1. SUPPORT ALL PLAYERS

- Encourage effort, teamwork, and sportsmanship—regardless of the score
- Applaud good plays by both teams
- Remember, this is about development and fun



2. RESPECT COACHES & OFFICIALS

- Allow coaches to coach and umpires to officiate
- Do not argue calls from the stands or sidelines
- Address concerns respectfully and at appropriate times (not during games)



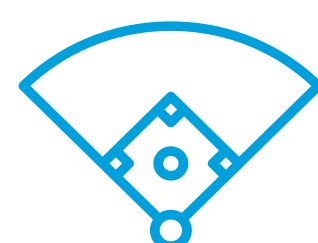
3. MAINTAIN POSITIVE BEHAVIOR

- No yelling, taunting, or negative comments
- No profanity or inappropriate language
- Be a role model—kids are always watching



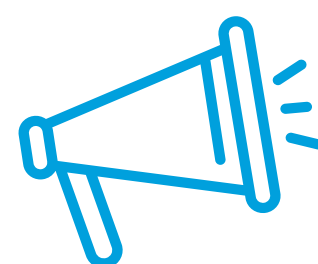
4. KEEP COMPETITION IN PERSPECTIVE

- Focus on learning, effort, and improvement over winning
- Understand mistakes are part of growth
- Celebrate progress, not just results



5. RESPECT THE FACILITY & COMMUNITY

- Follow all facility rules
- Clean up after yourself
- Be courteous to neighbors, staff, and visiting teams



6. ADDRESS ISSUES PROPERLY

- Wait 24 hours before discussing game-related concerns
- Use the league's communication process
- Do not confront coaches, players, or umpires publicly



7. ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

The following may result in removal and/or suspension:

- Verbal or physical abuse
- Threatening behavior
- Harassment of players, coaches, officials, or spectators
- Intoxication or unsafe conduct
- Foul language
