WIN-CINNATI PART TWO: Last night, the Dodgers took the second game in Cincinnati to secure their MLB-best 23rd series win of the season (23-11-2). The Dodgers’ longest road trip of the second half (3-2) rolls on at Great American Ball Park for their final of three games tonight. L.A. will enjoy an off day tomorrow in Tampa Bay and then wrap up the trip with an Interleague series vs. the Rays (August 1-3). When the team returns to Los Angeles, the Dodgers will host St. Louis (August 4-6) and Toronto (August 8-10).

- At 63-45 (.583), the Dodgers lead the San Diego Padres by 4.0 games in the National League West and are tied with the Chicago Cubs and 2.0 games behind the Milwaukee Brewers for the best record in the NL.
- Last season against Cincinnati, the Dodgers were swept in Cincy but took three of the four games in Los Angeles. The Reds took the season series in 2024 4-3 and will visit Los Angeles from August 25-27.
- The Dodgers are 10-13 in July with one game remaining in the month. The team has secured its second consecutive losing July.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: The Dodgers picked up the win in their second game against Cincinnati last night with a final score of 5-4. **Tommy Edman** got the Dodgers on the board first with a two-run homer in the second inning, his 12th of the season. Edman is now one away from his season-high in home runs set in 2022 and 2023. After the Dodgers fell behind 4-2, **Will Smith** came in clutch with an RBI single in the seventh and an RBI double in the ninth, bringing his average with runners in scoring position to .373 which is third in the Majors. **Freddie Freeman** smashed his third multi-hit game since the All-Star break, going 3-for-5 with a run scored and an RBI. Former Red **Alexis Diaz** recorded the win, his first of the season, after tossing 1.1 scoreless innings, while **Alex Vesia** earned his fourth save of the season after striking out two to secure the victory.

- **Shohei Ohtani** leads the Majors with 100 runs scored and ranks first in the NL with a .612 slugging percentage, 38 home runs, a .989 OPS and 254 total bases. By going 0-for-5 last night, he snapped his nine-game hit streak where he hit .306 (11-for-36), with six home runs, 13 RBI and nine runs scored in the streak.
- Ohtani became the second fastest Dodger to record 100 runs scored in a season in franchise history, doing so in the Dodgers’ first 107 games, bested only by Babe Herman (99 team games) in 1930.
- Smith leads the National League with a .325 batting average and a .423 on-base percentage, and his .965 OPS trails that of only Ohtani (.998) and the Phillies’ Kyle Schwarber (.966)
- Since June 22, **Michael Conforto** has been a steady force at the plate, hitting .278 (22-for-79) with five home runs, seven walks (including two last night), 11 RBI and 13 runs scored.

LAND OF THE FREE: After being recalled from Triple-A Oklahoma City yesterday, infielder **Alex Freedland** will make his Major League debut today, batting ninth and playing third base. In 93 games with Triple-A Oklahoma City this season, the Kentucky native has slashed .253/.377/.421 with 12 homers and 71 RBI.

MIGGY, MIGGY, MIGGY: After going 1-for-4 with a single last night, infielder **Miguel Rojas** has been hitting .313 (20-for-64) since June 10 with five home runs, 11 walks, 14 runs and nine RBI against nine strikeouts. His double Tuesday night was his 10th extra base hit in his last 28 games.

SHO ‘EM WHO’S BOSS: Dodger two-way superstar **Shohei Ohtani** will make his seventh start of the season tonight. In his first six turns this season, he has amassed a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts along with a 1.00 WHIP while searching for his first decision. In his last start against Minnesota, Ohtani went 3.0 innings, giving up four hits, one run and one walk while striking out three. The home run he gave up was the first run he had surrendered since returning to the big league bump on June 16. Ohtani has faced the Reds only once on the mound, tossing 1.1 scoreless innings on August 23, 2023 with one walk and two strikeouts.

- Ohtani also homered in the first inning of his last start, making him the first Dodger pitcher to homer in the first inning since Rick Rhoden (July 30, 1977 at MON) and the third to do so in franchise history...he is only the third pitcher in MLB history to give up and hit a homer in the first inning, along with Marshall Bridges (STL, June 18, 1959 vs. CIN) and Randy Lerch (PHI, May 17, 1979 vs. CHC).

- Highlights
- Sanpped his nine-game hit streak last night after going 0-for-5...hit .306 (11-for-36) during the time frame
 - Crushed his 38th homer of the season on Saturday night...hit five homers in five consecutive games from July 19-23, becoming the first Dodger to do so since Max Muncy from Aug. 15-21, 2019 and sixth overall
 - Launched a home run in his first at-bat last on July 21, making him the first Dodger pitcher to homer since Hyun-Jun Ryu (Sept. 22, 2019 vs. COL)...marks the first time in Major League history that a pitcher both allowed and hit a home run in the first inning
 - His 32nd homer on July 11 set the Dodger franchise record for HRs before All-Star break
 - Named the 2025 NL All-Star Game starting DH after earning the most votes of all NL players in phase one...went 1-for-2 with a run scored
 - His performance on June 22 against the Nationals marks the second time he has a homer and a triple in a game he pitched (other: May 15, 2023)...is the only player with multiple such games in at least the last 125 seasons (credit Sarah Langs of MLB)
 - Blasted his 249th and 250th career home runs on June 14...is the only player in the history of baseball to record 25+ home runs, 10+ stolen bases and 5+ triples before the start of July (according to OptaSTATS)
 - 15 HRs in May ties the record for the most home runs by a Dodger in a month (tied with Pedro Guerrero (June 1985) and Duke Snider (August 1953)
 - Leads the Majors with 100 runs scored...leads the NL in slugging (.612), total bases (254), OPS (.989) and home runs (38)
 - Unanimously named the 2024 NL MVP after leading the NL in runs (134), home runs (54), RBI (130), on-base percentage (.390), slugging (.646) and OPS (1.036)
 - In his 50/50 game, had his first career 6-for-6 game with four runs scored, two doubles, two home runs, two stolen bases and 10 RBI...his most home runs and RBI in a single game
 - Was the first person in franchise history and sixth overall to join the 40/40 club on Aug. 23, 2024 with his walk-off grand slam...was also the fastest player to accomplish the feat (126 games)
 - Has slashed .280/.372/.579 with 263 homers, 640 RBI and 158 stolen bases in 981 games while posting a 38-19 record with a 2.97 ERA and 621 strikeouts across 92 career starts

- Picked up his first save of his Major League career on July 28 at CIN, coming into the game with bases loaded and forcing Matt McClain to ground out to short stop, ending the game with a four-pitch outing.
- Has not given up an earned run in 29 of his 42 games (five starts)...has struck out 51 batters against 20 walks for a 1.09 WHIP in 53.1 IP
- Retired all six batters faced May 16 against the Angels and struck out four...second time doing that this season (April 15 vs. COL)
- Earned his first Major League win in his fourth game of the season against Atlanta on April 2, striking out one in 2.0 IP...named to his first Major League Opening Day roster for the Tokyo Series...made his debut in Game 2, striking out one and allowing one earned run on two hits
