TODAY'S GAME: The Brewers and White Sox meet for the first of four games this spring.....they also play each other in Phoenix today, Glendale on 3/13 and Phoenix on 3/19.....they meet during the regular season from 4/29-5/1 at Rate Field.

MONDAY'S GAME: The Brewers were defeated by the Reds. 5-4, in Goodyear....2B Caleb Durbin went 2-for-4 with 2 runs. a HR (#2) to lead off the game and a stolen base.....3B Vinny Capra went 2-for-3 with a double, solo HR (#4), walk and a stolen base.....LHP Aaron Ashby started for Milwaukee (1ip, 2bb, 1hbp) before leaving due to an oblique injury.

THE ROSTER: The team currently has 62 players in Major League camp: 30 pitchers, 7 catchers, 14 infielders and 11 outfielders.....there are 22 non-roster invitees in camp: 8 pitchers, 4 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 outfielders.

THE NEW BREW: LHP Tyler Alexander (free agent), RHP Grant Anderson (trade with TEX), LHP Nestor Cortes (trade with NYY), INF Caleb Durbin (trade with NYY), RHP Elvin Rodríquez (free agent), LHP Connor Thomas (Rule 5 Draft from STL) and LHP Grant Wolfram (free agent).

GONE FROM 2024: SS Willy Adames (SF), RHP Kevin Herget (NYM), LHP Wade Miley (CIN), LHP Hoby Milner (TEX), RHP Frankie Montas (NYM), RHP Colin Rea (CHC), RHP Joe Ross (PHI), C Gary Sánchez (BAL), RHP Devin Williams (NYY), RHP Bryse Wilson (CWS) and LHP Rob Zastryzny (CHC).

2024 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs.....the team tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball, trailing only the Dodgers (98-64), Phillies [95-67] and Yankees (94-68).....the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 666 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY'S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS

RHP Tobias Myers, 26, made his MLB debut last season and went 9-6 with a 3.00 ERA in 27 games (25 starts) to earn Brewers Most Valuable Pitcher honors.....he had four stints with the team (4/17, 4/22-5/9, 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-end of season).....the team went 13-12 in his starts.....he produced 7 quality starts.....Myers signed with Milwaukee on 11/10/22 after pitching in the Minor Leagues with Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022) and Chicago-AL (2022)....he was originally selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Chad Patrick, 26, went 14-1 with a 2.90 ERA in 26 games (24 starts) last season at Triple-A Nashville.....he was named International League Pitcher of the Year as he led the league in wins, ERA and strikeouts (145)....he became just the third pitcher in the International League since its modern inception in 1912 to win a Triple Crown.

RHP Logan Henderson, who will turn 23 on Sunday, was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of McLennan (TX) Community College.....he has produced 233 strikeouts in just 173.2 innings over his Minor League career (12.07 K/9IP)....he was added to the 40-man roster on Nov. 19.

RHP Grant Anderson, 27, was acquired from Texas in echange for LHP Mason Molina on Jan. 2.....Anderson went 0-1 with an 8.10 ERA and 1 save in 23 relief appearances with the Rangers last season during six stints with the team..... he was on the 15-day injured list from Sept. 6 through the remainder of the season with a right ankle contusion.
