RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue an eight-game road trip over seven days against Arizona (3G) and Chicago (5G) with the second of a three-game series at Arizona. Tonight's game is the 5th of 18 over 17 consecutive days without an off-day to end the month of August (Aug. 16-31).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today on a five-game winning streak and in first place in the National League Central with a season-high 16 games over .500 and a 4.0 game lead over Milwaukee (62-55). St. Louis ranks 4th in the NL in run differential (+101) behind the Braves (+117), Mets (+122), and Dodgers (+250).

FOUR!: The Cardinals 4.0 game lead over the Milwaukee Brewers marks the first time the team has held a lead of 4.0 games or more in first place of the National League Central Division since Sept. 13, 2019. The last time the Cardinals were 5.0 games up or more was Sept. 18, 2015.

LEADING OFF WITH A BANG: Last night's win marked the Cardinals first road trip opening win this season after starting 0-8. The most recent time the Cardinals won the first game of a road trip was Sept. 20, 2021 at Milwaukee, the 9th win of a team-record 17 straight and the first of a team record eight-game road trip sweep.

MOLINA RESTRICTED; HERRERA RECALLED: The Cardinals placed catcher **Yadier Molina** on the Restricted List today and recalled rookie catcher **Iván Herrera** from Memphis (AAA) who arrived last night as part of the traveling Taxi Squad.

30 AGAIN: With a first inning home run last night, **Paul Goldschmidt** posted his 7th season with 30 or more home runs, back-to-back seasons with 30 HR and his 3rd season with the Cardinals hitting 30. The last Cardinals player to hit consecutive seasons with 30 or more home runs was **Albert Pujols** at the end of his 11 straight seasons (2001-11). Goldschmidt's seven seasons with 30 or more HR since 2013 joins **Nelson Cruz** and **Edwin Encarnacion** with the most in MLB.

YADI AND YOGI: With a three-hit night last night, **Yadier Molina** (2,152) passed **Yogi Berra** (2,150) for 5th place in hits among primary catchers. **Jason Kendall** is next up the line with 2,195 in 4th place.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: **Nolan Arenado** tied his career-high with three doubles, a feat he achieved earlier this season vs. Pittsburgh on April 9. Arenado joins **Freddie Freeman** as the only two players in MLB this season with two games with three doubles. Arenado surpassed the threshold of 30 doubles for the 8th season. He and **Paul Goldschmidt** are the only two players in MLB with 30 or more doubles in eight seasons since 2013.

AWESOME AUGUST: St. Louis .813 (13-3) winning percentage in the month of August ranks 2nd-best in Major League Baseball behind the Los Angeles Dodgers (14-3, .824). The .813 winning percentage in August is the franchise's second best August monthly mark since the 1944 Cardinals (23-4, .852).

SOUTHPAW SMACKERS: The St. Louis Cardinals have had a lot of success against left-handed pitchers this season with an 18-9 record. They rank 2nd in slugging (.459), 1st in on-base percentage (.346) and 3rd in batting (.269) in MLB. **Paul Goldschmidt** is leading MLB batting a blistering .438 vs. LHP, the 7th-best single season mark in Cardinals history, while **Albert Pujols** ranks 4th at .358 and **Dylan Carlson** is T14th at .323.

FLAWLESS FLYERS: The Cardinals have not committed an error in seven straight games and completed their first flawless homestand of six games or more since August 1-7, 2008 vs. Philadelphia and Los Angeles (NL).

WHACKING DAY: Since Arizona joined MLB as an expansion team in 1998, the Cardinals .616 winning percentage (101-63) against the Diamondbacks is the highest in MLB among National League and common interleague opponents ... Arizona's .384 winning pct. vs. the Cardinals is also their worst against any annual opponent.

HOMECOMING PHOENECIAN: Cardinals rookie infielder **Nolan Gorman** will be playing his first Major League games in his home city of Phoenix. The Arizona native attended Sandra Day O'Connor High School where he batted .419 with 32 HR and 118 RBI over his high school career leading the school to a 6A State Championship in 2018.

START ME UP: Cardinals starting pitchers have limited their opposition to two runs or fewer in nine straight starts (Aug. 10-present) with a 7-2 mark and 1.66 ERA, longest streak of 2 runs or fewer since a nine-game stretch from Sept. 2-11, 2019 (non-COVID 2020 season).

ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Paul Goldschmidt was selected by Arizona in the in the 8th round of the 2009 MLB Draft...played eight seasons with Arizona (2011-18), hitting .297/.398/.532 with 209 home runs and 710 RBI...selected to six All-Star squads (2013-18)... won four Silver Sluggers (2013, '15, '17-18) and three Gold Gloves (2013, '15, '17)...acquired by St. Louis from Arizona for **Carson Kelly**, **Luke Weaver**, **Andrew Young**, and the 2019 Cardinals Compensation Round B selection (Dec. 5, 2018).

Nolan Arenado made his MLB debut vs. the Dbacks (April 28, 2013 at Arizona)...Signed his letter of intent to play college baseball at Arizona State University before drafted by the Rockies.

Nolan Gorman was born in Phoenix and attended and played high school baseball at Sandra Day O'Connor High School in Glendale.

JoJo Romero played college baseball at nearby Yavapai College in Prescott, Ariz.

Ian Kennedy was originally selected by St. Louis in the 14th round of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend USC.

Carson Kelly played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18)...originally selected by the Cardinals as a third baseman in the 2nd round of the 2012 MLB Draft...2016 Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year...younger brother, **Parker Kelly**, pitched in the Cards organization (2018-19).

Turner Ward played two seasons (1999-2000) and spent eight years coaching in the Dbacks organization, serving as AA-Mobile Hitting Coach (2008-10) and Manager (2011-12), and Arizona Asst. Hitting Coach (2013) Hitting Coach (2014-15)... Ward's Mobile teams won Southern League championships in 2011 and 2012...named SL Manager of the Year in 2011...Turner's son, **Tucker Ward**, was selected by Arizona in the 40th round of the 2015 MLB Draft draft and pitched three seasons in the Arizona organization (2015-17).

Cardinals President of Operations **John Mozeliak** attended the University of Arizona before graduating from the University of Colorado at Boulder.

Zac Gallen was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft...pitched two seasons in Cardinals minor league organization before traded to Miami as part of the package to acquire **Marcell Ozuna** (Dec. 14, 2017).

Diamondbacks Pitching Coach **Brent Strom** spent six seasons (2008-13) with the Cardinals organization as minor league pitching instructor (2008-11) and pitching coordinator (2012-13).

Diamondbacks First Base Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for the Cardinals for 16 seasons (1996-2011).

Diamondbacks Hitting Coach **Joe Mather** was selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB Draft...played parts of two years with St. Louis (2008, '10).

- NL Ranks:** Ground Balls induced (181, T12th), walks (50, 2nd), GDP/9 IP (1.64, 1st*), Ground Into Double Plays (20, 2nd)
- Tonight start marks his 22nd of the season (63rd career) and 91st career appearance. Also marks his 4th start since coming off the 15-day I.L. (neck strain).
 - Is 3-1 with 2.62 ERA in his six starts vs. NL West clubs this season, posting 1.17 WHIP.
 - Ranks 3rd on the Cardinals in starts (21), innings pitched (110.0) and 5th in strikeouts (62). His six wins are 4th-most on team.
 - Shares Major League Baseball lead in grounded into double plays (20) with Logan Webb and would lead in GDP/9 IP (1.64) but does not meet innings qualifications. Has induced a double play in nine of his last 11 starts (13 total).
 - Trying to avoid three consecutive losses for the first time in his professional or college career. Has not lost three straight decisions dating back through his freshman year at Mississippi State (2014).
 - The Cardinals went 0-4 in his four July starts, and are just 3-8 in his last 11 overall starts since June 7.
 - Received one run or fewer in four of his last six starts (July 4-present). He was ranked 6th in MLB in Run Support Avg (6.30) from the start of the season through the end of June, receiving 5+ runs of support four times.
 - Missed two weeks while on the 15-day I.L. (neck strain) from July 15-29. Made one rehab start at Memphis (AAA) vs. Gwinnett on July 24.
 - Has allowed just four home runs in his last 14 starts. Had a career-best 46.1 homerless innings streak from 5/8-6/23. It was the longest Cardinals homerless streak since Trevor Rosenthal (54.0 IP in 2015).
 - Allowed his 3rd HR at Busch Stadium snapping a streak of 48.2 IP without one, when he surrendered one against Gavin Lux on 7/14 vs. LAD. Was his first longball allowed at STL since a pair in the 2nd inning of his 2022 season debut vs. KC (4/12).
 - The Cardinals are 25-13 (.658) in his starts during which he does not allow a home run.
 - Averaging 4.6 inches of vertical movement on his sinker, ranking 14th among MLB pitchers (1st - Logan Webb, SF, 8.9").
 - Holds a career .762 winning pct.(16-5) at Busch Stadium, 2nd best in Busch III history and 5th-best home winning pct. by a Cardinal at a home stadium behind Howie Krist (.833, 20-4), Mark Petkovsek (.818, 18-4), John Tudor (.814, 35-8) & John Lackey (14-4, .778).
 - St. Louis is 23-9 (.719 win pct.) in his 32 career starts at Busch Stadium, winning 16 of the last 22.

LAST TIME OUT

- Came away with a no-decision in road series final at Colorado on 8/11, allowing a pair of runs on four hits and four walks over 5.0 innings. Exited with the game tied at 2-2 before the Rockies played six runs in the 7th inning.
