**SHUT OUT THE NOISE:** Dean Kremer threw 6.2 scoreless innings on four hits with six strikeouts and the bullpen trio of **Danny Coulombe** (0.1 IP), **Yennier Cano** (1.0 IP), and **Felix Bautista** (1.0 IP) combined to shut out the Nationals, 1-0, last night at Nationals Park...**Austin Hays** drove in the lone run with an RBI single in the fourth inning.

- ⚾ Marked the 120<sup>th</sup> win in franchise history (since 1954) and the first this season; the O's had four such victories in 2022.
- ⚾ The Orioles have now thrown two shutouts this year (also 4/3 at TEX); since the start of last season, the O's have 17 shutouts, fifth-most in the AL and seventh-most in MLB; Baltimore had 11 total shutouts in 384 games from 2019-21.

**AGAINST THE NATIONALS:** The O's and Nationals complete their two-game set at Nationals Park in Washington, D.C. tonight...Baltimore and Washington will play four times in 2023 with the Orioles hosting the Nats from September 26-27...The Birds went 3-1 against the Nationals last season, including winning both games in D.C. from September 13-14...The teams split a two-game set at Oriole Park from June 21-22.

**LOOKING AHEAD:** The Orioles have a scheduled off day tomorrow before opening a six-game homestand with the Tigers from April 21-23 and Red Sox from April 24-26...The Birds embark on the longest road trip of the season with four games at Detroit from April 27-30, an off day on May 1, three games at Kansas City from May 2-4, and three games at Atlanta from May 5-7.

**ON THE ATTACK:** Baltimore is batting .255/.352/.438 (145-for-568) with 34 doubles, two triples, 22 home runs, 95 runs scored, 92 RBI, and 82 walks to start the season...The O's rank fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB in runs scored after finishing 10<sup>th</sup> in the AL and 20<sup>th</sup> in MLB with 674 runs scored in 2022...The Birds are second in MLB in on-base percentage while ranking among AL teams in walks (1<sup>st</sup>), slugging percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>) and OPS (2<sup>nd</sup>, .790).

- ⚾ The Orioles lead the AL and are tied with the Cincinnati Reds for the MLB lead with 4.10 pitches-per-plate appearance this season; the O's have three players in the top 12 in the AL in pitches-per-plate appearance - **Anthony Santander** (8<sup>th</sup>, 4.35), **Adam Frazier** (T-9<sup>th</sup>, 4.34), and **Adley Rutschman** (12<sup>th</sup>, 4.31).

**NEED FOR SPEED:** The O's have 25 stolen bases, tied with the Guardians for the most in MLB this season...The 25 steals through the first 17 games of the year are the most in O's history (since 1954) to open a campaign...The O's have only been caught stealing three times for an 89.3 percent success rate...**Cedric Mullins** is tied with Chicago-NL's Nico Hoerner for the MLB lead with nine stolen bases while **Jorge Mateo** is second in the AL and third in MLB with eight steals...The duo's 17 combined stolen bases are more than 23 MLB teams while seven teams have eight or fewer steals to start 2023.

- ⚾ Mullins' nine successful stolen bases are the most to begin a season by an Oriole since Adam Jones also swiped his first nine attempts in 2013; the last Orioles to steal 10-or-more bases successfully without being caught to begin a season are Brian Roberts and Corey Patterson, who each swiped their first 13 attempts, an O's record, to begin 2006.

**BIG TIME RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** had his career-high 13-game on-base streak snapped last night...He reached at a .492 clip from April 3-16...Rutschman is still second in the AL and third in MLB with a .457 on-base percentage and leads the AL with 16 walks this season...He also ranks among AL leaders in OPS (5<sup>th</sup>, .995), and batting average (9<sup>th</sup>, .323).

- ⚾ His 37 times reaching base safely this season lead the AL and rank second in MLB behind Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. (39); Rutschman did not reach safely 37 times last year until his 32<sup>nd</sup> game on June 29; he is the only MLB player this season to reach safely at least four times in four different games.

- ⚾ He has hit four home runs this season, tied with Atlanta's Sean Murphy and Los Angeles-AL's Logan O'Hoppe for the most among primary catchers; last year, Rutschman didn't hit his fourth homer until his 38<sup>th</sup> game on July 7.

**HAYS OF OUR LIVES:** **Austin Hays** has a five-game hitting streak since April 13 while slashing .429/.455/.571 (9-for-21) with one double, one triple, five runs scored, one RBI, and one walk during that period...He's also hit in seven of eight games since April 10 while batting .441/.472/.765 (15-for-34) with three doubles, a triple, two homers, 11 runs scored, four RBI, and two walks...Hays' 11 runs scored are tied with Texas' Marcus Semien for the MLB lead during that period...He ranks among AL leaders this season in extra-base hits (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 10), slugging percentage (5<sup>th</sup>, .609), OPS (5<sup>th</sup>, .991), runs scored (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 15), total bases (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 39), batting average (6<sup>th</sup>, .344), and hits (T-7<sup>th</sup>, 22).

- ⚾ Hays' double off Jimmy Lambert in the eighth inning Friday night was 110.5 mph, the hardest-hit ball of his career, per Statcast; six of his seven hardest-hit balls and 10 of his hardest-hit 15 balls in 2023 have come since April 10.
- ⚾ He scored a career-high four runs on April 11 vs. Oakland.
- ⚾ April 11 vs. Oakland marked his second game this year with four hits, joining a five-hit effort on April 1 at Boston; Hays and **Adley Rutschman** are two of the four MLB players with two games of at least four hits this season; since the start of 2022, Hays and Los Angeles-NL's Freddie Freeman both have six games with 4+ hits, most in the majors.

**HIP, HIP JORGE:** **Jorge Mateo** has recorded an extra-base hit in four straight games for the second time in his career, joining May 27-30, 2022...He's batting .636/.843/1.182 (7-for-11) with three doubles, one homer, four runs scored, four RBI, two walks, and one stolen base in those four games since April 14 and .476/.500/.810 (10-for-21) with four doubles, a home run, six runs scored, seven RBI, two walks, one hit-by-pitch, and three stolen bases while recording a hit in six of seven games since April 11...Mateo ranks among AL leaders in OPS (2<sup>nd</sup>, 1.078), batting average (3<sup>rd</sup>, .370), slugging percentage (3<sup>rd</sup>, .652), and on-base percentage (6<sup>th</sup>, .426).

- ⚾ He drove in a run a career-high five straight games from April 12-16 (7 RBI).
- ⚾ Mateo's single off Keynan Middleton on April 15 at Chicago-AL had an exit velocity of a career-high 112.4 mph, the hardest-hit ball by the O's this year, per Statcast

**STEADY CEDDY:** **Cedric Mullins** has hit safely in a season-high six straight games while slashing .429/.571/.571 (9-for-21) with one double, one triple, two runs scored, seven RBI, seven walks, and four stolen bases since April 12...He batted .043 (1-for-23) with one walk in his previous six games before this stretch from April 5-11 and .067 (2-for-30) with three walks in his prior eight games from April 3-11.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Orioles reinstated Kyle Bradish (right foot contusion) from the 15-day Injured List today and optioned Logan Gillaspie to Triple-A Norfolk after yesterday's game.

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his second start of the season tonight against the Nationals...Making his first MLB start since being placed on the 15-day Injured List (right foot contusion) on April 5 (retroactive to 4/4)...Made 23 starts in his inaugural season with the Orioles in 2022...Went 4-7 with a 4.90 ERA (64 ER/117.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts to 46 walks...Made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston; dealt the loss after surrendering three runs (2 ER) on five hits (1 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Was one of 13 players (7 pitchers) to make their debut in 2022...Threw to Adley Rutschman in Rutschman's debut on May 21 vs. Tampa Bay...Tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings across four starts from August 26 to September 6...Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Kyle Brnovich**, **RHP Zach Peek**, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his season debut on April 3 at Texas, allowing one hit with one walk and two strikeouts in 1.2 innings...Exited the game in the second inning with a right foot contusion after being hit by a line drive from Jonah Heim...Made one rehab start with Double-A Bowie on April 14 vs. Akron; dealt the loss after allowing four runs (3 ER) on three hits (1 HR) with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work.

**CAREER AGAINST NL EAST/WASHINGTON:** Making his first career start against the Nationals and against the NL East.

**HITTIN' THE ROAD:** Went 3-2 with a 4.77 ERA (29 ER/54.2 IP) and 55 strikeouts in 11 road starts in 2022...The O's owned an 8-3 record in those games... Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts in 7.0 innings... Became the first O's hurler to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since **LHP John Means** on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in eight of his 11 road starts in 2022.

**BRINGING HIS 'A-GAME':** Made 14 starts against teams that qualified for the 2022 playoffs in his debut season, going 4-4 with a 4.24 (36 ER/76.1 IP) ERA...The Orioles owned a 9-5 record in those games...He went 2-0 against Houston, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings on August 26 at Minute Maid Park and throwing another 8.2 shutout frames on September 22 at Oriole Park.

**SAVING HIS BEST FOR LAST:** Went 3-2 with a 2.76 ERA (14 ER/45.2 IP) and 38 strikeouts in his final eight starts in 2022...Made six starts against teams that qualified for the postseason in that stretch; owned a 3-1 record with a 1.35 ERA (6 ER/40.1 IP) in those games...Allowed two home runs over his final eight starts, good for an 0.39 HR/9...His 0.39 HR/9 from August 26 on ranked third in MLB.

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS:** Started the season with Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in three starts with the team...Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 11-17 after going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in two starts...Recalled from Norfolk on April 29 and made his MLB debut later that day against the Boston Red Sox...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) on June 24...Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in his final 13 starts after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on July 29...Notched his first win at Oriole Park on September 22 vs. Houston after surrendering two hits and recording ten punchouts in 8.2 scoreless innings...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 16 of his 23 starts.
