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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (0-3 at San Diego and 1-2 at the Athletics), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a loss to the White Sox last night...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three against Chicago and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, the Twins will host the Tigers for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

FRIDAY NIGHT - ALL WHITE SOX: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 7-4...Dean Kremer (2-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing six runs (5 earned) on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, including home runs from Brooks Lee (22) and Kody Clemens (22)...Walker Jenkins made his major league debut and went 1-for-3 with a walk, recording his first career hit with a fourth-inning single off Luis Castillo...Minnesota went 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base.

CENTRAL HEATING: The Twins have 27 games remaining, 14 against AL Central opponents — five vs. the White Sox, six vs. the Tigers and three vs. the Guardians...they also play the Angels (.385 win%), Giants (.407 win%) and Rangers (.489 win%)...the remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .476, the sixth-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.
✦ Twins have gone 19-19 against the AL Central this season, including a record of 11-7 at home.
✦ Kody Clemens has posted an .856 OPS vs. the AL Central this season and Royce Lewis has posted an .806 OPS.

SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Twins and White Sox are playing the ninth of 13 games this season...Twins are 3-4 vs. the Sox in 2026, going 2-2 at Target Field and 1-3 at Rate Field.
✦ Minnesota has gone 27-15 in its last 42 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023...that includes a home record of 14-7.
✦ Luke Keaschall is hitting .368 (21-for-57) with four doubles, eight walks, five stolen bases, a .456 on-base percentage and an .894 OPS in 16 career games against the Sox...he has reached base safely in all 16 games.
✦ In his last 13 games vs. the White Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with five doubles, three RBI, four walks, six runs scored and an .815 OPS.
✦ In 14 career games vs. Chicago-AL, Royce Lewis is hitting .358 (19-for-53) with seven home runs, 21 RBI, an .774 slugging percentage and a 1.234 OPS.

CLEMENS TIME: After starting August going 5-for-43 (.116) in his first 11 games of the month, Kody Clemens has hit .366 (15-for-41) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, a .585 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS...
✦ Since June 16, Clemens has 42 RBI, fourth-most in the AL since that date, trailing Junior Caminero (53), Jac Caglianone (46) and Pete Alonso (43).
✦ With today's game, it marks Clemens' 119th game of the season, tying his single-season career-high, set last season between Minnesota (112) and Philadelphia (7).

LUKE OVER HERE!: Luke Keaschall is hitting .330 (30-for-91) with a .948 OPS in his last 24 games...since being inserted into the leadoff spot on August 17, he has led off in all 10 Twins games and has hit .318 (14-for-44) with an .816 OPS, reaching base safely in nine of the 10...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

UNBE-LEE-VABLE: Over his last 17 games, Brooks Lee is hitting .313 (21-for-67) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, one walk, a .333 on-base percentage, a .642 slugging percentage and a .975 OPS...additionally, he has just 10 strikeouts in 69 plate appearances (14.5%) in that span.
✦ This season, he has already set single-season career-highs in hits (119), runs (60), doubles (21), triples (3), home runs (22), RBI (73), walks (33) and stolen bases (7).
✦ He is the only switch hitter in baseball with 20-plus doubles, 20-plus home runs and 70-plus RBI...removing the RBI, he is one of five switch hitters in baseball with 20-doubles/20-homers (Ozzie Albies, Ian Happ, Ketel Marte, Ely De La Cruz).

JOGGING OR YOGGING, IT MIGHT BE A SOFT J: Royce Lewis stole his 14th base last night, extending his single-season career-high...it marked the Twins' 20th stolen base in their last 24 chances, since July 23...since that date, their 83.3 stolen base percentage ranks first in the AL and tied for fifth-highest in baseball.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins today and tomorrow to earn their 21st series victory...they have gone 20-21-2 in series play, 13-7-1 at home and 7-14-1 on the road.
✦ Twins began the season going 8-13-1 in their first 22 series through June 11, but have gone 12-8-1 in their last 21 series overall, dating back to June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
✦ Twins last series win over the White Sox came in June, taking two of three at Target Field, from June 1-3.
✦ Twins last home series win was a three-game sweep of the Braves from August 17-19.

TOUCH' EM ALL, SMOOTH MAGIC!: KMGK 107.1 in Glenwood, Minnesota has been named the 2026 John Gordon Radio Affiliate of the Year...while KMGK 107.1 Smooth Magic is based in Glenwood, Minnesota, it serves the greater Minnewaska Area with coverage of more than 15 communities across Pope County...KMGK covers multiple sports in those communities including High School Softball and Baseball, Legion Baseball, and the Senior American Legion Tournament each summer...KMGK has been a long-time supporter of the Minnewaska Baseball Association, and their commitment to growing the game will be rewarded by the naming of the 2026 John Gordon Radio Affiliate of the Year Award...they will receive a \$5,000 Grant from the Twins Community, which will be used to make improvements to the Jeff Holtberg Acceleration Center...KMGK has been part of the Twins Radio Network since June of 1993 when Steve Nestor took over the station...representing KMGK here today for a special pregame ceremony is the Sports Director and Voice of Smooth Magic, Brady Erdmann.

TWINS SCULPTED IN BUTTER: The Twins are currently at the 2026 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...The Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (now through Monday, September 7).
✦ National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Oliva will be at the Experience on Monday, August 31 from 10:30 to 11:15 am.
