THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their 10-game homestand, losing a series 1-2 to the Diamondbacks last weekend, followed by a 1-2 series loss to the Yankees mid-week...tonight, Minnesota will begin a four-game series against the Guardians through the weekend — including a doubleheader tomorrow (make-up of May 20).
✦ Twins have 10 games remaining, four at home and six on the road.
✦

TWINS DROP FINALE TO NEW YORK: The Twins lost to the Yankees on Wednesday night by a score of 10-5...Taj Bradley (6-8) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing seven runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks, four strikeouts and two home runs...the offense recorded 11 hits, three coming from Brooks Lee...Minnesota now has 58 hits over six games this homestand, recording nine-plus in all but one game (7 on 9/14 vs. ARI)...they are averaging 6.0 runs-per-game on the homestand and hitting .279 with RISP.

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the 10th of 13 games in 2025...Twins have gone 3-6 this season, going 1-1 at Target Field and 2-5 at Progressive Field.
✦ Six of the nine games this season between these two teams have been decided by one run...the Twins have gone 2-4 in those games.
✦ Since the start of 2024, 16 of the 22 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-13 in those)...and 11 have been decided by one run (Twins 2-9).
✦ Twins starting pitchers have posted 3.26 ERA (47.0 IP, 17 ER) against Cleveland this season.
✦ Austin Martin is hitting .400 (6-for-15) in seven career games against the Guardians.
✦ Byron Buxton has 14 career home runs against the Guards, his third-most vs. any opponent (Chicago-AL - 23, Detroit - 15).

LEFT SIDE STORIES: Twins are hitting .308 (66-for-214) with an .896 OPS over their last 20 games against left-handed pitching.
✦ Brooks Lee is hitting .311 (28-for-90) with an .857 OPS in his last 53 games vs. lefties.
✦ Byron Buxton is hitting .315 (29-for-92) with nine home runs, a .707 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS against left-handed pitching on the season — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career.

SLAPPIN' THE BASEPATHS: Over their last 27 games, since August 18, the Twins have posted a 5.7 BsR (base running runs above average), which is the best in baseball...in 108 games leading up to the trade deadline (July 31), the Twins posted a -6.5 BsR, ranking 29th in baseball (lower left)...in 44 games since, they have posted a BsR of 4.4, fourth-best in baseball (lower right):

AUSTIN, STONE COLD: Austin Martin went 2-for-4 on Wednesday night, extending his career-high on-base streak to 14 games (previous was 8)...over his last 21 games, Martin is hitting .353 (24-for-68) with six doubles, four RBI, 13 runs scored, 14 walks, just 13 strikeouts, a .470 on-base percentage and a .911 OPS.
✦ Martin has posted a .431 on-base percentage in 16 games this month, sixth-best in the AL and 13th-best in baseball.

KILLEBREW AWARD WINNERS: The Twins yesterday announced the 2025 Harmon Killebrew Award winners for outstanding minor league community service...the Twins have annually recognized a player from each of the organization's full-season affiliates for their service within the respective affiliate's community; players are nominated by their respective general managers...a plaque is awarded, in addition to an on-field presentation during spring training.
✦ Catcher **Noah Cardenas** has been named the winner of the award representing Triple-A St. Paul, his third Killebrew Award honor after also receiving the honor in 2022 with Fort Myers and 2023 with Cedar Rapids...the 25-year-old made four appearances on the Children's Minnesota Hospital Star Studio and visited patients in their rooms, and participated in two baseball camp sessions...Cardenas also volunteered at Catholic Charities, severing meals to those in need, every Monday when the Saints returned from road trips; these visits were set up by Noah himself, not through the team, and got teammates to join him on a few occasions.
✦ Right-handed pitcher **Ricky Castro** is representing Double-A Wichita...Ricky was one of the first players to get excited about the Wind Surge's Minnesota Twins Week of Service project with Habitat for Humanity, and also volunteered his time at The Lord's Diner, a local kitchen that provides three meals a day to those in need...while at The Lord's Diner, Castro and he got a few other teammates spent four hours serving food, refilling drinks, cleaning dishes and engaging with people.
✦ Right-handed pitcher **Nick Trabacchi** is representing High-A Cedar Rapids...Nick assisted with the club's baseball camp and visited a Veterans Administration hospital, visiting patient rooms and greeting people at the hospital's front entrance.
✦ Right-handed pitcher **Eli Jones** has been named the winner of the award representing Low-A Fort Myers...in his first professional season, Jones was recognized by Fort Myers staff for his leadership in the clubhouse and in the community, going above and beyond in his interactions with fans, community members and teammates.

REHAB UPDATES: Catcher Christian Vázquez began his rehab assignment last night in Memphis for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-for-3 with two walks as the designated hitter...Vazky has been on the IL with a left shoulder infection since August 8...left-handed pitcher Anthony Misiewicz begins his rehab assignment with St. Paul tonight...Misiewicz was placed on the IL on July 25 with left shoulder impingement.
