RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals conclude their quick two-game weekend series in Oakland this afternoon and need a win to prevent a season series sweep by the Athletics...the Cardinals continue their 5-game west coast trip with a 3-game series against the LA Dodgers tomorrow night at Dodger Stadium...the Cardinals entered play today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 1/2-game back of the Chicago Cubs and 2-1/2 games in front of 3rd place Milwaukee...The Cardinals went 16-9 in July, and own the 3rd best winning pct. (.667; 14-7) in the National League since the All-Star break, trailing the New York Mets (14-6, .700) and San Francisco Giants (15-7, .682).

CARDS SHUFFLE ROSTER: The Cardinals announced a series of roster moves prior to today's game, activating infielder **Matt Carpenter** from the 10-day Injured List and recalling right-handed pitcher **Ryan Helsley** from Memphis (AAA). The team also announced that first baseman/outfielder **Rangel Ravelo** has been optioned to Memphis and right-handed pitcher **Mike Mayers** has been designated for assignment...Carpenter, who has been on the Injured List since July 16 with a right foot contusion, completed a nine-game injury rehabilitation tour this past week, going 2-for-26 with seven walks between Springfield (5 games) and Memphis (4 games)...Carpenter is batting .215 with 10 HR and 29 RBI in 81 games this season...Helsley is being recalled for the sixth time this season...the rookie right-hander has gone 0-0 with a 2.92 ERA in eight games with the Cardinals, striking out 13 in 12.1 innings pitched. He has appeared in 17 games (seven starts) for Memphis, compiling a 2-3 mark with a 4.58...Helsley has been used as a starter in his last two outings at Memphis, including a scoreless 3.0-inning effort on July 31 vs. Albuquerque...the Cardinals activated outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** from the Injured List prior to last night's game and catcher **Yadier Molina**, out since July 8 due to a right thumb tendon strain, is currently on an injury rehabilitation assignment with Memphis.

PUTTING THE BARK IN DOG DAYS: Since 2000, the Cardinals have sported a winning August record in 16 of 19 seasons (excluding 2006, '08, & '10), with a combined .588 win pct. (316-221) that is highest in Major League Baseball over that time span. Last season, St. Louis (.786, 22-6) led MLB in August victories and winning percentage, marking the team's first 22-win August since 1946 (22-9, .710).

MANAGER MILESTONE: Skipper **Mike Shildt** piloted the Cardinals to his 99th career win on Thursday and he's 99-79 (.556) overall since taking the helm of the Redbirds last July...he's 23-7 in August games.

MEJÍA MAKES 19: Lefty reliever **Adalberto Mejía**, acquired on July 30 as a waiver claim from the LA Angels, made his Cardinals debut last night with 1.2 innings of work...Mejía became the 19th different player to work out of the Cardinals bullpen in 2019...the Redbirds used a franchise single-season record 25 different players out of the bullpen in 2018.

THOMAS' PINCH POWER: Rookie outfielder **Lane Thomas** cracked his 2nd career homer last night with a pinch-hit blast in the 9th inning...both of his homers have come as a pinch-hitter (also April 19, 2019 vs. NY Mets)...Thomas is the 7th Cardinals rookie to hit multiple pinch homers in a single season, joining **Jeremy Hazelbaker** (4 in 2016), **Matt Adams** (3, 2013), **José Martínez** (2, 2017), **Joe Mather** (2, 2008), **Chris Duncan** (2, 2006) and **Keith McDonald** (2, 2000).

Tommy Edman played college baseball at Stanford University (2014-16).

Yairo Muñoz was originally signed by the Athletics as a non-drafted free agent (Jan. 27, 2012)...played five years in their minor league system (2012-17) before traded to St. Louis.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and current coach **Willie McGee** played 29 games for the Athletics in 1990 and a member of their AL Championship squad...traded by St. Louis to Oakland in exchange for pitcher **Daryl Green**, outfielder **Félix José**, and infielder **Stan Royer**...was born in San Francisco, Calif...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond, Calif...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, Calif...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, Calif...resides in Hercules, Calif.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Former Athletics 2nd round draft pick in 1999 **Ryan Ludwick** and **Jason Istringhausen** who pitched for the Athletics (1999-2001) are members of the Cardinals Core, a program that teaches character building and leadership skills to players throughout the Cardinals minor league system.

Cardinals 1B/OF **Rangel Ravelo** was a member of the Athletics organization from 2015-16 before joining the Cardinals in 2017.

Stephen Piscotty was selected by the Cardinals in the first round (36th overall) of the 2012 MLB Draft out of Stanford University...played parts of three seasons for St. Louis (2015-17) before traded to Oakland in exchange for minor league infielders **Yairo Muñoz** and **Max Schrock** (Dec. 14, 2017)...named the 2015 Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year.

Athletics assistant hitting coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2008-11) and bench coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 National League pennant winner.

Athletics Assistant GM **Dan Kantrovitz** was the Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...was also a Cardinals 25th round draft pick out of Brown University in 2001...took his first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coordinator (2004).

Athletics Minor League Roving Infielder and Baserunning Instructor **Steve Scarson** played five games for the Cardinals (1997).

Athletics Triple-A (Las Vegas) Athletic Trainer **Brad LaRosa** spent three years in the same role with the Cardinals Springfield (AA) affiliate. He holds two degrees from SIU-Edwardsville and resides in Illinois in the off-season.

Athletics Roving Infielder and Baserunning Instructor **Steve Scarson** played five games for the St. Louis Cardinals in 1997.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is the only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series title in both...His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland and 1 with Chicago) rank second to Joe Torre (84)...In Oakland, La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three American League pennants and the...1989 World Championship...is the A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons with Oakland (1968-71).

Hall of Famer **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** played parts of 12 seasons with Oakland (1986-97)...Named AL Rookie of the Year (1987)...member of the 1989 World Series Champions and three AL pennant-winning teams (1988-90)...selected to eight AL All-Star teams (1987-92, '95-97)...won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Gold Glove award (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (10th overall) in the 1984 MLB Draft...traded to the Cardinals by Oakland in exchange for pitchers **Eric Ludwick**, **T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein**.

Cardinals Baseball Development Analyst **Emily Wiebe** grew up in nearby San Francisco, Calif...attended University High School.

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 21st start of the season (306th career start) and his 373rd career appearance.
- Ranks 9th among active pitchers with a 3.38 ERA (min. 1,500 IP) and T14th in starts.
- Has reached the 100 inning threshold in a season for first time since 2017 (123.1) and 100 strikeouts for first time since 2016 (161).
- Has a 60-33 (.645) career mark in post All-Star break games with a 3.41 ERA (804.1 IP/306 ER). He ranks 3rd among active NL pitchers in post All-Star winning pct.
- Ranks 2nd among active pitchers to Clayton Kershaw in career win. pct. in July (26-7, .788) and third in career July ERA (2.65). Kershaw 33-7 (.825) with 1.70 ERA (min. 30 dec.).
- Passed Bill Sherdel (1918-30, '32) for 4th all-time in wins (154) in franchise history in his 7/14 start vs. ARI. Is eight wins back of Bob Forsch (163) for 3rd all-time.
- Is one of five Cardinal pitchers to make 300 or more career starts, joining Bob Gibson (482), Bob Forsch (401), Jesse Haines (387), and Bill Doak (320).
- Is 2-5, 7.16 ERA in 10 road starts (5-2, 2.33 ERA in 9 home starts). His ERA is the highest in the NL this season. His lone road win came on April 30 at Washington (3-2).
- Since 2016, St. Louis sports a 51-33 record (.607 win pct) in his games pitched.

LAST TIME OUT

- Made his 40th career start vs. the Cubs, allowing one run over 5.2 innings in St. Louis' 2-1 win last Tuesday at Busch Stadium. Exited in the 6th inning with the game tied at 1-1 with bases loaded and one out.

- Has thrown his curve ball 34.0% of his total pitches (618 of 1,820) this season, with the opposition batting .259 (35-135) with two home runs and 46 strikeouts. Only Yankees RHP Domingo German (36.8%) and Rays RHP Charlie Morton (36.6%) throw a higher percentage of curve balls in MLB (minimum 1,000 total pitches) (*Statcast*).
- 8.0% of his curveballs (145) have been called for strikes, highest in MLB (minimum 1,000 total pitches). Stephen Strasburg is 2nd at 7.4%. (*Statcast*)
- Has allowed 15 runs in the third inning (6.75 ERA) of his 20 starts.
- Is a perfect 4-0 (Cardinals 5-0) in his five day game starts, posting 1.74 ERA.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 256 games, 8th-most all-time in Major League history (*since 1908*).
