**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Brewers play the third game of this four-game series tonight...SF has dropped the first two games and are 2-3 in five contests overall against the Brew Crew this season after winning two of three at Milwaukee on August 6-8...SF enters today having won 15 of its last 22 and is 27-16 since the All-Star break.

**ROSTER MOVES:** RHP **Johnny Cueto** placed on the 10-day Injured List with a right elbow strain...LHP **Caleb Baragar** (#45), RHP **John Brebbia** (#59) and IF/OF **Thairo Estrada** (#39) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.

**IT'S A WRAP:** The Giants finished the month of August with a 19-9 (.678) record in 28 games...the 19 wins were SF's most in a single month this season (went 18-10 in May), and their most wins in a single-month since going 19-6 in July of 2019...the Giants' .679 winning percentage in August was their best in SF era.

**¡ADIÓS PELOTA!** : With **Brandon Belt** and **Wilmer Flores** both homering last night, the Giants have reached 199 home runs this season...the 199 homers are now second-most in team history, trailing only the 2001 team who hit a franchise-best 235 homers...Belt's home run was his 20th this season, making it his first time reaching the 20 home run mark in his career.

**TOP OF THE ROCK:** SF has had the outright best record in the National League now for 108 days, the most days they've had the best record outright in the NL in the SF-era (1958-present) and the most since 1935, when they had the best record for 120 days...it's also the most days they've led the NL West outright since 2003 (176 days).

**BEST IN THE BIGS:** The Giants enter today's game tied with Tampa Bay for the best overall winning percentage in the Majors at 84-48 (.636)...this is the Giants' second-best record through 132 games of a season in the SF-era behind the 1993 club (86-46, .652).

**HOME SLICE:** SF's 42-21 (.667) home record is tops in MLB entering play today, ahead of the Dodgers (45-23, .662) and the Rockies (43-22, .662)...the Giants are averaging 4.81 runs per game at Oracle this season, which would be the fifth-highest runs per game for a season since this park opened in 2000.

**SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE:** The Giants enter tonight with MLB's best record at home (42-21, .667) while the Brewers are the Majors' best team on the road (45-23, .662).

**TRIPLE THREAT:** With last night's game, **Buster Posey**, **Brandon Crawford** and **Brandon Belt** have now started 670 games together for the Giants, tied for fourth-most by any trio in franchise history...including postseason play, Belt, Posey and Crawford have started a total of 706 games together, third-most of all-time for the team.

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

**LHP Brett Anderson** is slated to face the Giants for the 14th time in his career and second this season...the southpaw is 2-5 with a 4.36 ERA in 13 starts against the Orange & Black...he last faced them on August 8, when he held SF hitters to a run on five hits with three strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

**RHP Kevin Gausman** will face Milwaukee for the fifth time in his career and first since 2019...Gausman has gone 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (3er, 14.Oip) and 12 strikeouts in two starts against the Brew Crew, while posting a 1.59 ERA in four appearances overall...the right-hander is 12-5 this season with a 2.49 ERA, fourth-lowest figure in the MLB.

## HOME RUN FUN

The Giants enter today leading the Major Leagues with 199 home runs (Toronto has 196)...SF has scored 52.2% of their runs off home runs (329 of 630 total runs), most in the Majors...only two Giants teams since 1950 have led MLB in home runs (including ties for the lead) and only one since the team moved West in 1958: 1954 NY Giants (186 HR tied with Brooklyn) & 1972 SF Giants (150 HR)...the 199 homers are the team's most since the 2001 club, who hit a franchise-best 235 homers.

**TODAY'S OUTING:** 2021 NL All Star will make his 27th start of the season in the third game of this four-game series against the Brewers...the Giants are 17-9 in his starts this year.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Had one of his better "second half" starts, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on six hits on 91 pitches but did not factor into the decision in SF's 6-5 loss to the Braves last Friday night at Truist Park.

**LET'S GO AT LEAST 6:** Tossed at least 6.0 innings in 15 of his first 18 starts this season going into the All-Star break, but has pitched 6.0 or more innings just twice out of eight outings here in the second half of the season.

**SECOND HALF:** Is 3-2 with a 4.82 ERA (20er, 37.1ip) and a .281 batting average against in eight second half starts...went 9-3 with a 1.73 ERA (22er, 114.2ip) in 18 first half starts.

**THE 1ST INNING:** Has posted a 4.50 ERA (13er, 26.0ip) in the 1st inning this season while fashioning an ERA of 2.07 (29er, 126.0ip) in innings 2 through 9.

**GAUSMAN'S SPLIT:** Throws his split-finger 35.8% of the time, holding opponents to a .115 batting avg. (26-for-227) with 113 of his 176 strikeouts coming off that pitch.

**ON THE LEADERBOARD:** Ranks fourth in the NL in opponents batting average against (.192), tied for fifth in wins (12), eighth in strikeouts (176) and ninth in innings pitched (152.0).

**NL ALL-STAR:** Was named to his first All-Star team, however was ineligible to pitch because of his start the final Sunday before the break...became the first Giants starting pitcher to be selected to the ASG since **Madison Bumgarner** and **Johnny Cueto** in 2016.

**WITH RISP:** Opposition is 15-for-108 (.139) against him with RISP and 6-for-51 (.118) off him with RISP and two outs.

**CONGRATULATIONS!:** Was reinstated from the Paternity List on August 8 after he and his wife, Taylor welcomed their second child, a baby girl (Sutton) on August 6...the baby is named after Hall of Famer Don Sutton.

## DICK TIDROW 1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, MO. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children—Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
