Olson at Fenway

1B Matt Olson belted his 15th home run of the season last night, a two-run shot into the right-field stands.

Olson has a home run in three of his last four games here at Fenway Park dating to the beginning of 2025. He owns a slash line of .500/.526/1.188 (1.714 OPS) in those contests.

Olson's 15 homers stand as the second most he's hit through a season's first 55 games, only behind his franchise record-setting 2023 campaign, when he had 17 at this juncture.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Red Sox today continue a three-game midweek series with the fifth of six games between the clubs this season...The two are set to play all six games in a span of just 14 days, as Atlanta hosted Boston for three games at Truist Park from May 15-17.

A Atlanta bookended the first set with a pair of wins to take the series, including a walk-off double from Mike Yastrzemski in Game 1.

A Atlanta went an even 3-3 in six games versus Boston last season, with each club winning a series in the visiting ballpark...The Braves and Red Sox are playing for the seventh consecutive season, and Atlanta is 18-14 (.563) against Boston in 32 total games since 2020.

A The Braves are the only visiting team in MLB with a winning record at Fenway Park, playing to a 29-22 all-time record (.569).

A Since the advent of Interleague Play in 1997, Atlanta has played Boston far more than any other American League team...The two clubs have met 104 times in that span, with the Braves going 50-54 (.481)...The Braves have not played any other AL team more than 70 times (Toronto).

A LHP Connelly Early is set to face Atlanta for the second time in his last three starts...He pitched against the Braves on May 15 at Truist Park, the first game of that series, and gave up a pair of runs across 5.0 innings in a no-decision...The Braves won that game in walk-off fashion in the 10th inning...Early has allowed more than two earned runs in just three of his 14 career starts...In total, he has pitched to a 4-2 record and a 3.33 ERA (20 ER/54.0 IP) since his MLB debut on September 9, 2025.

BRYCE ELDER: Will toe the rubber for Atlanta tonight among MLB's leaders in multiple statistical categories, including innings pitched (6th, 68.2), earned run average (7th, 1.97), opponent batting average (8th, .190) and WHIP (9th, 0.99).

A Since 2013, Elder is one of three Braves to allow three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first 11 starts of the season, joining Max Fried (11 starts, 2020) and Reynaldo López (17 games, 2024)... League-wide, the only players this season to do so are Jacob Misiorowski (MIL, 11 games) and Cam Schlitler (NYY, 12 games).

A Elder has faced Boston twice in his career, including in Game 2 of the series earlier this season...He covered 8.0 innings and allowed three runs, but took the loss...The last Brave to post such a stat line was Jaime García, who equaled each of those stats on May 21, 2017 in a loss to the Washington Nationals, 3-2.

A Left-handed batters are hitting just .135 (21-for-156) off Elder, the third-best mark by a qualified pitcher regardless of throwing hand...He trails Misiorowski (.110) and Christopher Sánchez (PHI, .127).

MICHAEL HARRIS II: Went 4-for-4 while accumulating eight total bases, hitting a pair of singles, a double and a two-run home run...He scored two runs and finished with three RBI.

A He went deep on a pitch just 1.23 feet off the ground, the lowest offering he's ever hit for a home run...Only seven other players have homered on lower pitches this season.

A The home run left the yard at 104.1 mph...In the Statcast era (since 2015), only 11 changeups at that height (or lower) have been hit as hard for homers.

A Harris II logged his second four-hit game of the season, one of just nine players in MLB with multiple...Since his 2022 debut, he has posted six four-hit games while batting in the bottom three spots of the batting order, twice as many as any other player.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Connelly Early this evening...They faced lefties in each of their last two games and are scheduled to face another tomorrow in southpaw Payton Tolle...The stretch will constitute a four-game streak of the Braves facing a left-handed starter.

A It's the second time this season that Atlanta will see at least four straight lefties, after facing five in a row from April 29-May 3 in games against Detroit and Colorado.

A The team enters play 17-5 (.773) against opposing left-handed starters this season...Those are the most wins and the third-best winning percentage in such games in the majors this year.

A The Los Angeles Dodgers (10-2, .833) and Tampa Bay Rays (12-3, .800) are the only clubs with higher winning percentages against lefties.

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 183-104 (.638) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .626 (204-122).

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 12 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 10-2 record in those games.

AT FENWAY: Although interleague play didn't begin until 1997, the Braves have played 139 games at Fenway park, beginning in 1913...The team owns a 29-22 (.569) record against the Red Sox inside this venue, and a 59-27 (.686) record when facing non-Boston teams here (including playoffs).

A The current Atlanta Braves played their home games at Fenway Park during the 1914 World Series, and began the 1915 regular season here...The Braves clinched that World Series at this park, beating the Philadelphia Athletics, 3-1.

A The Braves have more all-time wins (87) at Fenway Park than two current members of the AL: the Seattle Mariners (84) and Houston Astros (26).

Today's Game

Makes his 12th start of the season today and the 90th of his career in the middle game of a three-game series against the Red Sox at Fenway Park...Will be facing Boston for the second time this season after taking the loss in their May 16 meeting at Truist Park.

Is 0-2 with a 4.05 ERA (6 ER/13.1 IP) over two career starts against the Red Sox, both coming this season and last...Has yet to earn a win against Boston.

Carries a 1.97 ERA (15 ER/68.2 IP) across 11 starts entering play, the fifth-lowest mark among qualified National League starters...Has posted a 60-to-21 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a 0.99 WHIP over the span...Atlanta is 7-4 in his 11 turns.

Dating to August 24 of last season, an 18-start span, Elder has tallied a major-league-most 14 quality starts...His 2.30 ERA (29 ER/113.1 IP) ranks fourth in baseball over the span, behind New York's (AL) Cam Schlichter (1.90), Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (1.99) and teammate Chris Sale (2.20)...Also ranks third in IP (113.1) and eighth in WHIP (0.99) over the span.

Has worked at least 5.0 innings while allowing three earned runs or fewer in each of his last 14 starts dating to September 19 of last season...He is the first Atlanta pitcher to do so since Reynaldo López strung together 17 such turns in 2024.

Left-handed batters are 21-for-156 (.135) against him this season, the second-lowest mark among qualified major league starters behind only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (.110)...Right-handers are 26-for-92 (.283).

Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts, the first such mark by an Atlanta starter since Teheran in 2014.

His four-seam fastball is averaging 92.1 mph this season, a career-high mark that edges his 91.8 average from 2025 and is up 1.4 mph from his 90.7 mph average across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25.

Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this season after not registering the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25...Has thrown the offering almost exclusively to left-handed batters, going to it against a right-hander on just three pitches all season, all on May 16 against Boston.

Since the start of the 2023 season, the Braves are 45-36 in Elder's starts...His 78 starts for Atlanta over the span lead the Braves staff.

2026

His 1.97 ERA (15 ER/68.2 IP) over his first 11 starts of the season is the second-lowest mark in his career through 11 turns to open a year, behind only his 2023 mark (1.92, 14 ER/65.2 IP).

Across the 11-start span this season, Elder has worked more innings (68.2 to 65.2), allowed 10 fewer hits (47 to 57) and recorded four more strikeouts (60 to 56) than he did to begin 2023...His 0.99 WHIP through 11 starts is a career low for the span, down from 1.16 in 2023.

Recorded a no-decision in his last outing on May 22 against Washington, working 6.0 innings of one-run ball on five hits with one walk and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 5-4, 11-inning walk-off win at Truist Park.

Took the loss in his lone start against Boston on May 16, working 8.0 innings of three-run ball on seven hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 103 pitches in a 3-2 defeat at Truist Park...It marked his longest outing since June 7, 2025 at San Francisco, and the second-longest start of his career.

Earned his fourth win on May 10 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 5.2 scoreless innings with four walks and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts on 83 pitches in the 7-2 victory at Los Angeles (NL)...Marked his second career win against the Dodgers.

Took the loss on April 4 at Arizona despite tossing 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run (4 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K, 89 pitches)...Committed his first career fielding error, a throwing miscue in the second inning that resulted in two unearned runs...Atlanta managed just one run of support in the 2-1 defeat.

Earned the win in his season debut on March 30, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings against the Athletics (5 H, 1 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches)...Recorded his first career pickoff, catching Lawrence Butler at first base in the second inning.

Career

Awards: 2023 National League All-Star.

Completed his first full major league season in 2023, going 12-4 with a 3.81 ERA (74 ER/174.2 IP) in 31 games, all starts.

Named to the 2023 National League All-Star Team, his first selection.

Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.

Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.

Career Cont.

Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-10) and Ian Anderson (20-21) each had five such starts.

Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.

Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).

The other two were both selected by Atlanta, and chosen with the 126th (Spencer Strider) and 156th (Elder) overall selections.
