THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 10
1962 - Major League Baseball officially starts in Houston as the Colt .45s win their first game in franchise history, an 11-2 victory over the Cubs at Colt Stadium.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros look to stop a four-game losing skid as they continue their 10-game road trip with the first game of a four-game series against the Seattle Mariners at T-Mobile Park in Seattle, WA...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** will be on the mound for the Astros opposite **RHP Emerson Hancock** and the Mariners.

TONIGHT'S ASTROS STARTER: **RHP Tatsuya Imai** is set to make his third career start in the Majors tonight...in his last start on April 4 at ATH, he tossed 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing three hits and three walks with nine strikeouts to record his first career victory...in January, the Astros signed Imai to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB), where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS: Dating back to the 2015 season, the Astros have made nine postseason appearances in 12 seasons, winning seven division titles, four AL pennants (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) and two WS titles (2017, 2022)...in that span, the Astros became the only team in history to advance to seven consecutive ALCS (2017-23) and posted the second-most wins in the Majors (982), trailing only the Dodgers (1,045).

NEW FACES: The Astros focused their offseason efforts on acquiring pitching, landing **RHP Mike Burrows** and **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** in trades and **RHP Tatsuya Imai** and **RHP Ryan Weiss** off the international free agent market.

AT THE HELM: Manager **Joe Espada** is in his third season as the Astros skipper...in 2025, for the second consecutive season, Espada and his staff were forced to deal with an extremely high number of injuries...despite an ever-changing roster that often was missing key players, to his credit, Espada managed to navigate his club to an 87-75 record, finishing in a tie for the final AL Wild Card berth (lost tiebreaker to DET).

ROAD TRIP: Tonight is the seventh game of a 10-game road trip for the Astros...the Astros are 1-5 so far on this road trip...Houston went 41-40 on the road last season...following this four-game series in Seattle, the Astros will face the Colorado Rockies for a three-game series at Daikin Park from April 14-16.

AGAINST THE MARINERS: The Astros and Mariners face each other tonight for the first of 13 scheduled matchups in 2026...the Astros went 5-8 against the Mariners in 2025, including 2-4 record at T-Mobile Park...Houston owns a 132-97 all-time regular season record against Seattle...the Mariners will travel to Daikin Park for the first of two road trips to Houston from May 11-14 for a four-game series.

WEDNESDAY'S GAME: The Houston Astros were defeated by the Colorado Rockies, 1-9 on Wednesday afternoon at Coors Field...**RHP Cristian Javier** (1.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 1 SO) started the game but left after one inning due to injury...**1B Christian Walker** (2x4), **PH-LF Brice Matthews** (1x3, RBI, BB) and **DH Yordan Alvarez** (1x4) led the way offensively for the Astros.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: The Astros placed **RHP Cristian Javier** on the 15-day IL (retro 4/9) due to a grade two right shoulder strain and **OF Jake Meyers** on the 10-day IL (retro 4/9) due to a grade two right oblique strain...to take their spots on the active roster, the Astros have selected **RHP J.P. France** and **OF Taylor Trammell** from the Triple A Sugar Land...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Astros transferred **RHP Ronel Blanco** to the 60-day IL.

YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros out-righted **RHP Roddery Muñoz** to Triple A Sugar Land...Muñoz was designated for assignment on Monday.

LEAGUE LEADERS: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (79), doubles (34), total bases (204), hits (122), walks (67) and OBP (.371)...individually, **LF Yordan Alvarez** leads the Majors in walks (13) and OBP (.500)...**2B Jose Altuve** ranks tied for first in the Majors in runs (12) and **1B Christian Walker** ranks tied for third in the Majors in doubles (6) and tied for third in RBI (13).

YORDAN'S CYCLE: On July 21, 2024 at Seattle, **DH Yordan Alvarez** recorded his first career cycle and the 10th cycle in Astros franchise history...it was the second cycle in T-Mobile Park history (also, **Miguel Tejada** on Sept. 29, 2001)...it was also the first cycle by an Astros left-handed hitter since **Luke Scott** hit for the cycle on July 28, 2006 vs. ARI...he also became the only DH to hit for the cycle in Astros history and ninth in MLB history (last, **Jake Bauers** on June 14, 2019).

TUVE VS. THE MARINERS: **2B Jose Altuve** has hit .312 (242x775) with 48 doubles, 21 homers, 96 RBI and an .832 OPS in 190 career games against the Mariners...he already ranks third all-time in hits vs. SEA, trailing only **Cal Ripken Jr.** (261) and **Michael Young** (259), and ranks eighth all-time in games played vs. the Mariners.

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: On Monday, **LF Yordan Alvarez** was named the American League Player of the Week for the week of March 30-April 5...Alvarez batted .471 (8x17) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, seven walks and a 1.733 OPS for the week...marked the fourth time that Alvarez has been named the AL Player of the Week.

FUTURE HALL OF FAMER: **2B Jose Altuve** recorded his 2,400th career hit on Mon. night at COL on a double in the first inning...became the second active player to record at least 2,400 hits, joining **LAD IF Freddie Freeman**...also joins **IF Craig Biggio** as the only two players in franchise history with at least 2,400 hits.

YORDAN'S UPCOMING MILESTONES: **LF Yordan Alvarez** recorded his 174th career home run on Sunday at ATH...the home run tied him with franchise icon **OF George Springer** for seventh on the Astros all-time list...next up on the Astros all-time list is **3B Alex Bregman** (191 HR).

LAST START, APRIL 4 at ATH: made his 2nd Major League start last Saturday in Sacramento, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings, working around 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts...tossed 94 pitches in the outing, including 58 strikes.

ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY): rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

IMAI'S ARSENAL: has worked mostly with a 2-pitch mix in his short MLB career, throwing 46.4% four-seam fastballs and 41.7% sliders...has also worked in select changeups (4.2%), split fingers (4.2%) and curveballs (3.6%)...raised eyebrows in his last start by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...through his 2 starts, Imai's slider is averaging 6 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

MLB DEBUT: made his MLB debut on March 29 vs. LAA, working 2.2 innings while allowing 4 runs on 3 hits with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts (74 pitches-36 strikes)...picked up his first MLB strikeout vs. **Mike Trout**, the second batter he faced in his debut...took a no-decision in the Astros' 9-7 win over the Halos...topped out at 97.6 mph in his debut.

JAPAN CONNECTION: by making his MLB debut, he became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth notable Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

I-45: wears jersey number 45 to honor 2 of his favorite pitchers, former Astros great **RHP Gerrit Cole** and the Phillies **RHP Zack Wheeler**, who both also wear #45.

SCORELESS SPRING TRAINING: made 3 official Spring Training starts and an exhibition game start, combining to toss 9.2 innings of scoreless baseball...in his 3 official starts, he allowed 2 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...his exhibition start came on March 23 vs. the Astros Triple A affiliate, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, in which he tossed 3.2 scoreless innings.

LOCKED UP: signed a 3-year contract with the Astros on Jan. 2, 2026...the contract includes player opt-outs after the 2026 and 2027 seasons.

2025 RECAP: went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

LAST APPEARANCE: pitched in Wednesday's series finale at COL, giving up a run on a hit and a pair of walks while striking out 2 in the inning...tossed 22 pitches (11 for strikes).

MILESTONE ACHIEVED: with his 1.0 inning pitched Wednesday at COL, he has surpassed **RHP Ryan Pressly** for the 11th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...is also 3.2 innings from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** for 10th-most.

VS. SEA: has struck out 50 batters through 35.0 scoreless innings in 32 career appearances vs. the Mariners, holding an impressive 12.86 SO/9IP with a 3.34 ERA (13ER/35.0IP)...has the highest SO/9IP among active relievers with at least 20.0 IP in their career vs. the Mariners...also owns the most strikeouts among active relievers against Seattle with 50.

CAREER: has appeared in the Majors with Houston in each of the last eight seasons (2019-26)...owns a 16-13 record with 17 saves, a 2.84 ERA (105ER/333.1IP) and 456 strikeouts in 333.1 Major League innings...among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in strikeouts (456), 7th in appearances (322) and 11th in innings (333.1).

LAST APPEARANCE: last pitched on Wednesday at COL, taking over the 2nd inning with no on and no outs after **RHP Cristian Javier** left due to injury...surrendered 5 runs on 4 hits and 3 walks in an inning of work...suffered the loss while tossing 39 pitches (23 strikes) in the outing.

MULTI-INNING MAN: is T-1st among Astros relievers (also **RHP Ryan Weiss**) with 3 appearances of 2.0 or more IP this season.

OPENING DAY: made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season and pitched that day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball...tossed a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**, the hardest pitch thrown in his career and the 2nd-fastest pitch thrown by an Astro this season, behind RHP Christian Roa's 99.3 MP sinker on April 5 at ATH.

ABOUT BLUBAUGH: entered the 2026 season as the Astros No. 4 prospect and as having the "Best Slider" according to *Baseball America*.
