**TONIGHT'S TILT...**the Mariners continue their 7-game homestand with the 2nd of 3 games vs. Houston (1-0)...began the homestand with a 4-game series win vs. Oakland (3-1)...following the current series against the Astros will embark on a 10-game road trip at Texas (3 G, 7/30-8/1), Tampa Bay (3 G, 8/2-8/4) and New York-AL (4 G, 8/5-8/8) with off days before and after the trip...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

**ODDS AND ENDS...**the Mariners won 11-8 last night after trailing 7-0...have won 4 consecutive games and are 10-4 in their last 14 games, 21-10 over their last 31, 24-11 over their last 35 and 34-20 over their last 54...are 21-13 in day games and 34-33 at night...are 33-21 at T-Mobile Park and 22-25 on the road...are 46-14 when scoring at least 4 runs and 9-32 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 38-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- **200 - Dylan Moore's** first career grand slam was the Mariners 200th in team history...since 1977, Seattle has the 4th-most grand slams behind New York-AL (226), Boston (210) and Baltimore (202).
- **Cal Started the Raleigh - Cal Raleigh** hit a 3-run double last night in the 4th inning to cut the Mariners deficit to 7-3...Seattle had a 6.6 win probability % before Raleigh's double, jumping to 14.7% after.
- **Stranger Things** - The Mariners scored a season-high 11 runs last night...most runs in a game since a 12-3 win at Oakland on Sept. 26, 2020 in game 2 of a doubleheader.
- **Last 11 Series** - The Mariners have won or split 10 of their last 11 series, owning an 8-1-2 series record in their last 11...would clinch a series victory with a win tonight.

**HIGH WATER MARK...**the Mariners enter tonight's game with a 55-46 record...they are a season-high 9 games above .500, the first time they are 9 games above since April 13, 2019 when they were 13-4...with a win tonight, they would be 10 games above .500 for the first time since April 12, 2019 when they were 13-3.

**FLEXEN AT HOME...**Chris Flexen is 6-3 with a 1.89 ERA (14 ER, 66.2 IP) in 11 starts at T-Mobile Park this season...he has 12 walks and 44 strikeouts with a 0.99 WHIP in those outings...the Mariners are 8-3 when Flexen pitches at home...his 1.89 home ERA is 4th-lowest in the Majors (min. 50 IP at home) and 3rd-lowest in the American League...trails Jacob deGrom-NYM (1.20), Lance Lynn-CWS (1.50) and Kyle Gibson-TEX (1.77).

**WHAT'S IN THE BOX...**the Mariners overcame a 7-0 deficit in last night's 11-8 win vs. Houston...the 7-run comeback surpassed their previous season-high 6-run comeback (W 8-6 at MIN on April 11 after trailing 6-0)...last night's win also surpassed their previous season-high 5-run comeback at home on Opening Night (W 8-7 vs. SF in 10 innings on April 1 after trailing 5-0)...it was the Mariners 24th comeback win of the season and their 3rd consecutive comeback win.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER...**Kyle Seager went 1-for-3 with 2 runs, 1 walk and a 3-run home run in the bottom of the 5th last night...Seager's homer was his 19th of the season, bringing his RBI total to 58...with 1 more homer this season, it would be Kyle's 9th 20-homer season in a Mariners uniform, which would tie him for most in franchise history with Ken Griffey Jr....Seager's currently tied with Edgar Martinez and Jay Buhner for 2nd-most in franchise history with 8.

**KEEPING IT 100...**J.P. Crawford went 3-for-4 with 2 runs scored and a hit-by-pitch last night...his third hit of the night was his 100th hit in his 100th game of the season...J.P. has 77 "non-pull" (straightaway and opposite field) hits this season, ranking T4th in the American League and T6th in the Majors...Crawford has the highest WAR (2.4) on the Mariners this season according to *Baseball-Reference*.

**BULLISH 'PEN...**Seattle relievers **Keynan Middleton**, **Erik Swanson**, **Kendall Graveman** and **Paul Sewald** combined for 5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 ER, 1 BB and 2 SO in last night's win...the Mariners bullpen is 27-14 with 29 saves and a 3.99 ERA (173 ER, 390.0 IP) with 338 hits allowed, 139 walks and 397 strikeouts this season...*FanGraphs* pegs Mariners relievers as the 2nd-most valuable by Wins Above Replacement (4.9) this season, trailing only Tampa Bay (5.2)...the bullpen's 3.55 Fielding Independent Pitching also ranks 2nd in the Majors to Tampa Bay (3.40).

- **Swanson** (2.0 IP, 1 BB) has 1 save and a 0.49 ERA (1 ER, 18.1 IP) in 14 appearances (2 starts) this season...has 7 walks and 18 strikeouts...his 0.49 ERA and .131 opponent average both lead the American League among pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched.
- **Graveman** (W#4, 1.0 IP, 1 BB, 2 SO) is 4-0 with 10 saves and a 0.82 ERA (3 ER, 33.0 IP) with 8 walks and 34 strikeouts in 30 appearances this season...his 0.697 WHIP and .136 (15x110) opponent batting average both lead qualified American League relievers.
- **Sewald** (SV#4, 1.0 IP, 1 SO) is 6-2 with 4 saves and a 2.30 ERA (8 ER, 31.1 IP) with 12 walks and 54 strikeouts in 31 appearances this season...his 15.51 strikeouts-per-9 innings ranks 3rd in the Majors behind Craig Kimbrel-CHC (15.71) and Aroldis Chapman-NYY (15.58).

**LONG DIVISION...**the Mariners play the 6th of 10 consecutive games against the American League West Division, their 3rd-longest intra-divisional streak this season...Seattle is 25-16 (.610) in 41 games against the AL West this season and 30-30 in 60 games outside the division...Seattle went 9-5 during a season-high 14-game stretch against divisional opponents from May 24-June 6...the Mariners play their final 13 games of the regular season within the division.

**IN THE CLUTCH...**the Mariners offense is rated as the most clutch in the Majors by *FanGraphs* with a 7.46 "Clutch" metric...they lead Philadelphia (3.97) and Boston (3.95) by a wide margin...8 of Seattle's 11 runs batted in last night came with 2 outs...on the season, the Mariners are batting .267 (193x723) with 40 doubles, 5 triples, 35 home runs and 287 RBI with runners in scoring position...Seattle has the highest slugging percentage (.481) with RISP in the Majors this season, leading Toronto (.478) and Houston (.474)...Seattle's .267 average with RISP ranks 5th-highest in the Majors...**J.P. Crawford** is batting .356 (21x59) with RISP, **Ty France** is batting .341 (28x82), **Mitch Haniger** is batting .338 (23x68) and **Kyle Seager** is batting .317 (26x82).

**5 PROSPECTS IN TOP 100...***Baseball-America* released its 2021 Midseason Top 100 Prospects list yesterday...the Mariners landed 5 prospects on the list: OF **Julio Rodriguez** (#3), OF **Jarred Kelenic** (#4), SS **Noelvi Marte** (#10), RHP **George Kirby** (#14) and RHP **Emerson Hancock** (#54).

- **3 in Top 10** - Seattle is the first team to land 3 prospects in the midseason top 10 since the 2015 Dodgers: INF Corey Seager (#5), OF Joc Pederson (#8) and LHP Julio Urias (#10).

**AS YOU KNOW...**Dylan Moore hit a go-ahead grand slam in the bottom of the 8th last night to give the Mariners an 11-8 lead...he homered off Houston reliever Brooks Raley to complete the 7-run comeback...Moore's grand slam was the 5th for the Mariners this season...**BUT, DID YOU KNOW?**...that the 2021 Mariners are the first team in MLB history to have 5 different players hit a go-ahead grand slam in a span of 52 days?...**Jake Fraley** (June 5 at LAA), **J.P. Crawford** (June 19 vs. TB), **Shed Long Jr.** (June 20 vs. TB), **Mitch Haniger** (July 9 vs. LAA) and Moore (July 26 vs. HOU) contributed the grand slams...each of the last 3 (Long Jr.-10th, Haniger-8th and Moore-8th) have come in the 8th inning or later...Shed had the lone walk-off grand slam...via Stats By STATS.

ABOUT FLEXEN...

- 27-year-old right-hander is making his 30th career start (46th appearance), his 19th start of 2021 and 2nd vs. Houston.
- Signed with the Mariners as a free agent, agreeing on a 2-year contract with an option for 2023 on Dec. 18, 2020.
- Was originally selected by the Mets in the 14th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Newark Memorial (CA) High School... made his Major League debut with New York-NL on July 27, 2017 at San Diego.
- Graduated from Newark Memorial High School (CA) in 2012... played 4 years of baseball and was a quarterback on the football team for 2 years..... was committed to Arizona State University before signing with the Mets.
- Appeared in parts of 8 minor league seasons with Mets organization (2012-19)...overall, went 43-31 with a 3.61 ERA (236 ER, 588.0 IP) with 192 walks and 513 strikeouts in 122 games (105 starts)...in 2013, was named Topps Appalachian Player of the Year.
- Toronto was the 22nd team Flexen faced in his career...has not faced: Baltimore, Chicago-AL, Kansas City, New York-AL, New York-NL, Pittsburgh, Seattle, Toronto and Washington.
- In his Mariners debut on April 3, 2021, became the 900th Seattle Mariners player in franchise history.
- Recorded his 100th career strikeout when he struck out Cavan Biggio on 6/29 against Toronto.
- **Seattle is 13-5 in his 18 starts this season...**his 3.51 ERA in the first half of the season was the 12th-lowest in the American League...his 1.85 walk per 9.0 inning ratio was the 6th-lowest in the AL.
- Ranks 8th in the American League with a 3.35 ERA, trailing Lance Lynn-CWS (1.91), Carlos Rodon-CWS (2.24), Gerrit Cole-NYY (2.74), Kyle Gibson-TEX (2.87), Robbie Ray-TOR (3.12), Sean Manaea-OAK (3.16) and Aaron Civale-CLE (3.32).

**LAST OUTING**...L#4 in Mariners 1-4 loss vs. Oakland on July 22...allowed only 2 runs on 6 hits while walking 2 and striking out 1 over 5.1 innings... has allowed 3 earned runs of fewer in each of his last 8 starts, including 2 runs or fewer in his last 4 starts.

**WINNER**...posted a career-best 4-game winning streak, June 15-July 16... went 4-0, 1.36 (39.2 IP, 6 ER) in 6 starts during the streak...struck out 29 while walking just 8 and has limited opposing hitters to a .200 BAA...his previous career-best winning streak was 3 games (4/24-5/14/21).

**STREAKING**...is 3-1 with a 1.42 ERA (4 ER, 25.1 IP) in 4 starts in July... has limited opponents to a .204 (19x93) average, while walking 5 and striking out 14...his 1.42 ERA is T4th-lowest ERA in the Majors in the month of July.

**CAREER DAY**...earned win #6 this season against Minnesota after setting career highs in innings pitched, strikeouts and pitches thrown... went 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing 4 hits, striking out 8 without walking a batter...26 BF in 8.0 IP...threw 107 pitches, 77 for strikes.

**HOME COOKIN'**...has posted a 1.76 ERA (12 ER, 61.1 IP) with 10 walks and 43 strikeouts in 10 starts at T-Mobile Park this season, compared to a 5.92 ERA (26 ER, 38.0 IP) with 10 walks and 22 strikeouts in 7 games on the road...his 4.16 differential between road and home ERA is the largest in the Majors this season...Flexen's 1.76 ERA at home this season is 3rd-best in the Majors this season, trailing only Jacob deGrom-NYM (1.20) and Lance Lynn-CWS (1.50).

**SAFE AT HOME**...Flexen is 6-3 with a 1.89 ERA (14 ER, 66.2 IP) in his first 11 home starts with the Mariners...his 1.89 ERA is the lowest in club history through a player's first 11 home starts of a season, ranking ahead of Felix Hernandez (2.09 in 2014) and James Paxton (2.15 in 2017).

**FIRST WIN**...earned his first win as a Mariner in his first Mariners start, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts on April 3 vs. San Francisco...became first Mariners pitcher to throw 5.0+ scoreless innings in his debut with the team since LH Wade LeBlanc threw 6.0 scoreless IP on June 24, 2016 in his Mariners debut in a 4-3 win vs. St. Louis...marked Flexen's first win in the Majors in 1,319 days (Oct. 1, 2017 w/New York-NL at Philadelphia).

**DOMINATING THE KBO**...spent the 2020 season with the Doosan Bears in the Korean Baseball Organization and went 8-4 with a 3.01 ERA (39 ER 116.2 IP) with 30 walks and 132 strikeouts over 21 starts...struck out 28% of batters faced, the 4th-highest rate in the KBO.

**PLAYOFF MVP**...posted a 1.91 ERA (6 ER, 28.1 IP) in the KBO playoffs, while pitching in both starting and relieving rolls.. named series MVP of the semi-finals after tossing 10.1 innings and allowing 2 earned runs with 13 strikeouts in one start and one relief appearance... started Game 1 for Doosan and tossed 7.1 IP of 2-run ball...came out of the bullpen in Game 4 on 3 days rest and tossed 3.0 scoreless IP.

**RACKKKK 'EM UP**...tallied 10+ strikeouts in 4 starts while pitching for Doosan in the Korean Baseball Organization during the 2020 season...ended the season with back-to-back games of 10+ Ks (10/20 at Lotte: 12 K & 10/27 vs. Hanwha: 10 K)...tallied a season-high 13 strikeouts on 9/22 at Hanwha.

**W#1**...earned his first career Major League win with the Mets on Aug. 8, 2017 vs. Texas.

**CAREER**...had appeared in 3 Major League seasons with New York-NL (2017-19) before debuting with the Mariners on April 3, 2021...was originally selected by the Mets in the 14th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Newark Memorial (CA) High School... made his Major League debut with New York-NL on July 27, 2017 at San Diego.

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUT**...made his Major League debut on July 27, 2017 with the Mets vs. San Diego...tossed 3.0 innings, while allowing 3 earned runs on 5 hits and 4 walks with 2 strikeouts.
