THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
SEPT. 5
1971 - The late RHP J.R. Richard records 15 strikeouts in his Major League debut, which is a franchise record and ties an MLB record for a players debut...he makes this debut in the second game of a doubleheader in San Francisco, which ends as an Astros 5-3 win.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros will play the middle game of their three-game series with the Diamondbacks tonight in a nationally televised game at Daikin Park...rookie **RHP Ethan Pecko** (1-0) will get the start for the Astros, the fourth of his Major League career, opposite **RHP Brandon Pfaadt** (7-2) and the Snakes.

TONIGHT'S BROADCASTS: Tonight's game will be nationally televised by FOX with **Wayne Randazzo** and **John Smoltz** on the call...for tonight's game only, the English radio broadcast will be on KTRH 740 AM with **Robert Ford** and **Josh Reddick** behind the mic...as always, the Astros Spanish radio broadcast features **Francisco Romero** and **Alex Treviño** on TUDN 102.9 FM.

SLOW AND STEADY RECOVERY: Since starting the season with a 20-31 record after 51 games, the Astros are 53-38 (.582) in their last 91 games (since May 22)...that is the second-best record in the AL in that span, behind the Red Sox (55-38).

ABOUT THE RECORD: At 73-69, the Astros are a season-high four games over .500 and have tied their season-high with a 3.0-game division lead...the Astros are 8-3 over their last 11 games.

YOUNG ETHAN: **RHP Ethan Pecko**, 24, is coming off his first Major League win, which he earned on Aug. 30 at NYY (2ER/5IP)...Pecko, the Astros #3 pitching prospect per MLB.com, combined to post a 4.57 ERA (42ER/82.2IP) with 86 strikeouts in 20 games (18 starts) in the minors this season, including 17 games at Triple A...he was originally a sixth-round pick by the Astros in 2023.

STARTING BLOCKS: Astros starters have a 1.69 ERA (5ER/26.2IP) with 29 strikeouts, a .151 opponent average (14x93) and a 1.09 WHIP in the first five games of this homestand...stretching back over the Astros last 11 games, in which they've gone 8-3, Astros starters own a 2.83 ERA (17ER/54IP).

MEASURING UP: The Astros are within a streak of playing four straight teams with winning records (CWS, ARI, PHI, TB)...the Astros are an American League-best 32-21 (.604) vs. teams currently at .500 or above...some clubs that the Astros have winning records against include BOS (5-1), CHC (3-0), CWS (5-2), CLE (4-2), MIA (3-0), and TB (2-1).

VS. THE D-BACKS: The Astros have won nine of their last 10 games against the Diamondbacks, a streak that dates back to Sept. 29, 2023...this run includes a three-game sweep of the D-backs in Arizona last season from July 21-23, 2025.

FRIDAY NIGHT FIREWORKS: The Astros opened their weekend series with the D-backs last night with a 3-1 win...**RHP Cristian Javier** (1ER/5IP) fanned eight in his start en route to his second win of the season...the Astros scored all three of their runs in the 3rd inning, a rally that started on a solo homer by **C Yainer Díaz** (2x3, HR, RBI)...**LHP Josh Hader** (0ER/1IP) struck out the side in the 9th for his 23rd save of the season and the 250th of his career.

RELIEVER OF THE MONTH: Announced earlier this week, **LHP Josh Hader** was named the AL Reliever of the Month for August...it is Hader's ninth career Reliever of the Month Award and his third as an Astro...in the month, Hader converted all seven of his save opportunities, while going scoreless in his 13 total appearances and 14.1 innings pitched.

STREAKING: **LHP Josh Hader** has worked 20 consecutive scoreless appearances, spanning 21.0 innings (since July 21)...this is the longest streak by an Astros hurler this season and the second-longest active streak in the Majors...opponents are just 5x68 (.074) vs. Hader during the streak.

THE CLOSER: **LHP Josh Hader** recorded his 250th career save last night, becoming the 41st player in modern MLB history to reach 250 career saves...Hader has 23 of those saves this season, in 23 save chances, giving him the most save chances in the Majors this season without a blown save.

YOU'RE MY BOY BLU!: **RHP A.J. Blubaugh**, who's tossed 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings, has taken a huge Major League lead in innings pitched as a reliever with 86.1, far ahead of second-place **RHP Adrian Morejon** (75.2IP) and **LHP Aaron Ashby** (75.2IP)...the Astros have not had a reliever lead the Majors in innings pitched since **RHP Doug Jones** (111.2IP) in 1992.

TRIPLE THREAT: **DH Yordan Alvarez**, who is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award, currently owns at least a share of the lead in all three **Triple Crown** categories...he enters tonight leading the AL in batting avg. (.317), while ranking tied for first in HR (37) and RBI (94)...**Rare Feat:** Since **Carl Yastrzemski** won the AL Triple Crown in 1967, there has been just one Triple Crown winner in the Majors, **Miguel Cabrera** in 2012 (AL).

THE HIT MAN: **2B Jose Altuve** has 2,495 career hits, needing just five hits to reach 2,500 for his career...among active players, Altuve ranks second in hits, trailing only **1B Freddie Freeman** (2,586).

OUCH!: **3B Isaac Paredes** was hit by a pitch for the 18th time of the season last night, which ranks sixth in the Majors...hit 18 HBP are the most by an Astro in a single season since **2B Craig Biggio** recorded 27 HBP in 2003.

BEHIND THE DISH: **C Christian Vázquez** has played in 999 career games as a catcher and is looking to become just the third active catcher to reach 1,000 career games behind the dish...he would join **C Salvador Perez** (1,427) and **C J.T. Realmuto** (1,382) in that exclusive group.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Astros prospect **OF Caden Powell** went 3x5 with two homers and five RBI for Class A Asheville in their 10-6 win over Greensboro last night...Powell, the Astros sixth-round pick in the 2024 draft, is having a strong minor league season, hitting .279 (114x408) with 18 doubles, 18 homers, 69 RBI, 30 stolen bases and an .823 OPS in 105 games for the Tourists.

LAST START, AUG. 30 at NYM: Allowed 3 runs (2 ER) on 3 hits and 2 walks with 4 strikeouts in a career-high 5.0 innings...earned his first Major League win...after he allowed a hit to his first three batters of the game (Lindor HR, Soto HR, Bichette single), did not allow a hit to his final 16 batters faced.

ABOUT PECKO: The rookie Pecko has made 3 Major League starts since being selected to the Major League roster on Aug. 19...currently ranks the Astros No. 3 pitching prospect and the No. 9 overall prospect in the Astros system by MLB.com.

HIS DEBUT: Made his MLB debut on Aug. 19 vs. LAA, allowed 2 runs on 3 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts through 3.2 innings of work vs. the Angels at Daikin Park...recorded his 1st career strikeout against **IF Vaughn Grissom** in the 2nd inning...was scoreless through his first 3.0 innings of the night before allowing a 2-run double to **IF Denzer Guzman** with 1 out in the 4th inning.

2026 MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: In minor league action this season, has made 20 appearances, including 18 starts between the FCL Astros (3g) and Triple A Sugar Land (17g)...combined to record a 4.57 ERA (42ER/82.2IP) with 86 strikeouts, a 1.33 WHIP and a .259 opponent batting average.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Named the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Month for June...for the month he recorded a 2.48 ERA (8ER/29IP) with 29 strikeouts, 6 walks, a 0.93 WHIP and a .206 opponent batting average...tied for the PCL lead in innings for the month and led all qualified pitchers in ERA, WHIP and opponent batting average...has also earned a few other accolades in his minor league career including, All-Spring Breakout Second Team in 2025 and the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month in May of 2024.

STELLAR START: On June 11 vs. Sacramento, he allowed 2 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless innings...also earned the win after the Space Cowboys defeated the River Cats, 2-0 at Constellation Field...prior to this start, he hadn't pitched more than 6.0 innings in a game in his professional career.

PECKO'S CAREER: Has pitched in parts of 4 minor league seasons in the Astros organization (2023-26), recording a 4.08 ERA (124ER/273.2IP) with 323 strikeouts, a 1.28 WHIP and a .241 opponent batting average in 72 minor league appearances, including 55 starts...was named the Astros 2024 Minor League Pitcher of the Year...for the 2024 season, he went 4-6 with a 3.47 ERA (37ER/96IP) in 26 appearances, including 15 starts between Low A Fayetteville, High A Asheville and Double A Corpus Christi...he also recorded 125 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP and a .219 opponent batting average.

COLLEGE: In 2023 at Towson, he went 2-2 with a 3.21 ERA and 48 strikeouts across 42.0 innings as the Saturday starter...transferred to Towson in 2022 after redshirting his freshman year at La Salle University due to undergoing Tommy John Surgery...was forced to transfer after La Salle discontinued their baseball program.

LAST APPEARANCE (9/4 vs. ARI): Walked 1 in 1.1 scoreless innings last night vs. ARI...stranded both of his inherited runners...was his 9th multi-inning appearance of the year (last, Aug. 28 at NYM).

ABREU OF LATE: Has recorded 5 consecutive scoreless outings (5.1 IP since Aug. 28 at NYM)...has also been scoreless in 9 of his last 10 apps. (since Aug. 16 vs. SEA), posting a 0.82 ERA (1ER/11IP) with 12 strikeouts and a .143 opponent batting average in that span.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 5-1-7 with a 1.97 ERA (10ER/45.2IP)...also has recorded 53 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .164 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...his .168 opponent average since May 3 ranks 3rd among AL relievers (min. 40 IP).

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 97th percentile in whiff percentage (34.7%), 91st percentalie in xBA (.199) and 89th percentile in strikeout rate (29.2%) among MLB players, per Baseball Savant.

A CUT ABOVE: Began throwing a cutter this season in his outing on June 2 vs. PIT and has tossed the pitch at a 10.2 percent rate on the season...has held opponents to a .111 batting average (2x18) vs. his cutter this year.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started the 2nd game of this current homestand on Tuesday vs. CWS and worked around 3 walks to toss 4.0 scoreless innings on 3 hits with 3 strikeouts...marked his 1st Major League appearance since Aug. 15 vs. SEA...notched his 1st scoreless start of the season (last, May 11, 2025 vs. CIN).

ROSTER MOVE: Was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land on Tuesday as part of September roster expansion...marks his 2nd stint with the Astros this season.

THE WAY BACK: Missed a majority of the 2026 season after undergoing right elbow surgery in June of 2025...was reinstated from the Injured List on July 20 and made 5 appearances, including 4 starts for the Astros before being optioned to Triple A Sugar Land on Aug. 16.

SEASON DEBUT: Made his first Major League start in over a year on July 20 vs. MIA...tossed 4.2 innings in his return, allowing 4 runs on 2 hits and 3 walks...tossed 86 pitches, including 58 strikes...struck out 8 hitters in the outing...marked his first big league start since May 17, 2025 at TEX.

THE BREAKOUT: Spent most of his minor league and Major League career as a reliever entering 2024, but worked that entire season out of the Astros rotation (outside of 1 relief app.) and was one of the AL's top starters...among qualifying AL starters, he ranked 1st in opponent batting average (.190), 1st in H/9 (6.13) and 2nd in ERA (2.80)...also threw the 17th no-hitter in Astros franchise history in his season debut on April 1, 2024 vs. TOR...was named the 2024 Astros Pitcher of the Year by the Houston chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.
