has the most experience as a closer of any player in this current bullpen group.
- ▶ Last season, his 87.0 mph avg. exit velo ranked in top 7% of MLB.

### #67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/14 at CIN; 1.0ip, 2k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Six of his eight appearances this year have been scoreless.
- ▶ Spent most of the first half of 2025 on the injured list dealing with right shoulder tendinitis.
- ▶ Appeared in seven games with SF last season exclusively out of the 'pen, posting a 4.50 ERA (5er, 10.0ip) with nine strikeouts...prior to 2025, he had started 17 of his 21 games at the big league level.
- ▶ Overall, was 1-1 with a 8.49 ERA (22er, 23.1ip) in 14 games (three starts) with Triple-A Sacramento in 2025.

(uh-DAH-mess)

**Yesterday:** 0x4, 4k  
**CIN Series:** 2x8, r, hr, rbi, 5k (2g)  
**Road Trip:** 5x20, 2r, 2 2b, 2hr, 3rbi, bb, 7k (5g)

- ▶ Matched his career-high with four strikeouts last night (9th time).
- ▶ Despite going 0x4 last night, he's still 11-for-32 (.344) in his last eight games with nine of the 11 hits going for extra-bases.
- ▶ Overall, 12 of his 18 hits this year have been for extra-bases (nine 2B, three HR)...nine doubles are tied for most in NL (tied for second-most in MLB).
- ▶ Traditionally has been somewhat of a slow starter but his 12 XBH in March/April have surpassed his career-best 11 from March/April 2024 (29 games).
- ▶ His 145 home runs as a shortstop since 2021 are most in the Majors ahead of NYM's Francisco Lindor (140).
