**AT A GLANCE:** The Yankees continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the third game of a four-game set vs. Toronto (2-0 thus far)...will also face Tampa Bay in a three-game set this weekend (Fri.-Sun.).

- ▶ **Their 30-19 (.612) record is the second-best in the American League and tied with Los Angeles-NL (30-19, .612) for the third-best record in the Majors**, trailing only Tampa Bay (32-15, .681) and Atlanta (33-16, .673).
- ▶ **Are 20-10 in their last 30 games (since 4/17), 21-11 in their last 32 games (since 4/15) and 22-12 in their last 34 games (since 4/13).**
- ▶ **Are in a stretch of playing 26 games in 27 days (5/1-27).**
- ▶ **Are 10-5 vs. the AL East this year.**
- ▶ **Are 2-0 in their current four-game series vs. the Blue Jays**, guaranteeing at least a series split...snaps a three-series losing streak...including this series, have won or split eight of their last 11 series and 11 of their 16 series this season.
- ▶ **The Yankees' +70 run differential this season is the best in the AL and tied for the third-best in the Majors.**

**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Yankees improved to 2-0 on the homestand after defeating the Blue Jays, 5-4, on Tuesday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Will Warren** (5.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 3K, 0HR) started and earned his sixth win of the season...**3B Ryan McMahon** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI, 1SB) hit his fourth home run of the year with a game-tying three-run shot in the fourth inning, snapping an 0-for-24 stretch...**1B Ben Rice** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his 16th home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the fifth inning...**LF Cody Bellinger** (1-for-3, 1BB) and **CF Trent Grisham** (1-for-3, 1R, 1BB) each reached base twice...**LHP Tim Hill** (1.0IP, 1BB, 1K) tossed a scoreless sixth inning...**RHP Jake Bird** (0.2IP, 1K, 1HP) retired 2-of-3BF...**LHP Brent Headrick** (1.1IP, 1H, 2K) tossed 1.1 scoreless innings of relief...**RHP Camilo Doval** (1.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB) earned his first save of the season and second as a Yankee (also 8/30/25 at Chicago-AL).

**RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice** hit his 16th home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the fifth inning on Tuesday vs. Toronto...his 11 go-ahead RBI are tied for the second-most in the Majors this season (first in AL)...**seven of his 16HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including four of his last 5HR and five of his last 7HR.**

- ▶ **Has hit 3HR in his last five games (since 5/15), 4HR in his last eight games (since 5/11), 6HR in his last 14 games (since 5/1), 8HR in his last 20 games (since 4/24) and 12HR in his last 27 games (since 4/16).**
- ▶ **Has hit .297/.397/.671 (46-for-155) with 36R, 10 doubles, 16HR, 33RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 44 games this season...has reached base safely in 34-of-40 starts.**
- ▶ **26 of his 46H this season have been XBH (10 doubles, 16HR).**
- ▶ **Has hit 8HR in his last 17G vs. AL East opponents (since 9/21/25).**

**McMAHON OF THE HOUR: INF Ryan McMahon** hit his fourth home run of the year with a game-tying three-run shot in the fourth inning on Tuesday vs. Toronto...his HR snapped an 0-for-24 stretch...three of his 4HR this year have either tied the game (two) or gave the Yankees the lead (one)...his 3RBI were a season high and his most since 9/4/25 at Houston (also 3RBI).

**DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (16HR) are only the second pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 16HR in the club's first 49 games of a season**, joining Yogi Berra (16HR) and Mickey Mantle (21HR) in 1956...**are the only pair of Major League teammates in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) to accomplish the feat** and first since St. Louis' J.D. Drew (17HR) and Albert Pujols (16HR) in 2001.

**ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** is batting .455/.538/.727 (10-for-22) with 5R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 4BB and 1SB over his last six games (since 5/13).

- ▶ **His 12SB are tied for the fifth-most in the AL and tied for the eighth-most in the Majors this year.**
- ▶ **GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt** has hit .370/.463/.739 (17-for-46) with 10R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 10RBI, 6BB and 2HP over his last 15 games (since 4/26).
- ▶ **Has hit 3HR in his last four starts (since 5/9) and 4HR in his last seven starts (since 5/5).**
- ▶ **Has hit .600/.765/1.100 (6-for-10) with 2 doubles, 1HR, 9RBI, 5BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .336/.434/.454 (40-for-119) with 8 doubles, 2HR, 43RBI, 19BB/5IBB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.**

**HIGH VOLTAGE: INF Anthony Volpe** has reached base in 12-of-24 PA over his first six games, batting .294/.500/.412 (5-for-17) with 2R, 2 doubles, 3RBI, 7BB and 2SB.

**SCHLITTT'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlichter** will make his 11th start of the season tonight...**has gone 6-1 with a 1.35 ERA (60.0IP, 9ER) and 68K in 10 starts this season, holding opponents to a .168/.209/.234 (36-for-214) slash line**...has allowed only 2HR to 226BF this season.

▶ **Is the only pitcher in franchise history to post a sub-1.40 ERA and record at least 65K through their first 10 starts of a season.**

▶ **His 1.35 ERA is tied with Jack Quinn's 1.35 ERA in 1919 for the fifth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first 10 starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Phil Niekro (1.20 ERA in first 10GS in 1984), Max Fried (1.29 ERA in first 10GS in 2025), Allie Reynolds (1.31 ERA in first 10GS in 1952) and Rob Gardner (1.32 ERA in first 10GS in 1972).

▶ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in each of his last six starts (since 4/17), going 4-0 with a 0.70 ERA (38.1IP, 3ER) and 38K over that span...his six-start streak of 1ER-or-fewer matches the sixth-longest by a Yankees starter in franchise history** (excluding openers), trailing only Whitey Ford (9GS from 8/24-9/28/63), Spud Chandler (8GS from 9/29/45-5/19/46-G1), Luis Gil (7GS from 5/1-6/4/24), Michael King (7GS from 8/24-9/26/23) and Steve Kline (7GS from 7/18-8/14/72).

▶ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in a Major League-leading eight starts this season.**

▶ **The Yankees are 8-2 in his starts...his eight team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season (tied for first in AL).**

▶ **Over his last 18 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 9-2 with a 1.74 ERA (103.1IP, 63H, 22R/20ER, 28BB, 122K, 4HR)...the Yankees are 15-3 in those starts...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 11 of those starts.**

▶ **According to Elias, his 2.23 ERA is the second-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 24 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Hank Thormahlen's 2.14 ERA in his first 24 career starts from 1917-19...**marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 24 career appearances were all starts.**

**ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge** has reached base in 40 of his last 43 games (since 4/3), batting .283/.426/.612 (43-for-152) with 38R, 8 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 36BB/5IBB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.

▶ **24 of his 46H this season have been XBH (8 doubles, 16HR).**

▶ **Has hit .321/.525/.750 (9-for-28) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/5IBB and 1HP with RISP this season.**

▶ **His 41HR vs. the Blue Jays are the most by a Yankee against Toronto in franchise history...also marks the second-most HR by any player vs. a single opponent since 2017, trailing only his own 53HR vs. Baltimore...has hit 6HR in his last 19 games (since 6/30/24) against Toronto and 13HR in his last 37 games vs. Toronto (since 5/15/23).**

**SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger** reached base twice on Tuesday vs. Toronto...**has hit safely in each of his last 15 home games (since 4/13), batting .455/.537/.945 (25-for-55) with 13R, 8 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 20RBI, 11BB, 15B and 15F over that span**...is the longest home hitting streak by a Yankee since Anthony Volpe's 15-game home hitting streak from 5/7-6/8/24.

▶ **Has hit safely in 19-of-21 home games this year, batting .382/.479/.789 (29-for-76) with 17R, 9 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 24RBI, 16BB, 2SF and 1SB.**

▶ **Has hit .341/.412/.537 (14-for-41) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 20RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this season.**

▶ **According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (nine)...is tied for seventh in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (nine, tied for fourth in AL).**

**HOME SWEET HOME: The Yankees have gone 11-1 in their last 12 home games (since 4/17)**...have gone 16-6 (.727) at home this season, the second-best home record in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay (18-5, .783).

**FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners** have recorded 48 stolen bases this year, their most through their first 49 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 56SB in 2001.

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP CAM SCHLITTLER (6-1, 1.35 ERA)

**RHP Cam Schlittler** will make his 11th start of the season tonight vs. Toronto...the 25-year-old will pitch on regular four days' rest...made his 10th start of the season on Friday at the Mets, earning his sixth win of the season after allowing 1R/ER over 6.2IP (2H, 2BB, 9K, 1HR)...has gone 6-1 with a 1.35 ERA (60.0IP, 36H, 11R/9ER, 11BB, 68K, 2HR) in 10 starts this season...has also allowed 1ER-or-fewer in eight of his starts, including each of his last six starts (since 4/17)...has allowed only 2HR to 226BF this season...made his first career Opening Day roster...**over his last 18 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 9-2 with a 1.74 ERA (103.1IP, 63H, 22R/20ER, 28BB, 122K, 4HR)**...saw his first Major League action in 2025 with the Yankees, going 4-3 with a 2.96 ERA (73.0IP, 58H, 24R/ER, 31BB, 84K, 8HR) in 14 starts...in 24 career Major League starts, has gone 10-4 with a 2.23 ERA (133.0IP, 94H, 35R/33ER, 42BB, 152K, 10HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 22-of-24 career starts, 2R-or-fewer in 18 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 14 starts...according to *Elias*, **his 2.23 ERA is the second-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 24 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Hank Thormahlen's 2.14 ERA in his first 24 career starts from 1917-19...**marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 24 career appearances were all starts...his 152K through his first 24 career games are the second-most in franchise history**, trailing only Masahiro Tanaka (165K)...**his 35R allowed are the fewest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 24 career starts...has posted a .195 opponents' BA over his first 24 career starts...according to *Elias*, marks the fifth-lowest opponents' BA by a Yankees pitcher through their first 24 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Luis Gil (.176), Tommy Byrne (.181), Al Downing (.182) and Russ Ford (.188)...the Weymouth, Mass., native was selected by the Yankees in the seventh round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University (Mass.).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his 10th start of the season on Friday at the Mets, earning his sixth win of the season after allowing 1R/ER over 6.2IP (2H, 2BB, 9K, 1HR)...allowing his only run on a solo home run to Juan Soto in the seventh inning...marked only his second homer allowed this season...his 106 pitches marked a career high...his 9K matched a regular season career high (also 9K on 9/27/25 vs. Baltimore).

**2026:** In 10 starts this season, has gone 6-1 with a 1.35 ERA (60.0IP, 36H, 11R/9ER, 11BB, 68K, 2HR)...has held opponents to a .168/.209/.234 (36-for-214) slash line...**see Major League rankings at right.**

- ★ **His 1.35 ERA is tied with Jack Quinn's 1.35 ERA in 1919 for the fifth-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first 10 starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Phil Niekro (1.20 ERA in first 10GS in 1984), Max Fried (1.29 ERA in first 10GS in 2025), Allie Reynolds (1.31 ERA in first 10GS in 1952) and Rob Gardner (1.32 ERA in first 10GS in 1972).
- ★ **Is the only pitcher in franchise history to post a sub-1.40 ERA and record at least 65K through their first 10 starts of a season.**
- ★ **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in all 10 starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in seven starts (including four scoreless starts)**...his 10 starts of 3R-or-fewer are tied for the most in the Majors (first in AL)...is the first Yankees pitcher to have a season-opening streak of 3R-or-fewer through their first 10 starts of a season since Clarke Schmidt's franchise-record-tying 15-start streak to begin the 2024 season...along with Schlittler's nine-start streak to begin the 2025 season, is only the second pitcher in franchise history to allow 3R-or-fewer in at least nine starts to begin a season multiple times, joining Jim Bouton (2x: first 12GS in 1966 and first 10GS in '63).
- ★ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in eight of his starts this season, including each of his last six starts (since 4/17)**...his eight starts of 1ER-or-fewer are the most in the Majors...**is one of just three Yankees starters (not including openers) in the last 29 seasons (since 1998) to allow 1ER-or-fewer in at least six straight starts in a single season**, joining Luis Gil (7GS from 5/1-6/4/24) and Michael King (7GS from 8/24-9/26/23)...**his six-start streak of 1ER-or-fewer matches the sixth-longest by a Yankees starter in franchise history** (not including openers), trailing only Whitey Ford (9GS from 8/24-9/28/63), Spud Chandler (8GS from 9/29/45-5/19/46-G1), Gil, King and Steve Kline (7GS from 7/18-8/14/72).
- ★ **Has allowed only 2HR to 226BF this season**...is only the fourth Yankees starting pitcher (not including openers) to allow two-or-fewer home runs over his first 10 starts of a season in the last 18 years (since 2009), joining Max Fried (1HR this season in first 10GS), Luis Severino (2HR in first 10GS in 2018) and CC Sabathia (2HR in first 10GS in 2016).
- ★ Has recorded at least 7K in six of his starts, including 8K in four starts...his four starts with at least 8K are tied for the fourth-most in the Majors (tied for second in AL).
- ★ Has allowed 4H-or-fewer in seven of his starts, tied for the third-most in the Majors (tied for first in AL).
- ★ The Yankees are 8-2 in his starts...his eight team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season (tied for first in AL).
- ★ Has tossed at least 6.0IP in six of his last nine starts (since 4/1), including five of his last six starts (since 4/17).

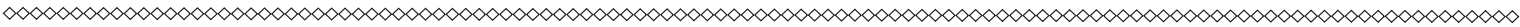
