AROUND THE HORN

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs look to win their fifth se-ries out of the last 7 in today's rubber match.

- The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 6 series (4 wins, 1 split).
- The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 games and 6 of their last 9.
- D-backs starters’ combined 3.41 ERA (12 ER in 31.2 IP) in their last 7 games since Sept. 5 ranks third in the NL to the Pirates (2.65) and Phillies (2.92).
- The D-backs are 10-6 in their last 16 Interleague games.
- The D-backs have won in 5 of **Eduardo Rodri-guez’s** last 6 starts and in 9 of his last 11.
- In Rodriguez’s last 6 bids, is 5-1 with a 1.96 ERA (8 ER in 36.2 IP), op-ponent .200 AVG (27-for-135)/.567 OPS, 12 walks and 36 strikeouts.
- In his last 4 home starts, is 3-1 with a 1.82 ERA (5 ER in 24.2 IP), oppo-nent .209 AVG (19-for-91)/.551 OPS, 10 walks and 25 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 6-2 vs. Rangers last night.

- **Pavin Smith** gave the D-backs a 1-0 lead in the third inning with a RBI single in his first game in the Majors since July 8.
- **Corbin Carroll** added a sac fly in the sixth inning to make the score 6-2.
- **Gabriel Moreno** went 2-for-4.
- **Jonathan Loáisiga** (0.1 IP), **Derek Law** (1.2) and **Juan Morillo** (0.1) combined for 2.1 scoreless frames with 3 hits, 1 walk and 2 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled INF **Jose Fernan-dez** from Triple-A Reno and designated OF **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** for assignment.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are in fourth place in the NL Wild Card race, 1.5 games behind the Padres (WC3, Season tied 5-5), 3.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, tied 3-3) and 4.0 behind the Cubs (WC1, trail 2-4).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs are 11 games above .500 (34-23) since July 9...their 34 wins since then are tied for third most in the NL (also: Padres), behind the Braves and Brewers.

COMEBACK SNAKES: The D-backs’ 44 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (42) and Dodgers (42).

- Their 22 comeback home wins are tied for fifth most in the NL with the Mets, behind the Padres (27), Dodgers (26), Cubs (24) and Brewers (23).

HOME SWEET HOME: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 36 of his last 39 home games, batting .310 (45-for-145)/.838 OPS with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 21 RBI and 21 walks.

- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 7 of his last 8 home games, batting .367 (11-for-30)/1.124 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Jordan Lawlar** has reached base safely in 8 of his last 9 home starts, including 5 multi-hit efforts, bat-ting .419 (13-for-31)/1.212 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 5 RBI, 1 hit by pitch and 1 sac hit.

TRENDING BATS: **Nolan Arenado** has 3 homers in his last 6 games while hitting .368 (7-for-19)/1.433 OPS with 1 double, 5 RBI and 6 walks.

- **Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in his last 7 starts at a .367 clip (11-for-30)/.958 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 ho-mer, 5 RBI and 3 walks, including 4 multi-hit efforts.
- **Ketel Marte** has hit in 8 of his last 9 games since returning from the 10-day Injured List on Aug. 31, batting .256 (10-for-39)/.758 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 6 RBI, 5 walks, 1 hit by pitch and 1 sac fly... has reached base 2+ times in 6 games.
- **Tim Tawa** has hit in his last 6 games (with PA) at a .381 clip (8-for-21)/1.054 OPS with 1 triple, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 2 walks.

RETURN WITH AUTHORITY: **Justin Martinez** has not al-lowed an earned run in 8 games (2 R-0 ER in 7.2 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18...is 2-0 with an opponent .080 AVG (2-for-25)/.338 OPS with a 0.91 WHIP, 5 walks, 11 strikeouts and no extra-base hits.

STINGY AT HOME: **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 24 of his 25 home games, going 0-0 with a 0.41 ERA (1 ER in 22.0 IP), opponent .151 AVG (11-for-73)/.400 OPS, 0.68 WHIP, 4 walks and 19 strikeouts.

- **Juan Morillo** is scoreless in 11 straight home games (10.1 IP), going 1-0 with 2 saves, an oppo-nent .171 AVG (6-for-35)/.493 OPS, 5 walks and 8 strikeouts.

VS. RANGERS: The D-backs have taken 4 of their last 5 home series...have won or tied 8 of their last 9 home series since 2013.

The D-backs are 8-5 in their last 13 overall meetings.
