TODAY'S GAME: San Francisco will look to even up this series this afternoon after falling short last night, 7-5...after winning three of the first four games of this season series vs. San Diego, the Giants are 1-6 in the last seven games vs. the Padres, including losing each of their last four contests.

- ▶ SF needs to win just one of its final 15 games to avoid the second 100-loss season in team history (the club went 62-100 in 1985).

ON THE HOME FRONT: The Giants have won eight of their last 13 games at home and are 23-17 (.575) in their last 40 games at Oracle Park dating to June 14.

- ▶ Last night's loss dropped SF to 36-37 at home this year with eight home games remaining...SF has only finished with a losing record at home five times in the Oracle Park-era (since 2000): 2019 (35-46), 2017 (38-43), 2008 (37-44), 2007 (39-42) and 2005 (37-44).

ON THE HILL: LHP **César Perdomo** makes his third appearance (second start) since having his contract selected from Triple-A when rosters expanded on September 1.

- ▶ In his first career MLB start last Sunday in New York, he blanked the Mets over 6.0 innings...he allowed three hits, a walk and struck out four...he left in line for his first big league win but settled for a no-decision in an eventual 4-2 loss.
- ▶ His changeup was particularly effective against the Mets as they went 1-for-12 in at-bats that ended with the pitch...in his two outings, hitters are 1-for-14 in ABs that end with that offering...the Padres as a team have a .632 OPS (12th of 30 clubs) against changeups and a .601 OPS against changeups from a lefty (17th of 30 teams).

KEEP ON KEEPING ON: IF **Rafael Devers** hit his ninth career grand slam last night (and the Giants' Major League-leading ninth of the season) for his 36th homer of the season.

- ▶ Devers is now four homers shy of SF's first 40-homer season since **Barry Bonds** in 2004 (45) and four RBI shy of the club's first 100-RBI season since **Buster Posey** in 2012 (103)...as it stands now, Devers' 96 RBI are most by a Giant since **Hunter Pence** had 99 in 2013.
- ▶ His 36 homers and 96 RBI are both fifth-most in the National League while his .862 OPS is eighth-best.

BRYCE, BRYCE, BABY: IF **Bryce Eldridge** extended his on-base streak to 19 games last night, which is tied with Mookie Betts for the longest active such streak in the Majors...it's Eldridge's second 19+ game on-base streak this season after a career-best 22-game on-base streak from May 23-June 17.

- ▶ During this 19-game on-base streak he's slashing .366/.453/.549 with seven doubles, two homers, 20 RBI, seven runs scored and 13 walks...since the start of that streak on August 20, Eldridge's 20 RBI are tied with MIL's William Contreras for third-most behind teammate **Rafael Devers** (27) and CHC's Alex Bregman (21)...his .366 average is fourth-best in that time while his .453 OBP is seventh-best.

BROADENING OUR HORIZONS: Through August 28, the Giants scored 43.5% of their runs via the homer, tied for ninth-highest percentage in the Majors...since August 29, however, they've scored 35.7% of their runs via a homer, 19th of 30 clubs.

FOR ALL THE MARBLES: Single-A San Jose won the California League's Northern Division title Thursday night with a 3-1 victory over Stockton clinching a spot in the California League Championship Series, which begins Sunday at Lake Elsinore.

- ▶ High-A Eugene had its playoff run come to a close last night, dropping a heartbreaker 9-8 at home to lose the Northwest League Championship Series three games to none...they carried a four-run lead into the 8th inning but Vancouver scored once in the 8th and three more times in the 9th inning to tie it...after exchanging runs in the 10th, Vancouver went ahead for good in the 12th with the Ems unable to answer...IF **Jhonny Level** drove in three runs in the defeat while **Isaiah Barkett** had three hits.
- ▶ Double-A Richmond, who clinched a postseason berth by winning the Eastern League's Southwest Division in the first half, wraps up its regular season this weekend and will begin their divisional series versus Erie on Tuesday at Erie in a best-of-three series.

WHAT'S UP, ROOK?: The 24-year-old from San Juan de los Morros, VZ is in his debut MLB season...this is Perdomo's third level this season (also Double-A and Triple-A).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Made his MLB debut on September 1 at Pittsburgh, becoming the 15th Giants player to make their MLB debut this season...he became just the seventh Giants left-handed pitcher since 1899 to throw at least 4.0 innings of relief in their MLB debut as shown in the chart below.

LAST TIME OUT: Followed up his solid debut with his first career start at the MLB level last Sunday in New York...blanked the Mets over 6.0 innings... he held them to three hits, walked one and struck out four and left with SF leading 2-0...he couldn't pick up his first MLB win, however, as the bullpen let the lead and game slip away in the 8th inning in a 4-2 Giants loss...was very efficient in his outing at Citi Field, needing only 83 pitches to get through 6.0 innings.

THE BREAKDOWN: Kept the Mets off balance primarily with his four seamer and his changeup...Mets hitters went 1-for-4 in at-bats that ended with the four-seamer, 1-for-12 in ABs that ended with the changeup and 1-for-3 off his slider...threw his fastball 34 times and hsi changeup 30 times...through two outings, batters are 1-for-14 in ABs that end with his changeup.

WITH THE RIVER CATS: Was 7-2 with a 5.10 ERA (27er, 47.2ip) in nine games for Triple-A Sacramento prior to is promotion...he was in excellent form prior to his call-up...after starting 1-2 in his first three Triple-A starts, Perdomo went 6-0 with a 3.89 ERA (16er, 37.0ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP over his final six AAA starts since July 30.

WITH THE SQUIRRELS: Went 2-4 with a 3.98 ERA (32er, 72.1ip), 89 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP in 13 starts for Double-A Richmond prior to his promotion...at the time of his promotion to Double-A, Perdomo's 89 strikeouts were ninth-most in all of Double-A.

SPLITS: Was burned by left-handed hitters in Triple-A, with them holding a .348/.434/.576 slash line compared to a .264/.319/.424 slash line against right-handed hitters...through two MLB games, lefties are 5-for-14 (.357) with two extra-base hits but righties are 1-for-19 (.053).

LAST SEASON: Spent the entire 2025 season with High-A Eugene...led the NWL in innings pitched (127.1)...he ranked inside the league's top-5 in games started (26, T-1st), WHIP (1.24, 2nd), wins (8, T-3rd), ERA (3.96, 4th) and strikeouts (118, 4th).

AWARD SZN: Perdomo was named an Northwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of September 8, 2024 while pitching for High-A Eugene, and was a California League Post-Season All-Star in 2024 with Single-A San Jose.
