WHAT'S BREWING?

Papa Murphy

Pat Murphy is looking for his 200th victory as Brewers manager today.... since 2024 - his first season with the team - Murphy (199) is tied with the Phillies' **Rob Thomson** for second in the majors in managerial wins, trailing the Dodgers' **Dave Roberts** (205).

Back in the Win Column

The Brewers last night snapped a 6-game losing streak....it marked the team's longest streak since losing six in a row from 6/8-6/14, 2023.

One and Done

The Brewers picked up their first 1-run win of the season last night in their 17th game....it marked their most games to begin a season without a 1-run win since 2005 (21st game).

They're Out of Our League

The Brewers are 111-63 (.638) since 2022 during Interleague Play, which marks the best record in the majors.... the team has gone 9-5 (.643) against American League opponents in 2026.

Line 'Em Up

Through 17 games, the Brewers have used 17 different lineups.

And the Winner Is...

Aaron Ashby last night earned his fourth win of the season....he is tied with Angels starter **José Soriano** for the Major League lead in wins.

Up for the Challenge

Gary Sánchez last night notched his seventh ABS challenge of the season as a hitter (3-for-7)....the rest of the team's hitters have combined for six challenges (2-for-6).

William the Conqueror

William Contreras enters the day on a 10-game hitting streak, the longest streak by a Brewer this season.... Contreras is batting .350 (14-for-40) with 1 HR and 6 RBI during the streak with a .435 OBP/.475 SLG/.910 OPS.

The Brice Is Right

Brice Turang has reached base safely in all 15 of his games this season, batting .304 (17-for-56, 3hr, 11rbi) with a .435 OBP/.571 SLG/1.006 OPS.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: **OF Akil Baddoo** (left quad), **OF Jackson Chourio** (left hand), **LHP Jared Koenig** (left elbow), **RHP Quinn Priester** (right thoracic outlet), **1B Andrew Vaughn** (left hand), **OF Christian Yelich** (left groin), **RHP Craig Yoho** (right calf) and **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (left shoulder) are currently on the injured list....Baddoo and Zastryzny are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** (341g, 199-142, .584) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (21 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 16, **SECOND:** 0, **THIRD:** 3, **FOURTH:** 2, **FIFTH:** 0....the Brewers are currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Pirates and Reds by 1.5 games.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 6-5 at home, going 2-1-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 3-3 on the road, going 1-1-0 in series play.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made eight replay challenges this season, going 6-2....their last challenge (lost) came on 4/14 vs. Toronto as a safe call at third base involving Lenyn Sosa on a throw by Garrett Mitchell stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 772 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (867), Astros (814) and Yankees (798).

SPROAT AT A GLANCE: Brandon Sproat, 25, will be making his fourth appearance and second start of the season.....Sproat last pitched last Saturday in relief vs. Washington (3.2ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 3k, 65 pitches)....it was his second straight relief appearance....he made his Brewers debut in a start on 3/29 vs. Chicago-AL and received no decision in a 9-7 win (3ip, 6h, 7r, 7er, 4bb, 3k, 3hr, 86 pitches)....he was acquired from the Mets with INF/OF Jett Williams on January 21 for RHP Freddy Peralta and RHP Tobias Myers....he entered the 2026 season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.....Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida.

LAST SEASON: Sproat entered the 2025 season as the second-best prospect in the Mets organization according to *Baseball America* with his changeup rated best in the system....he went 8-6 with a 4.24 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Syracuse....he was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 0.67era).... Sproat was selected by the Mets on September 7 and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts....he made his Major League debut on 9/7 at Cincinnati and carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-0 with a 10.80 ERA in 2 games/1 start, all coming this season (6.2ip, 8er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 0-3 with a 6.91 ERA in 3 games/2 starts (14.1ip, 11er)....is 0-1 with a 9.82 ERA in 1 relief appearance this season (3.2ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. BLUE JAYS: Sproat has not faced the Toronto, Ontario, Canada Blue Jays.

ODDS & ENDS: Sproat graduated from Pace (FL) High School, where he played football (quarterback) during his freshman and sophomore years in addition to four years of baseball....he enjoys golf, hunting, fishing and the outdoors.
