WHISPERING SWEEP NOTHINGS

- Washington enjoyed a day off on Monday following a three-game sweep of the Los Angeles Angels over the weekend...All three wins were in come-from-behind fashion.
- The Nationals have won eight of their last 10 home games and are 16-8 (.676) at home since July 25.

- Also of note, Abrams leads Major League Baseball with an 86% ABS Challenge success rate (min. 10 challenges)...He is 12-for-14 in ABS Challenges this season.

- Starters/openers have allowed just two home runs in 75.2 innings across the last 17 games.

- The seven doubles are tied for fifth in Major League Baseball, while the .426 on-base percentage is good for 10th in the National League (min. 55 PA) during this stretch.

- On the season, Lile ranks fourth in MLB with eight triples and fourth among NL outfielders with 82 RBI.

- If Wood reaches the 80 RBI mark, the 2026 Nationals would become the eighth team in Major League history with at least three players age 25 and younger to record a 20/80 season...The last team to do so was the 2007 Milwaukee Brewers, who hold the record with four (**Ryan Braun, Prince Fielder, J.J. Hardy, Corey Hart**)...The last team to have three was the 1999 Kansas City Royals (**Carlos Beltran, Jermaine Dye, Mike Sweeney**).

- The 2026 Nationals join the 2019 and 2017 clubs as the only teams in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with at least 10 players to hit at least 10 home runs in a season.

- **Jack Sinclair** earned his first career win (9/12 vs. LAA) and first career save (9/13 vs. LAA) on back-to-back days...He's posted a 1.69 ERA (1 ER/5.1 IP) with a .118 opponents' average (2-for-17) in five games.

LAST START

Kent tossed 3.0 innings and allowed five earned runs on eight hits and one walk with two strikeouts against the San Diego Padres on Sept. 9 at Petco Park...He took the loss in the 9-2 defeat.

NO HOMER(S) CLUB

Kent has surrendered just one home run in 27.1 innings (0.33 HR/9.0 IP) since making his Major League debut on on Aug. 12, tied for the second-fewest in Major League Baseball (min. 25.0 IP) over this span...He is one of just eight pitchers to allow one home run or fewer since Aug. 12 (min. 25.0 IP).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW, KID

With his Major League debut on Aug. 12 vs. Chicago (NL), Kent became the 31st starting pitcher originally signed or drafted and developed by the Nationals to start a game for the team (since 2005).

- Kent fanned **Pete Crow-Armstrong** looking to lead off the game for his first Major League strikeout...He recorded three strikeouts in that first inning.
- He struck out five batters in the first three innings before allowing a hit in the top of the fourth.

FIRST FOUR

Kent earned his first career-win behind 7.0 innings of one-run, three-hit ball against the Marlins on Aug. 28.

- In the outing, he became just the third Nationals pitcher (2005-pres.) to pitch at least 7.0 innings and allow three hits or less in one of his first four career games...He joined **Mitchell Parker** (7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 8 SO on April 21, 2024 vs. HOU) and **Mike O'Connor** (7.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 6 SO on May 2, 2006 at NYM).

DOWN ON THE FARM

Kent joined the Nationals after going 9-4 with a 3.72 ERA and 105 strikeouts in 20 starts (94.1 IP) between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester

- At the time of his promotion, he led Washington's Minor League system in opponents' on-base percentage (.277) and opponents' average (.216)...He ranked second in winning percentage (.692) and WHIP (1.12).
- The opponents' on-base percentage ranked ninth in all of Minor League Baseball, while the opponents' average and WHIP rank 11th.

2025

Entered the season with High-A Wilmington before making his Double-A Harrisburg debut on August 14, 2025.

- Made 18 appearances (18 GS) with High-A Wilmington and pitched to a 4.31 ERA (45 ER/94.0 IP) with a 5-7 record.
- His best start of the season came on April 12 when he allowed one hit and struck out nine over 5.0 shutout innings, for which he earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week.
- His 18.5% strikeout-to-walk rate was the best in Washington's Minor League system.
- Made six appearances (6 GS) with Double-A Harrisburg and pitched to a 5.59 ERA (18 ER/29.0 IP) with 35 strikeouts.
