Enoli Paredes is the 41st player (24th pitcher) to appear on the active roster this season.

A Call to Arms

Jared Koenig will be the 11th different starting pitcher used by the Brewers this season, tying the Dodgers for most in the Major Leagues.

It's Fenway or the Highway

Jared Koenig will be making just the sixth start of his Major League career but his second at Fenway Park..... he also started here in a 6-1 loss on 6/14/22 as a member of the Athletics and allowed 6 runs on 9 hits in 4.0 innings (2bb, 3k, 2hr, 2hbp, 1wp, 1bk).

Homecoming King

Sal Frelick is making his first visit to Fenway Park as a Major Leaguer..... he was born in Boston and graduated from Lexington High School, where he played baseball, football and hockey, before attending Boston College.

Everyday People

Willy Adames and **William Contreras** have both started each of the team's first 49 games.....this is the longest streak to start a season by Brewers teammates since **Ryan Braun** and **Prince Fielder** in 2011 (56 games).

William Contreras, who has started every game for the Brewers this season (40g at C, 9g at DH), currently ranks among the National League top five in the following categories:

Leading Off

Brice Turang has started in the leadoff position in each of his last 10 starts and has hit .350 (14-for-40) with 5 RBI.....in this stretch, Turang has a .381 OBP/.500 SLG/.881 OPS..... he had never started in the leadoff spot prior to this season.

A Life of Crime

Brice Turang has been successful in his last 35 stolen base attempts, the longest active streak in the majors and longest streak in team history.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is the seventh game (2-4) of a 9-game, 10-day road trip to Houston (1-2), Miami (1-2) and Boston (3g).....following this trip, the Brewers return to American Family Field for a 7-game homestand against Chicago-NL (4g) and Chicago-AL (3g).

AT HOME: The Brewers are 12-9 at home, going 4-2-1 in series play.....the team has gone 7-2 in their last 9 home games after a 5-7 start.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 16-11 on the road, going 4-4-1 in series play.....the team has lost its last four road series (1-2 at CHC/1-2 at KC/1-2 at HOU/1-2 at MIA) after going 4-0-1 in its first five.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff..... **Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges this season, going 6-4.....their last challenge came on 5/19 at Houston as an out call at first base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON (12g, 6gs, 2-1, 2.79)

WILSON AT A GLANCE: Bryse Wilson, 26, will be making his 13th appearance and seventh start of the season....Wilson last pitched last Saturday in a start at Houston and had no decision in the Brewers' 4-2 win (4.2ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 3k, 1hr, 2wp, 58 pitches)....he has gone 0-1 with a 2.20 ERA as a starter (28.2ip, 7er) and 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA in relief (10ip, 5er)....opponents are batting .203 (28-for-138, 6hr)....the team is 3-3 in his starts....he has 2 quality starts....his last start prior to this season came on 9/28/22 vs. Cincinnati....he made 59 straight relief appearances between starts....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

LAST SEASON: Wilson went 6-0 with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career....he held opponents to a .211 batting average, marking a career best.

CAREER: Is 17-18 with a 4.58 ERA and 4 saves in 121 games/49 starts (347.2ip, 177er)....is in his seventh Major League season with Atlanta (2018-21), Pittsburgh (2021-22) and Milwaukee (2023-24)....is 9-17 with a 5.08 ERA as a starter (226.2ip, 128er) and 8-1 with a 3.64 ERA in relief (121ip, 49er)....Wilson was selected by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Orange (NC) High School....he committed to the University of North Carolina prior to being drafted....Wilson was traded by the Braves to the Pirates, along with RHP Ricky DeVito, in exchange for RHP Richard Rodríguez on 7/30/21.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-3 with a 3.22 ERA in 36 games/6 starts (72.2ip, 26er)....is 0-1 with a 2.50 ERA in 5 games/3 starts this season (18ip, 5er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 9-11 with a 4.52 ERA in 58 games/25 starts (165.1ip, 83er)....is 2-0 with a 3.05 ERA in 7 games/3 starts this season (20.2ip, 7er).

CAREER vs. RED SOX: Is 0-0 with a 7.11 ERA in 3 games/1 start (6.1ip, 8h, 5r, 5er, 6bb, 5k, 0hr)....his only start against the Red Sox came as a member of the Braves on 9/27/20 in Atlanta....he had no decision in a 9-1 loss (3ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 2k).
