LAST APPEARANCE (8/7 at SD): Allowed 2 hits and struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning on Fri. night vs. SD to record his 16th hold of the season.

NO FREEBIES: Has not allowed a walk in 18 consecutive appearances (17.2 IP), dating back to June 28 at DET...has struck out 23 batters over that span...is the longest streak of appearances without a walk by an Astro this season and is the longest since a 19-game streak (21.0IP) by **RHP Ryan Pressly** from March 28-May 20, 2019...Okert's longest streak was a 23-game streak from Sept. 6, 2017-July 6, 2021.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Among AL relievers, he ranks first in WHIP (0.81), second in appearances (56), second in H/9 (5.56), second in opponent batting average (.179), fifth in opponent OPS (.546) and seventh in ERA (2.06) (min. 50 IP).

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 93rd in walk percentage (5.4), 88th percentile in barrel percentage (4.8), 84th percentile in hard-hit percentage (33.3), 83rd percentile in whiff percentage (30.0)...also ranks in the 91st percentile in xERA (2.86) and 90th percentile in xBA (.201).

THE STREAK: His scoreless streak (14 apps, 17.1 IP from May 23-June 24) was the longest streaks by innings and appearances among Astros pitchers this season...is the 5th-longest streak by innings and tied for 7th-longest by appearances among AL relievers this season...is also the 2nd-longest scoreless appearance streak of Okert's career, behind a 17-game streak in 2017 while with the Giants.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Logged 3 scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings in June (June 4 vs. PIT, June 12 at KC and June 19 vs. CLE)...tossed 2.1 innings on June 12 at KC, matching his career high, which he reached once before on Aug. 6, 2021 at COL...his 4 scoreless outings of 2.0+ innings this season are tied for the 2nd-most in a season in his career, trailing only 6 such appearances in 2025.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/7 at SD): Tossed 0.1 of a scoreless inning on Fri. night at SD.

ROSTER MOVE: Was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 20 (left elbow inflammation)...was on the IL from May 6-July 19 and marked his 2nd IL stint of the season...since returning from the IL, he's recorded a 1.23 ERA (1ER/7.1IP) with 6 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .185 opponent batting average...made 5 rehab appearances between Triple A Sugar Land (3g) and FCL Astros (2g), recording a 0.00 ERA (0ER/5IP)...also missed the first 27 games of the season due to a left oblique strain.

HOME COOKIN': Owns a career 2.67 ERA (10ER/33.2IP), a 0.86 WHIP, a .155 opponent batting average and a 11.23 SO/9IP (42 SO/33.2 IP) in 28 career appearances at Daikin Park, all coming while a member of the Astros.

2025 RECAP: Enjoyed the best season of his MLB career, going 5-1-4 with a 2.84 ERA (16ER/50.2IP), a 1.03 WHIP, 59 strikeouts and a .204 opponent batting average...prior to last year, his single-season career highs in appearances were 25 and innings were 20.1, both coming with the White Sox in 2022...was especially strong at Daikin Park, posting a 2.55 ERA (7ER/24.2IP), 0.81 WHIP and .172 opponent batting average in his 19 home appearances last season.

LAST GAME: Went 0x4 yesterday at SD.

ON THE MOVE: Recorded his 10th stolen base of the season on Wed. vs. TOR and has now logged 10+ stolen bases in 4 of his last 5 seasons.

WELCOME TO H-TOWN: Was acquired by the Astros from the Blue Jays on Aug. 3, along with cash considerations, in exchange for RHP Spencer Arrighetti.

ASTROS DEBUT: Batted cleanup and started in CF on Aug. 3 vs. his former club, going 1x4 with a walk...singled in his 1st plate appearance as an Astro.

2026 AT A GLANCE: Hit .243 (81x333) with 19 doubles, 7 home runs and 26 RBI in 99 games for the Blue Jays prior to the deal, appearing exclusively in CF...ranks in the 88th percentile among qualified MLB defenders in defensive range, per Baseball Savant.

THE VARSHOW: Has played in parts of 7 MLB seasons with the Diamondbacks (2020-22), Blue Jays (2023-26) and now the Astros (2026), appearing in 752 career MLB games...won the American League Gold Glove Award in CF in 2024...has accrued 83 Defensive Runs Saved since 2022, the most among all MLB outfielders.

PENNANT CHASE: Started all 18 postseason games of the Blue Jays' World Series run in 2025...recorded a career-high .825 OPS and belted 20 homers in 71 regular-season games to help the Blue Jays secure their first AL East title since 2015.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTION: Was selected by the Diamondbacks in the 2nd round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee...is 1 of 2 UW-Milwaukee alums now on the Astros, joining RHP AJ Blubaugh...the duo are 2 of 3 UW-Milwaukee alums to ever appear in the Majors, along with RHP Brian Keller, who debuted with the Phillies this season.

IN THE GENES: His father, Gary, played 8 MLB seasons (1988-1995) with the Cubs, Pirates, Reds and Phillies...is currently a professional scout for the Pirates.

LAST GAME: Went 0x2 in a start at catcher yesterday at SD...has still hit safely in 4 of his last 5 starts, batting .294 (5x17) with a double, RBI and a walk in his last 5 starts.

BEHIND THE DISH: The Astros are 37-22 in his 59 total starts this season...has caught 18 of 20 starts for RHP Peter Lambert, who leads the Astros with 8 wins and 8 quality starts, while posting a 3.09 ERA on the year...started in 28 of the Astros' 38 games from May 5-June 15, coinciding with C Yainer Diaz's stint on the IL.

DON'T TRY ME: He ranks T-9th in the AL with 13 catcher caught stealings...has thrown out 13 of 61 (21.3%) would-be base stealers this season.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Is hitting .341 (14x41) with an .880 OPS with RISP this season.

NO-HITTER: Was behind the plate for the Astros' combined no-hitter on May 25 at TEX...marked the 2nd career no-hitter he's caught, with the other on Nov. 2, 2022 at PHI (Game 4 of the 2022 WS)...he joins Alan Ashby (3 no-hitters) and Martín Maldonado (3 no-hitters) as the only 3 catchers in club history to catch multiple no-hitters.

LAST GAME: Went 0x1 yesterday at SD, grounding out as a pinch-hitter for the last out of the game.

NO. 200: Recorded his 200th career RBI with an RBI single on Wednesday vs. TOR...finished the game 3x4 with a double and an RBI, matching his season high of 3 hits for the 2nd time (also, June 6 vs. ATH).

RBI STREAK: Has collected an RBI in 4 consecutive starts and had his general 4-game RBI streak snapped yesterday, which had matched his career high...also had two 4-game RBI streaks in 2021 with the Giants...has yet to record an RBI in 5 consecutive starts in his 8-year MLB career.

WALK THIS WAY: Ranks T-5th in the AL with 12 walks since the All-Star Break...has drawn a walk in 9 of his last 16 games...tied his single-game career high of 3 walks on July 17 vs. BAL, doing so for the 8th time in his career, last, was on Sept. 3, 2024 vs. ARI as a member of the Giants.

BASES JUICED: Has reached safely in all 6 of his plate appearances with the bases loaded this season, going 4x4 with 1 double, 1 homer (July 11 at TEX), 10 RBI and 2 walks...with RISP this season, he is hitting .412 (7x17) with a .500 OBP.

WELCOME PARTY: Went 3x5 with a double, home run, 3 RBI and 2 runs scored in what was his 2nd game as an Astro on June 6 vs. ATH...matched his career high with 3 hits for the 17th time, last doing so on July 20, 2025 at PHI.

NEW FACE: Was signed by the Astros to a Major League contract on June 4...prior to signing with the Astros, he spent the beginning of the regular season with Triple A Charlotte in the White Sox organization, batting .250 (38x152) with 27 runs, 8 doubles, 7 home runs, 26 RBI and an .861 OPS in 46 games...opted out of his contract with the White Sox on June 1.

ON DEFENSE: Has primarily appeared at first base (322g) and right field (136g) in his MLB career, while also making appearances in LF (104g) and CF (23g)...with the Astros, has primarily appeared in LF (16g), also making appearances at 1B (5g) and RF (4g).

LAST GAME: Went 1x2 with a walk and a run scored yesterday at SD...was also hit by a pitch on his right hand in the 9th inning.

STREAKING: Is amid a season-high 11-game hitting streak, batting .333 (14x42) with 8 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 7 walks and a 1.011 OPS during the streak...is the 2nd-longest hitting streak of his career, now trailing only a 13-game streak from June 16-29, 2023.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: In the AL, he ranks T-6th in XBH (47), T-11th in RBI (67) and 13th in HR (22).

IRON MAN: Is T-1st in the AL with 110 starts at 1B this season...has not committed an error through 948.1 innings played at the position...is the only qualified infielder in the Majors to not have committed an error this season (regardless of position).

VS. SD: In 97 career games vs. the Padres, he's batted .240 (79x329) with 17 doubles, 16 home runs, 49 RBI and a .772 OPS...among active players, he ranks 10th in games, 11th in doubles and 13th in home runs vs. SD.

20/20 VISION: Has reached 20+ homers in 5 consecutive seasons, along with 6 total seasons in his career (2019, 2022-26)...reached 20 homers in his 90th game of the season, marking the 4th time in his career he reached 20 home runs within that span (also, 2022-24)...his 5 consecutive seasons of 20+ homers is the 8th-longest active streak among active players.
