AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip tonight with the second game a three-game series at Cleveland (1-0 thus far)...will also travel to Toronto for a three-game series this weekend (Fri.-Sun.)...went 2-3 on their recent homestand, dropping two-of-three games vs. Cleveland and splitting their rain-shortened two-game series vs. Boston.

- Their 39-26 (.600) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- **Are 9-4 in their last 13 games (since 5/24)** and 11-7 in their last 18G (since 5/18)...**are 31-19 in their last 50 games (since 4/13).**
- The Yankees'+98 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 79-46, over their last 13 games (since 5/24).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Guardians, 7-5, in 10 innings on Monday at Progressive Field...**RHP Will Warren** (4.1IP, 3H, 3R/2ER, 2BB, 5K, OHR, 1HP, 1WP) started and did not record a decision...**DH Paul Goldschmidt** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI) drove in three of the Yankees' seven runs, hitting a go-ahead two-run HR in the first inning...also drove in a run in the eighth inning on a fielder's choice...**3B Ryan McMahon** (1-for-2, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his seventh HR of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the fifth inning...**LF Cody Bellinger** (2-for-5, 2RBI) recorded his second straight multi-hit game and hit a go-ahead two-run single in the 10th inning...**1B Ben Rice** (2-for-3, 2R, 2BB) reached base a career-high-tying four times...**CF Trent Grisham** (2-for-4, 2R, 1BB) reached base three times for his second straight game...**RHP David Bednar** (1.2IP, 1BB, 3K) earned his second win of the year after tossing 1.2 scoreless innings, his longest scoreless appearance of the season.

GOOD AS GOLD: **INF Paul Goldschmidt** drove in three of the Yankees' seven runs on Monday at Cleveland, hitting his eighth HR of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the first inning...also drove in a run in the eighth inning on a fielder's choice.

- Has hit 3HR in his last nine games (since 5/29).
- Has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games (since 5/25), batting .314/.340/.549 (16-for-51) with 8R, 3 doubles, 3HR, 13RBI, 2BB and 1SB over that span.
- Is batting .306/.369/.568 (34-for-111) with 18R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR, 24RBI, 9BB, 2HP and 1SB over his last 31 games (since 4/26).
- Has hit .357/.514/.643 (10-for-28) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 19RBI, 7BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .321/.417/.445 (44-for-137) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 53RBI, 21BB/5IBB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

RICE RICE BABY: **C/INF Ben Rice** reached base a career-high-tying four times on Monday at Cleveland (10th time and fifth time this year)...has hit .304/.400/.641 (66-for-217) with 49R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 34BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 60 games this season...has reached base safely in 46-of-56 starts.

- 35 of his 66H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).

WALK IT OUT: **Yankees batters** walked six times on Monday at Cleveland...their 277BB this year lead the AL and rank third in the Majors...marks their most walks through their first 65 games of a season in the last 20 years (since 2007) and their most since recording 278BB in 2006.

COLE TRAIN: **RHP Gerrit Cole** will make his fourth start of the season tonight at Cleveland...has gone 1-1 with a 2.00 ERA (18.0IP, 4ER) in three starts this season...two of his three starts have been scoreless...has held opponents to a .188/.235/.391 (12-for-64) slash line.

- Needs 5K to tie Lefty Grove (2,270) for 60th place on the all-time strikeouts list.
- Since 2023, has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 20 of his 24 road starts, going 12-5 with a 2.28 ERA (150.0IP, 38ER) over that span...has gone 9-3 with a 1.99 ERA (81.1IP, 18ER) over his last 13 road starts (since 8/25/23).
- Is 30-7 with a 2.64 ERA (289.2IP, 85ER) and 339K in 46 career regular season starts vs. the AL Central...is 21-3 with a 2.38 ERA (192.2IP, 51ER) and 228K in his last 31 starts vs. the AL Central (since 8/1/19).

ON A ROLL: **OF Spencer Jones** has hit .500/.500/.600 (5-for-10) with 1 double, 1RBI and 1SB over his last three starts (since 5/21).

SAVED BY THE BELL: **INF/OF Cody Bellinger** recorded his **second straight multi-hit game and hit a go-ahead two-run single in the 10th inning on Monday at Cleveland...his 13 go-ahead RBI this season are tied for the most in the Majors (tied for most in AL)...his seven game-winning RBI are tied for the second-most in the AL and tied for the fifth-most in the Majors...** is batting .321/.386/.464 (18-for-56) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 28RBI, 9BB and 5SF with RISP this season.

- Has recorded 11RBI in his last 12 games (since 5/25).
- Is hitting .303/.391/.545 (40-for-132) with 20R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 29RBI, 21BB, 4SB and 3SF over his last 36 games (since 4/28).
- Has hit .310/.333/.517 (27-for-87) with 8R, 3 doubles, 5HR, 15RBI, 5BB, 4SF and 4SB in 22 career games vs. Cleveland.
- According to FanGraphs, leads all Major Leaguers in DRS (15).

McMAHON OF THE HOUR: **INF Ryan McMahon** hit his seventh HR of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the fifth inning on Monday at Cleveland...has hit .300/.300/.625 (12-for-40) with 6R, 1 double, 4HR, 8RBI and 1SB over his last 12 starts (since 5/19)...since 4/25, is batting .345/.367/.552 (10-for-29) with 2HR, 12RBI and 1BB with RISP.

MERRY GRISHMAS: **OF Trent Grisham** reached base three times for his second straight game on Monday at Cleveland...**has hit safely in 13 of his last 16 games (since 5/19), batting .383/.456/.567 (23-for-60) with 11R, 5 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI, 8BB and 2SB over that span.**

- Has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 11 games (since 5/26) and 11 of his last 16 games (since 5/19).

FOR STARTERS: **Yankees starters** have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 12 of their last 16 starts (since 5/20), posting a 2.81 ERA (93.0IP, 29ER) over that span...have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in nine of their last 15 starts (since 5/21).

- Have posted a 3.14 ERA (358.2IP, 125ER) and 349K in 65 starts this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 53 starts this season, the most in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors...marks their third-most in franchise history through their first 65 games of a season, trailing only their 57 starts in 2022 and 55 starts in 2024.
- Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.335), rank second in ERA (3.14, first in AL), WHIP (1.10, first in AL), opponents' BA (.211, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.280, first in AL) and opponents' OPS (.615, first in AL), fourth in HR/9.0IP (0.88, second in AL), fifth in strikeout rate (23.9%, second in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.01, second in AL), seventh in strikeouts (349, fourth in AL) and eighth in innings pitched (358.2, fourth in AL) and BB/9.0IP (2.91, fourth in AL).

CLOSE CALLS: The Yankees have had four of their last five games and 13 of their last 19 games (since 5/17) decided by 2R-or-fewer.

HIP HIP JOSÉ: **INF/OF José Caballero** has reached base safely in 32 of his last 40 games with a PA (since 4/13), batting .285/.345/.454 (37-for-130) with 20R, 7 doubles, 5HR, 12RBI, 9BB, 3HP and 10SB over that span.

ALL THAT JAZZ: **INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** is batting .289/.353/.526 (22-for-76) with 13R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 11RBI, 8BB, 1SF and 5SB over his last 20 games (since 5/13).

FAST AND FURIOUS: **Yankees baserunners** have recorded 135B over their last seven games (since 5/31)...their 64SB this season are tied for the most in the AL and tied for the fourth-most in the Majors.

- **Their 64SB this season are their most through their first 65 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 75SB in 2001...** marks only the third time in the last 37 years (since 1990) the Yankees recorded as many stolen bases through their first 65 games of a season (75SB in 2001 and 84SB in 1998).
- **INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (16SB) is tied for sixth in the Majors in stolen bases and **INF/OF José Caballero** (15SB) is tied for eighth in the Majors...**are only the fourth pair of Yankees teammates in the last 110 years (since 1917) to each record at least 15SB through the club's first 65 games of a season**, joining Chuck Knoblauch (23SB) and Alfonso Soriano (19SB) in 2001, Rickey Henderson (24SB) and Steve Sax (17SB) in 1989, and Willie Randolph (23SB), Mickey Rivers (23SB) and Roy White (16SB) in 1976.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP GERRIT COLE (1-1, 2.00)

RHP Gerrit Cole will make his fourth start of the season tonight at Cleveland...the 35-year-old will pitch on extended five days' rest due to Saturday's rainout...last pitched on Wednesday vs. Cleveland and suffered his first loss of the year (5.1IP, 6H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 2K, 3HR)...has gone 1-1 with a 2.00 ERA (18.0IP, 4ER) in three starts this season...missed the entire 2025 season and the first 51 games of this season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...the six-time All-Star (2015, '18-19, '21-23) was unanimously named the 2023 American League Cy Young Award winner and has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting six times (first in 2023, second in 2019 and 2021, fourth in 2015 and 2020, and fifth in 2018)...his career 10.34 K/9.0IP ratio (2,265K/1,972.0IP) is the seventh-highest in Major League history (min. 1,500.0IP)...in 128 starts with the Yankees, is 60-29 with a 3.09 ERA (777.0IP, 267ER) and 929K...since 2018, is tied for first in the Majors in shutouts (five), ranks second in strikeouts (1,531), WHIP (1.00) and opponents' OBP (.260), tied for second in wins (95), third in ERA (2.95), winning percentage (.709, min. 70 decisions), opponents' BA (.205), opponents' OPS (.616), complete games (seven) and WAR among pitchers (30.7 – FanGraphs), fourth in K/9.0IP (11.58), sixth in K/BB (5.09) and eighth in opponents' SLG (.356)...is the first Yankee in franchise history to record at least 200K in three different seasons...owns two of the Yankees' top three single-season strikeout records and three of the top-eight records (his 257K in 2022 are the most in franchise history, his 243K in 2021 are the third-most in franchise history and his 222K in 2023 are tied for the seventh-most in Yankees history)...was originally selected by the Yankees in the first round (28th overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play at UCLA for three seasons (2009-11)...was the first overall pick of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft, the 15th pitcher (and 11th right-hander) to be chosen first...is the fifth player selected first overall to play for the Yankees, joining Alex Rodriguez, Darryl Strawberry, Tim Lincecum and Ron Blomberg...signed a nine-year contract extending through the 2028 season with a player opt-out following the 2024 season on 12/18/19.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss of the year in the Yankees' 5-4 loss on Wednesday vs. Cleveland (5.1IP, 6H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 2K, 3HR)...had his season-opening 13.2 scoreless inning streak snapped in the second inning...surrendered a solo HR to Kyle Manzardo in the second inning, a two-run home run to Rhys Hoskins in the fourth inning and a solo HR to José Ramírez in the sixth inning.

- 2026:** Has gone 1-1 with a 2.00 ERA (18.0IP, 4ER) in three starts this season...two of his three starts have been scoreless...has held opponents to a .188/.235/.391 (12-for-64) slash line.
- Made his season debut on 5/22 vs. Tampa Bay, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision...marked his first Major League start since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers...retired 15 of his final 17BF (1H, 1BB).
 - Earned his first win of the season on 5/27 at Kansas City after striking out 10 batters over 6.2 scoreless innings (4H, 0BB)...marked his first win since 2024 ALDS Game 4 at Kansas City...retired 11 of his final 13BF...marked his 63rd career double-digit strikeout game and franchise-record 28th as a Yankee...was his first game with at least 10K since 8/10/24 vs. Texas (10K)...struck out 10 batters despite throwing only 79 pitches...became only the second Yankees pitcher in the last 25 years (since 2002) to throw fewer than 80 pitches in a game and record at least 10K (also Domingo Germán's 78 pitches and 11K on 4/15/23 vs. Minnesota)...marked his 23rd career game with at least 10K and 0BB.
 - Posted a season-opening 13.2 scoreless inning streak from 5/22-6/3.

ROAD TO RECOVERY: Missed the first 51 games of this season and the entire 2025 season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery...made only one spring training start in 2025 before undergoing "Tommy John" surgery on 3/11/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at Cedars-Sinai Kerlan-Jobe Institute in Los Angeles, Calif.

- Made six combined rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 0-2 with a 4.66 ERA (29.0IP, 28H, 17R/15ER, 3BB, 28K, 6HR)...made his final rehab start with Scranton/WB on 5/16 vs. Syracuse and allowed only 1R/ER in 5.1IP (ND, 6H, 1BB, 6K, 0HR).

2024: Went 8-5 with a 3.41 ERA (95.0IP, 36ER) in 17 starts with the Yankees in 2024...missed the first 75 games of the season on the 60-day injured list with right elbow inflammation...allowed 2R-or-fewer in 12 of his 17 starts, including 10 of his final 13 starts (7/12-9/26) and 11 of his final 15 starts (6/30-9/26)...allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of his final nine starts (8/10-9/26), nine of his final 13 starts (7/12-9/26) and 10 of his final 15 starts (6/30-9/26).

- Went 7-4 with a 2.67 ERA (77.2IP, 23ER) and 80K in his final 13 starts from 7/12-9/26...was 5-3 with a 2.25 ERA (60.0IP, 15ER) and 61K over his final 10 starts of the season from 8/4-9/26.
- Allowed 19 of his 38R and seven of his 11HR in three of his starts: 6R/4HR on 6/25 at the Mets, 6R/3HR on 7/24 vs. the Mets and 7R/0HR on 9/14 vs. Boston...in his 14 other starts, went 8-2 with a 1.89 ERA (81.0IP, 17ER) and 93K.
- Went 1-0 with a 2.17 ERA (29.0IP, 27H, 13R/7ER, 10BB, 22K, 1HR) in five postseason starts...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those five starts and 2ER-or-fewer in four of those starts.

IN PINSTripES: In 128 starts with the Yankees, is 60-29 with a 3.09 ERA (777.0IP, 267ER) and 929K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 100-of-128 starts, the ninth-most in the AL in that span...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 88 starts as a Yankee, the sixth-most in the AL...has recorded 26 scoreless starts as a Yankee, tied for the fourth-most scoreless starts by any AL pitcher in that span.

- Since 2020, leads the Majors in opponents' OBP (.264), ranks third in WHIP (1.02, second in AL) and K/9.0IP (10.76, first in AL), fourth in opponents' BA (.211, first in AL) and K/BB (4.92, third in AL), fifth in winning percentage (.674, first in AL, min. 60 decisions), ERA (3.09, second in AL) and opponents' OPS (.629, second in AL).
- Was unanimously named the American League Cy Young Award winner in 2023...became the sixth player in Yankees history to win the award, joining Roger Clemens (2001), Ron Guidry (1978), Sparky Lyle (1977), Whitey Ford (1961) and Bob Turley (1958)...was the seventh American League pitcher (11th time) to win the Cy Young Award unanimously, joining Justin Verlander (2011, '22), Johan Santana (2004, '06), Pedro Martínez (1999-2000), Roger Clemens (1986, '98), Ron Guidry (1978) and Denny McLain (1968)...joined Guidry as the only two Yankees to win the award unanimously...has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting in three of his first five seasons he has pitched in pinstripes (first in 2023, second in 2021, fourth in 2020).
- His 28 double-digit strikeout games with the Yankees are the most by a pitcher in franchise history (next: Ron Guidry-23G)...has 28 such games in 128 starts with the Yankees while Guidry recorded 23 double-digit strikeout games in 368 games/323 starts with the Yankees...his eight games with at least 12K are the second-most in franchise history (Al Downing-10G)...is just the fourth pitcher in franchise history to record multiple games with at least 14K (one in 2021 and one in 2022), joining Masahiro Tanaka (two in 2017), David Cone (one in 1997 and one in 1998) and Ron Guidry (one in 1978 and one in 1987).
- Since 2023, has started after a Yankees' loss 26 times...the Yankees are 19-7 in those games with Cole going 14-5 with a 2.96 ERA (161.1IP, 53ER).
- With 243K in 2021, 257K in 2022 and 222K in 2023, is the first Yankee in franchise history to record at least 200K in three different seasons (previous: twice by Luis Severino in 2017 and '18, David Cone in 1997 and '98, and Ron Guidry in 1978 and '79)...is also the only Yankees pitcher in franchise history to record at least 225K in multiple seasons.

VS. CLEVELAND: Will face the Guardians for his second straight start...is 7-3 with a 3.09 ERA (78.2IP, 27ER) and 75K in 12 career regular season starts vs. Cleveland...has held Cleveland batters to a .195 (53-for-272) opponents' BA during the regular season...including the postseason, has gone 11-3 with a 2.85 ERA (110.1IP, 35ER) and 120K in 17 starts vs. the Guardians.
