1-2 to the Diamondbacks last weekend, followed by a 1-2 series loss to the Yankees mid-
weektonight, Minnesota will begin a four-game series against the Guardians through the
weekend — including a doubleheader tomorrow (make-up of May 20).

TWINS DROP FINALE TO NEW YORK: The Twins lost to the Yankees on Wednesday night by a score of 10-5...Taj Bradley (6-8) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks, four strikeouts and two home runs...the offense recorded 11 hits, three coming from Brooks Lee...Minnesota now has 58 hits over six games this homestand, recording nine-plus in all but one game (7 on 9/14 vs. ARI)...they are averaging 6.0 runs-per-game on the homestand and hitting .279 with RISP.

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the 10th of 13 games in 2025... Twins have gone 3-6 this season, going 1-1 at Target Field and 2-5 at Progressive Field.

♣ Six of the nine games this season between these two teams have been decided by one run...the Twins have gone 2-4 in those games.

♣ Since the start of 2024, 16 of the 22 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-13 in those)...and 11 have been decided by one run (Twins 2-9).

♣ Twins starting pitchers have posted 3.26 ERA (47.0 IP, 17 ER) against Cleveland this season.

♣ Austin Martin is hitting .400 (6-for-15) in seven career games against the Guardians.
