PITTSBURGH PIRATES (2-2) vs. BOSTON RED SOX (2-2)

APRIL 4, 2023 at Fenway Park, Boston, MA -- GAME #5/ROAD #5
RHP ROANSY CONTRERAS (5-5, 3.79 ERA IN 2022) vs. RHP NICK PIVETTA (10-12, 4.56 ERA IN 2022)

THE PIRATES:...Opened their three-game series against the Red Sox with a 7-6 comeback win last night at Fenway Park...Dropped each of the final two games of their season-opening series against the Reds at Great American Ball Park...Opened their 137th season as a member of the National League with a 5-4 win against the Reds Thursday afternoon.

ROSTER MOVE: The Pittsburgh Pirates today placed catcher Austin Hedges on the seven-day concussion injured list... Catcher Tyler Heineman had his contract selected from Triple-A Indianapolis...To make room for Heineman on the 40-man roster, right-handed pitcher Edwin Uceta has been designated for assignment...Heineman will wear uniform No. 54...In addition, outfielder Ryan Vilade has cleared waivers and has been outrighted to Indianapolis.

THE BATTLIN' BUCCOS: The Pirates scored three times in the first inning last night before surrendering five runs to the Red Sox in the bottom of the first inning...It marked the third time since 2018 that the Pirates allowed at least five runs in an inning on the road but went on to win the game...Prior to last night, the Bucs lost 19 straight road games when allowing at least five runs in an inning since winning for the last time on July 11, 2021, at Citi Field against the Mets...New York scored five times in the first before the Pirates emerged as 6-5 winners.

ALSO FROM LAST NIGHT: The Pirates won in interleague action for the second time in the last 25 games after allowing at least six runs in a game...Prior to last night, Pittsburgh's only other win against an American League team in the last 25 games after allowing at least six runs in a game came on June 18, 2021, against Cleveland at PNC Park.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Roansy Contreras will make his season debut tonight in the middle game of this series against the Red Sox...Contreras ranked fifth among all National League rookies in ERA (3.79) and strikeouts (86) and third in batting average against (.225) during the 2022 season...The 23-year-old righthander also posted the seventh-lowest ERA (3.53) among all rookies in MLB with at least 50.0 innings pitched beginning with his start on July 7 through the end of the season while his .202 batting average against in that time ranked third among MLB rookies with at least 50.0 innings of work.

BACK-TO-BACK B. REY: Bryan Reynolds went deep for the second straight game last night with his two-out solo shot in the second inning before also connecting for his second homer of the night in the fourth...Reynolds has now homered in back-to-back games 12 times in his career...He did it four times during the 2022 season (last from September 12-13).

TWICE AS NICE: Last night Bryan Reynolds recorded the fourth multi-homer game of his career and his first since August 18, 2022, which came against the Red Sox at PNC Park...Last night Reynolds became the eighth player all-time (and only National League player) with back-to-back multiple-homer games vs. the Red Sox and the first to do it since Baltimore's Anthony Santander from September 26-27, 2022.

<u>HEY 1900:</u> Andrew McCutchen's next game played will be the 1900th of his career... McCutchen ranks sixth among all active players in games played...McCutchen has played in 1350 career games as a Pirate, which ranks 14th all-time in club history (Honus Wagner is first with 2437).

<u>BIRTHDAY GREETINGS:</u> Opening Day starter Mitch Keller is celebrating his 27th birthday today...Keller has spent his entire career as a member of the Pirates organization after being selected in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar earned his second save of the season Monday night that was highlighted by striking out each of the last two batters he faced...Bednar has recorded a 1.27 ERA (21.1ip/3er) in 22 career appearances during the month of March/April.

DAURI DEALING: Dauri Moreta worked 0.1 scoreless inning Monday night while also stranding his third inherited runner of the season...Dating back to his outing on July 10 of last year while pitching for the Reds, Moreta has posted a 1.08 ERA (16.2ip/2er), 18 strikeouts, .130 batting average against and 0.84 WHIP.

<u>CRUZ'N RIGHT ALONG:</u> Oneil Cruz enters today with a career-best 14-game on-base streak dating back to September 23 of last year...During his current 14-game streak, Cruz is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with four doubles, a homer and six RBI.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 4, 2007: The Pirates completed a season-opening three game sweep of the Astros at Minute Maid Park with a 5-4 win. It was Pittsburgh's first three game sweep in Houston since 1991 and first for the Buccos at Minute Maid Park since the ballpark opened its doors in 2000.

MITCH KELLER: The 27-year-old righthander will make his second start of the season tomorrow in the finale of this season-opening six-game road trip to Cincinnati and Boston...Made his first career Opening Day start Thursday at Cincinnati, allowing four runs in 4.2 innings in a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 5-4 win... Posted a 3.22 ERA (120.1ip/43er) in his last 22 starting assignments last season after rejoining the rotation on 5/31...His 3.22 ERA from 5/31 through the end of the regular season ranked 12th among all qualified National League pitchers during that time.

vs. BOSTON: 0-1 in one career start...Allowed five runs (4er) in 2.0 innings while losing a 5-3 decision against Nick Pivetta last year at PNC Park on 8/16...Has gone 1-6 with a 4.55 ERA (57.1ip/29er) in 12 career starts during interleague play...Went 0-3 with a 4.68 ERA (25.0ip/13er) in five starts last season against the American League.
