**NATIONALS HISTORY**  
**APRIL 11 (5-10)**  
2010 - A **Josh Willingham** grand slam in the top of the first is all of the offense the Nationals needed to top the Mets, 5-2 at Citi Field. Willingham also doubled and drove in a run in the third inning, finishing the day with five RBI. **Livan Hernandez** earned the win, tossing 7.0 innings of five-hit, shutout ball.

## MILWAUKEE'S BEST

The Washington Nationals bested the Milwaukee Brewers, 7-3, thanks to a four-run ninth inning that propelled them to the series-opening victory...**James Wood** (4-for-5, 2 2B, RBI, R) and **CJ Abrams** (2-for-3, 2B, RBI, R) recorded multi-hit efforts, while Washington's bullpen combined on 4.0 innings of two-hit, shutout ball with two strikeouts and no walks.

- The win snapped Washington's six-game losing streak at the hands of Milwaukee.
- With one more win this weekend, the Nationals would secure their second road series win of the season, their first series win over Milwaukee since Aug 2-4, 2024 in D.C. and first road series win over the Brewers since July 12-14, 2024.
- Friday night's game began a stretch of 17 games for the Nationals without a day off...Washington's next off day is April 27 in New York.

## GOOD WOOD

**James Wood** is 11-for-20 (.550) with two doubles, three homers, eight RBI, four walks, just three strikeouts, one stolen base and eight runs scored over his last five games...His four-game multi-hit streak is tied for a career-long (8/9-12/2025) and is tied for the longest active streak in baseball.

- Wood is the only player in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball (has 2) of at least 116.0 MPH... He's also the only player with more than two batted balls (has 3) of at least 115.0 MPH.
- His 19 batted balls over 100 MPH are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with **Bobby Witt Jr.**
- Since the start of last season, his 13 home runs against left-handed pitching ranks third among left-handed batters, trailing **Kyle Schwarber** (23) and **Shohei Ohtani** (15).
- Nine of his 15 hits this year have gone for extra bases (5 2B, 4 HR).

## PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals have scored 78 runs, the second-most by any Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 13 games, behind the 2019 Nationals who scored 80 runs through their first 13 contests.

- Washington has scored 15 runs in the first inning, tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Philadelphia.
- The Nationals have scored at least five runs in 10 games this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

## A FOR ABRAMS

**CJ Abrams** has reached base safely in 11 of 12 games this season and hit safely in nine of his last 10...He is 13-for-38 (.342) with a double, four homers, 13 RBI, six walks, four stolen bases and nine runs during the 10-game stretch.

- Abrams has improved his walk rate this season...He has a 11.3% BB (6 BB in 53 PA) in 2026, compared to a 5.8% BB (37 BB in 635 PA) in 2025.

## TOUGH TO HIT

Two of Washington's relievers have been especially tough to record hits off of so far this season:

- Clayton Beeter** has allowed just two hits in 21 at-bats against him through six outings...The .095 opponents' average is good for seventh in Major League Baseball (min. 25 batters faced)...Opposing left-handed batters are 0-for-11 against Beeter.
- Opposing batters are hitting .195 (5-for-27) against **PJ Poulin**...Left-handed batters are 1-for-11 (.091) against him.

## DAYLEN'S DAYS

**Daylen Lile's** 15 hits are tied for ninth-most in the National League...He has hit safely in 10 of the first 13 games and has reached safely in 11 of the 13.

- Since June 21, 2025, he ranks fourth among all hitters with a .313 batting average.
- The reigning National League Player and Rookie of the Month, Lile paced the National League in OPS (1.212), slugging percentage (.772), batting average (.391) and triples (7) during September 2025.

## OUR HOUSE

**Brady House** leads the Nationals and is tied for sixth in the National League with five multi-hit games this season.

- House has hit safely in six of 11 starts, going 13-for-46 (.283) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, five walks, seven runs scored, a .353 on-base percentage and a .478 slugging percentage in those 11 starts.
- He has five walks in 52 plate appearances (9.6% BB) through 13 games...He had eight walks in 274 plate appearances (2.9% BB) in 73 games in 2025.

## BLAKE BUTERA

**Blake Butera** was named Washington's eighth field manager on October 31, 2025 after spending the previous two seasons as the senior director of player development for the Tampa Bay Rays...He served as the Rays' Minor League field coordinator in 2023 following four seasons (2018-19, 2021-22) as a manager in their Minor League system.

- At Single-A Charleston, Butera was named Carolina League Manager of the Year in 2021 and 2022, won the Carolina League championship both seasons and the 2022 club was named Minor League Team of the Year by *Baseball America*.
- He began his coaching career with the Rays organization in 2017 as the bench coach for Single-A Hudson Valley and was promoted to manager in 2018, becoming the youngest manager in all of Minor League Baseball at the age of 25.
