**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
JUNE 14**
1996 - 1B Jeff Bagwell ties a Major League record and sets the franchise high with four doubles in the Astros 9-1 win at San Francisco...Bagwell also ties the franchise record for the most extra-base hits in a game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros will conclude their six-game trip with the final game of a three-game series against the Royals today at Kauffman Stadium...May AL Pitcher of the Month, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** will be on the mound for the Astros, opposite **RHP Stephen Kolek** and the Royals...the Astros are 3-2 on this road trip.

HOT SPAGHETTI: Today's Astros starter **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** made his season debut on April 15 and has since gone 7-1 with a 2.21 ERA (14ER/57IP) and a .185 opponent average while allowing one-or-fewer earned runs in seven of his 10 starts...among AL pitchers with 50+ innings pitched, he's posted the lowest opponent average, while ranking second in ERA and tied for fourth in wins.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: RHP Spencer Arrighetti was named the AL Pitcher of the Month for May after going 4-1 with a 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent average (16x97) in five starts in the month...in May, he posted the lowest ERA and opponent average among AL starters, while ranking tied for third in wins.

PEN PALS: Since May 15, the Astros bullpen has recorded a 2.67 ERA (29ER/97.2IP) with 88 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and a .184 opponent batting average... among AL teams since May 15, the Astros bullpen ranks first in opponent batting average, first in WHIP and first in ERA...the Astros are also 16-11 during since May 15.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Astros are tied for the fewest errors in the AL (28) with the Athletics... Houston has posted the best fielding percentage (.989) in the AL, topping the Athletics (.989), Royals (.988) and Yankees (.988) by a few percentage points.

LAST NIGHT'S GAME: The Astros defeated the Royals, 8-7 last night at Kauffman Stadium...**RHP Mike Burrows** (5.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 5K) made the start for the Astros...**1B Christian Walker** (1x5, HR, 3 RBI), **2B Jose Altuve** (2x4, HR, 2 RBI), **LF Brice Matthews** (2x4, HR, 2 RBI) and **CF Jake Meyers** (2x4, 2 R, HR, RBI) each recorded a home run...**RHP Bryan Abreu** (1.0 IP, 1 H) tossed a scoreless inning to recorded his fifth save of the season.

UPCOMING HOMESTAND: Following today's game, the Astros will travel back to Houston for a six-game homestand that will feature two three-game series against AL Central opponents in the Detroit Tigers and the Cleveland Guardians...the Astros are 16-19 at Daikin Park this season and went 4-5 in their last homestand.

VOTING COMMENCES: MLB launched the 2026 Konami eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot last week... the Astros on the ballot: **1B Christian Walker**, **2B Jose Altuve**, **3B Isaac Paredes**, **SS Jeremy Peña**, **C Yainer Diaz**, **DH Yordan Alvarez**, **OF Brice Matthews**, **OF Jake Meyers** and **OF Cam Smith**.

HIT PAREDES: IF Isaac Paredes is one double away from recording his 100th career double...is looking to become just the 4th Mexican-born player in MLB history with 500 career hits, 100 doubles and 100 home runs, joining **IF Vinny Castilla**, **IF Jorge Orta** and **IF Aurelio Rodriguez**.

VS. THE ROYALS: The Astros and Royals are facing each other for the first time this season...the Astros went 3-3 against the Royals last season, including a 1-2 record at Kauffman Stadium...the Astros own a 60-49 record all-time record against the Royals, including a 31-24 record at Kauffman Stadium.

ON THE LEADERBOARD: DH Yordan Alvarez leads the Majors in OPS (1.093), SLG (.658) and total bases (169) and is tied for the Major League lead in home runs (24)...in the AL, he ranks first in RBI (54), first in extra-base hits (37), first in hits (84), first in batting average (.327), second in OBP (.435), fourth in walks (46) and fourth in runs (49).

HOMER HAPPY: DH Yordan Alvarez hit two home runs, including a grand slam in the first inning of Fri. night's game vs. KC...he became the third player in franchise history to record two home runs in a single inning, joining **Lee May** on April 29, 1974 and **Jeff Bagwell** on June 24, 1994.

RIBEYE STEAK: DH Yordan Alvarez also recorded six RBI in the first inning of Fri. night's game, becoming the first player in franchise history to record at least six RBI in a single inning, the last player in MLB history to record at least six RBI in a single inning was **LAD OF Cody Bellinger** on June 2, 2021 vs. STL...he's also the 17th player in MLB history to do so.

YORDAN'S SLAM: DH Yordan Alvarez hit his sixth career grand slam on Fri. night at KC...Alvarez now ranks tied for fourth in franchise history in grand slams, trailing only **2B Jose Altuve** (7), **3B Alex Bregman** (7) and **OF Carlos Lee** (7).

AIR YORDAN: DH Yordan Alvarez is on pace to hit 54 home runs, which would set the single-season franchise home run record, passing **IF Jeff Bagwell's** 47 home runs in 2000...Alvarez's single-season career-high in home runs is 37, which he recorded in 2022.

ON BASE MACHINE: OF Yordan Alvarez is on a 20-game on-base streak...during the streak, he's batting .389 (28x72) with 19 runs, two doubles, nine home runs, 23 RBI, 15 walks and a 1.286 OPS...it is his second-longest on-base streak this season, behind a 22-game on-base streak from April 4-28... it is the second time in his career, he's recorded two 20-game on-base streaks in the same season, also did so in 2023 with on-base streaks of 30 games and 36 games.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: In the AL, **1B Christian Walker** ranks second in RBI (52), behind only teammate **OF Yordan Alvarez** (54 RBI)...also ranks, fifth in extra-base hits (32), tied for fourth in home runs (18), fifth in total bases (135) and 11th in SLG (.506)...in the field, Walker has not committed an error in 70 games.

LAST START, JUNE 8 at LAA: Picked up a quality start in a no decision on Monday in Anaheim after tossing 6.0 innings and allowing 3 runs on 4 hits...allowed all 3 runs in the 2nd inning before finishing his outing with 4.0 scoreless innings...struck out 7 and issued 4 walks...tossed 95 pitches (57 strikes) in the outing.

SPAGHETTI DAY: The 3rd-year starter has dominated in his Major League action this season, going 7-1 in 10 starts with a 2.21 ERA (14ER/57IP), while fanning 53 in 57.0 innings and allowing a .185 (37x200) opponent batting average...leads the Astros in wins (7), quality starts (5) and leads all Astros pitchers in bWAR (1.9) on the season...all this came after he began the season at Triple A Sugar Land (recalled on April 15).

ON THE LEADERBOARDS: Despite making his season debut on April 15, Arrighetti ranks tied for fifth in the AL in wins (7)...among AL pitchers with 50+ innings pitched, Arrighetti owns the lowest opponent average (.185) in the AL and ranks 2nd in ERA (2.21).

VS. KC: Has faced the Royals once in his career, which was his Major League debut on April 10, 2024 at KC...allowed 7 runs on 7 hits in 3.0 innings and was handed the loss in the contest...allowed all 7 runs in the 3rd inning.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Named American League Pitcher of the Month for May...marked the first Pitcher of the Month Award and second monthly award overall for Arrighetti...was also named AL Rookie of the Month for August of 2024...was outstanding in the month of May, posting a 4-1 record in his 5 starts with an 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent batting average...led the AL in ERA and opponent batting average and was tied for first in wins...allowed just three earned runs in his five May starts, allowing one or no earned runs in all five starts...is the first Astros hurler to earn Pitcher of the Month honors since **RHP Hunter Brown** won the award for June of 2025...is also the Astros second monthly award winner in 2026 as **Yordan Alvarez** was named AL Player of the Month for March/April of this season.

START FOR THE BOOKS: Made the best start of his career on May 15 vs. TEX at Daikin Park, where he allowed 1 hit and 4 walks with 5 strikeouts in 7.1 scoreless innings...also carried a no-hit bid through 7.1 innings prior to allowing a single...was Arrighetti's longest career no-hit bid and his longest since tossing 7.0 no-hit innings on Aug. 28, 2024 at PHI.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI: Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/13 vs. KC): Earned his 5th save of the season last night after tossing a scoreless 9th inning...allowed a double in the inning, but worked around it by inducing a line drive double play...tossed 8 pitches (6 strikes) in the outing...is now 5-for-5 in save chances on the season.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.57 ERA (4ER/14IP) in his last 16 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the longest by an Astro this season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has made 344 career appearances, recently passing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...now directly trails **LHP Joe Sambito** (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (479) and 10th in innings pitched (353.0).

CAREER: In 344 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.91 ERA (114ER/353IP) with 479 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.21 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among AL relievers.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/12 at KC): In his first career appearance against the Royals on Friday night, tossed 2.0 scoreless innings with 2 strikeouts, while working around 1 hit and 1 walk...tossed 38 pitches (24 strikes) in the outing...marked his 3rd consecutive outing in which he tossed exactly 2.0 scoreless innings and marked his 7th scoreless outing of 2.0+ innings this season.

STRONG STRETCH: Has posted a 2.38 ERA (9ER/34IP) and .171 opponent batting average (20x117) over a 21-appearance stretch dating back to April 16.

MULTI-INNING MAN: Leads Major League relievers with 44.2 innings pitched this season...a starter throughout his MiLB career, he has 16 multi-inning outings among his 28 apps. this season.

CHANGING THINGS UP: Has tossed his changeup at a 20.8-percent rate...used his changeup at a 19.3-percent rate as a rookie in 2025...has held opponents to a .162 average (6x37) with his changeup this season.

INHERITANCE: Has stranded 12 of 13 inherited runners this season for a 7.7% inherited runners scored rate.

REVERSE SPLIT: Has held left-handed hitters to a .163 average (13x80) with 22 strikeouts this season.
