YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles were defeated by the Cubs, 9-2, in the series opener...Drop to 19-11 in series openers and to 12-12 against National League opponents...Have allowed eight-or-more runs for the second time this month and for the sixth time in 17 games since June 21; the Birds had five such games in 74 games through June 20...**Dean Kremer** dropped to 4-5 after allowing seven runs (5 ER) on seven hits (2 HR), three walks, and one hit-by-pitch with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings pitched...**Jordan Westburg** connected on his 15th home run of the season in the second inning, a 418-foot solo shot to left field...Prior to yesterday's game, Westburg was named to the American League All-Star team, becoming the fourth Oriole to be selected to this year's Midsummer Classic.

ALL-STAR ANNOUNCEMENT: MLB announced the rest of the American League and National League All-Star teams on Sunday afternoon...Four Orioles have been selected to the All-Star Game, while two were named starters as a result of the fan vote revealed on Wednesday...**Adley Rutschman** (C) and **Gunnar Henderson** (SS) will start for the AL, marking the first time Baltimore will have multiple starters in a Midsummer Classic since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014...**Corbin Burnes** was selected to his fourth career All-Star Game in his first season as an Oriole...**Jordan Westburg** was added to the AL All-Star roster for the first time in his career on Tuesday afternoon as a replacement for Boston's Rafael Devers...With Westburg's addition, the 2024 O's are the first team to have three All-Star position players who are in their third career season or earlier, per MLB's **Andrew Simon**.

- 👉 Rutschman received 70 percent of the votes to defeat Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's an All-Star for the second time (2023) and will be making his first starting assignment; he'll become the third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; **Matt Wieters** was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).
- 👉 Henderson beat Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of the votes; this is his first career All-Star selection and is the first Orioles shortstop sent to the Midsummer Classic since **Manny Machado** started in 2018.
- 👉 Burnes becomes the first Orioles starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since **John Means** in 2019; he's made his fourth straight All-Star team and first in the AL.
- 👉 Westburg is the first Orioles third baseman to be selected to the All-Star Game since **Manny Machado** in 2016.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won eight of their last 12 games after dropping their previous five, the team's longest losing streak since May 13-18, 2022 (6 G)...At 57-34 (.626), the Birds own the third-best record in MLB behind the Guardians (.633, 57-33) and Phillies (.648, 59-32)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 158-95 (.625), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The O's are 241-174 (.581) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.586, 243-172), Braves (.618, 256-158), and Dodgers (.639, 266-150).

- 👉 The 57 wins are tied for the fourth most through 91 games in team history with 1971 and 1997, while trailing 1969 (63) and 1966 and 1979 (59).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 147 home runs, 15 more than the second-place Yankees (132) and 22 more than the Dodgers (125), who are third...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

- 👉 The 147 homers are the most through 91 games in team history; the quickest a Baltimore club has hit 147 home runs to begin a season before this year was in 2016 (97 G); the team record (since 1954) for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996.
- 👉 The O's are 48-23 this year when homering, 37-8 when hitting multiple home runs, 19-5 when hitting at least three, and 5-2 when hitting four.
- 👉 Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most in MLB: **Gunnar Henderson** (27), **Anthony Santander** (23), **Adley Rutschman** (16), **Jordan Westburg** (15), **Colton Cowser** and **Ryan Mountcastle** (12), and **Ryan O'Hearn** (11).
- 👉 Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramirez and Josh Naylor, and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Juan Soto; only five other teams have one player with at least 20 homers - Braves (Ozuna), Diamondbacks (Walker), Dodgers (Ohtani), Phillies (Harper), and Red Sox (Devers).
- 👉 The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).
- 👉 The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.
- 👉 **Anthony Santander** led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history; he tied with **Nelson Cruz** (13 in May 2014) and **Frank Robinson** (13 in July 1966), and finished behind **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a month by an Oriole.

CLOSING TIME: **Craig Kimbrel** ranks second in the AL and tied for third in MLB with 23 saves...He has matched his total from 2023 with the Phillies and is one behind 2021 combined between the Cubs (23) and White Sox (1)...The last time he recorded more than 24 saves in a season was in 2018 with the Red Sox (42)...His 440 career saves are fourth all time and two ahead of Boston's Kenley Jansen for the most among active pitchers...Kimbrel passed Francisco Rodriguez (437 SV) on July 3 at Seattle and is 38 saves behind former Oriole **Lee Smith** for third on the all-time list.

- 👉 Since May 10, he's 2-1 with 15 saves in 16 chances with a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP) while holding opponents to a .088/.184/.103 (6-for-68) slash line with five walks and three hit batters while striking out 31 in 22 games; 18 of those appearances have been hitless.
- 👉 His 1,244 strikeouts are the third most in MLB history as a reliever.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** announced on ESPN's *Sunday Night Baseball* last week that he will participate in the 2024 T-Mobile Home Run Derby in Arlington...He will be the third Oriole in the last four seasons to hit in the derby, joining **Adley Rutschman** (2023) and **Trey Mancini** (2021).

- 👉 Henderson is among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).
- 👉 His MLB-best 77 runs scored this season are the most through the first 91 team games of a season in O's history; the only players in club history to lead the AL in runs are **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** in 1982 (121); Robinson is the only player in Orioles history to lead MLB in runs, when he tied with Atlanta's Felipe Alou.
- 👉 He had a career-long 36-game on-base streak from May 22 to June 29, the longest by an O's batter since **Nick Markakis**' 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009.
- 👉 His career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21 was the longest hitting streak by an O's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles finished 29 games in 30 days in June while going 17-12 (.586), the third-best record in the AL during that time...The O's have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the O's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand today with the second of three games against the Cubs...The O's will then host the Yankees from Friday through Sunday before heading into the All-Star break...The Birds went 4-3 on their last homestand against the Guardians (1-2) and Rangers (3-1) from June 24-30, tied for their worst homestand of the season, joining April 26-May 2...At 29-18 (.617), the O's own the fourth-best home record in the AL this year and the seventh-best in MLB...Since the start of 2023, the Birds have gone 78-50 (.609) at Oriole Park, owning the best home record in the AL and the fifth-best home record in MLB behind the Brewers (.623, 76-46), Dodgers (.633, 81-47), Braves (.638, 81-46), and Phillies (.643, 83-46).

AGAINST THE CUBBIES: The O's and Cubs carry on with a three-game series tonight at Oriole Park...Baltimore is 7-13 (.350) against Chicago-NL all time, the second-fewest number of games (20) against an opponent in team history behind the Dodgers (18, 7-11)...The .350 winning percentage is the second-lowest all time against one opponent by the Orioles ahead of only the Marlins (.317, 13-28)...The Birds are 2-7 against the Cubs at Oriole Park since the teams first met in 2003.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 19th start of the season tonight against the Cubs...Reinstated from the Paternity List on July 1; placed on the PL June 28... His 2.32 ERA is the lowest mark for an Orioles starting pitcher through his first 18 starts in a season since Jim Palmer in 1975 (1.78) and it is the second-lowest mark for a pitcher through his first 18 starts to begin an Orioles career all time, only behind Mike Cuellar in 1969 (2.25)...The Orioles are 12-6 in his starts this year...Has allowed 22 stolen bases this season, the most by any pitcher in MLB...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024... Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on July 4 at Seattle after allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Has completed at least 6.0 innings in a career-high 13 consecutive starts, the longest such streak by an Orioles pitcher since Sidney Ponson did so in 16 straight (7/4-10/2/04 [G2])...Threw 94 pitches, 62 strikes.

AGAINST THE CUBS: Owns a 2-4 record with a 3.26 ERA (25 ER/69.0 IP) in 16 career appearances (10 GS) against Chicago-NL...Went 0-2 with a 3.75 ERA (5 ER/12.0 IP) across his two starts against the Cubs last season; allowed one run on eight hits, two walks, and one hit batter with seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings in his last outing against them on August 29, 2023 at Wrigley Field.

AGAINST THE NL CENTRAL: Will be making his 76th career appearance (45th start) against the NL Central...Owns a lifetime 17-13 record with a 3.07 ERA (103 ER/302.0 IP) against the division...NL Central foes are slashing .202/.279/.321 (222-for-1100) off him in his career...Allowed three runs (2 ER) on six hits (1 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts across 5.0 innings vs. Milwaukee on April 14, his only start against the division this season.

HIGH QUALITY: Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest streak in the majors this year and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 14 quality starts on the season are tied for third in MLB and his 72 quality outings since the start of 2021 are the most.

NEW BEGINNINGS: Burnes began his Orioles career with 15 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings and three-or-fewer runs allowed...The 15 consecutive outings was the longest such streak to begin a pitcher's career with the Orioles all-time.

EARLY STRUGGLES: After allowing five first-inning runs across his first six starts to open the season, Burnes has not allowed one since his outing on April 26 vs. Oakland...Four of those first inning runs have come via solo home runs.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with 200+ strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is one away from 100 on the season and 31 away from 1,000 for his career.

INNINGS EATER: The 675.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank third in MLB behind San Francisco's Logan Webb (676.0) and Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (693.0 IP)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
